Game 8: #1, Gonzaga 65, #2 Saint Mary's 51

Gonzaga did not trail over the final 32 minutes of regulation en route to its third WCC Championship in the past five years. The Bulldogs were dominant around the rim outscoring the Gaels 42-18 in the paint. Elias Harris was named the WCC Tournament MVP and finished with 19 points in the title game.

Kelly Olynyk collected his fourth double-double of the season with 21 points and 12 boards. He and Harris combined for 40 of the team's 65 points. Defensively the Bulldogs held the Gaels to their season-low scoring output of 51 points.

Stephen Holt led Saint Mary's with 19 points on 8-of-14 shooting including three 3-pointers. The rest of the Gaels roster shot just 12-for-42 (.286) overall and 4-for-19 (.211) from beyond the arc. Matthew Dellavedova was held to a season-low two points in his Saint Mary's program record 134th career game.
