QUICK HITS

★ LMU is making its second postseason appearance in the last three years. The Lions' first round CIT win Wednesday gave the WCC five 20-win teams for the first time ever.

★ For the second time in its 60-year history of men's basketball (2008), the West Coast Conference had three teams participating in the NCAA Tournament (BYU, Gonzaga, Saint Mary's). The WCC also registered five postseason teams for the second straight year (LMU, USF).

★ Only five Division I teams have won at least 25 games in each of the last five seasons. Three of those teams (BYU, Gonzaga, Saint Mary's) call the WCC home. The other two: Duke, Kansas.

★ The WCC boasts the defending CIT champion, as Santa Clara won the 2011 title with a road win at Iona.

★ The winner of Wednesday's Loyola Marymount-Utah State game will face the winner of Rice-Oakland (played on Tuesday night) in the CIT semifinals.

West Coast Conference, ESPN Announce Eight-Year Extension

The West Coast Conference and ESPN announced an eight-year contract extension in June that will make the ESPN networks the conference's men's basketball national television home through the 2018-19 school year. According to the agreement, the WCC will receive a minimum of 48 annual men's basketball appearances on the ESPN networks from the 2011-12 through the 2018-19 seasons. This year, more than 30 WCC games will be televised on the ESPN Networks.

WEST COAST CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE YEAR



Matthew Dellavedova, Jr., Saint Mary's

Matthew Dellavedova becomes the seventh player in the history of Saint Mary's College – and the second straight Gael (Mickey McConnell, 2011) – to be named West Coast Conference Player of the Year. A finalist for the Bob Cousy Award given annually to the nation's top point guard, Dellavedova leads the West Coast Conference in assists per game with 6.6, while ranking third in scoring at 16.4 points per contest during WCC play. He led this year's Gaels to a 14-2 WCC record – setting a new school mark for the most conference victories in a season.

Dellavedova was later named the 2012 Zappos.com West Coast Conference Basketball Championship Tournament Most Valuable Player.

★ Down 49-24, BYU rallied to top Iona by a 78-72 score in the NCAA Opening Round Tuesday night in Dayton. It was the largest comeback in NCAA Tournament history.

★ BYU put together its sixth straight season of 25+ wins in 2011-12, and the Cougars made their sixth straight NCAA Tournament appearance under head coach Dave Rose.

★ Junior **Brandon Davies** and senior **Noah Hartsock** were each named to the All-West Coast Conference Team. Freshman **Matt Carlino** was named honorable mention.

★ During conference play, junior forward **Brandon Davies** topped the WCC in scoring (18.0 points per game) and ranked fourth in rebounding (8.1 boards per contest). Davies was named to the NABC All-District 9 Second Team.

★ BYU fell 88-68 to No.3 Marquette in the NCAA Second Round, concluding its season with a 26-9 record.

★ Both **Elias Harris** and Pangos were named to the 2012 Zappos.com WCC Basketball Championships All-Tournament Team. Harris was also named to the NABC All-District 9 First Team.

★ Harris, Sacre, and Pangos were all named to the All-WCC Team. Pangos and **Gary Bell, Jr.** were recognized on the All-Freshman Team.

★ The No. 7 Bulldogs concluded their season with a 73-66 setback to No. 2 seed Ohio State in the NCAA Third Round in Pittsburgh.
