Key WCC Postseason Notes

★ For just the second time in WCC history, four men's basketball teams advanced to postseason play. Gonzaga and Saint Mary's earned bids to the NCAA Tournament, while Loyola Marymount and Portland competed in the Collegeinsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT). The only other time in league history that four teams advanced to the postseason in the same year was in 1989.

★ The WCC is one of 11 conferences in the country to have a team in the Sweet Sixteen.

★ This marks the second straight season, and the third time in the last five years, that the WCC has had a team advance to the Sweet Sixteen.

★ The WCC is one of only seven conferences to have a team advance to the Sweet Sixteen in 2009 and 2010 (ACC, A-10, Big East, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-10, WCC).

★ Saint Mary's is the fifth WCC school to reach the NCAA Tournament Sweet Sixteen (GON, LMU, USF, SCU are the others).

★ With the Gonzaga women advancing to the Sweet Sixteen on Monday, it marks the first time in WCC history that the league has a team in the final 16 in both fields in the same season.

#18/22 Gonzaga Bulldogs (27-7 / 12-2 WCC)

★ Gonzaga ended its season with an 87-65 loss to Syracuse in the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

★ The Zags are tied with Texas and Wisconsin for the fifth longest active consecutive NCAA Tournament streak with 12 straight appearances.

★ Gonzaga has won 10 consecutive WCC regular season titles, extending the nation's longest conference regular season title streak and tying Connecticut (Yankee Conference - 1951-60) and UNLV (Big West - 1983-92) for the second longest streak in NCAA history.

★ Senior **Matt Bouldin** was named the WCC Player of the Year, while freshman **Elias Harris** was selected as the conference's Newcomer of the Year and Head Coach **Mark Few** was tabbed for Coach of the Year honors. Bouldin's selection marks the ninth time in the last 10 years a Bulldog has been named the top player in the conference as voted by the coaches.



Loyola Marymount Lions (18-16 / 7-7 WCC)

★ The Lions ended their season by dropping an 86-76 decision to Pacific in the first round of the CollegeInsider.com Tournament.

★ The Lions game against Pacific was their first postseason game since their historic run through the NCAA Tournament in 1990 and the first-ever Lions' postseason game hosted at Gersten Pavilion.

★ With a roster that features no seniors, LMU's 15-game improvement from last season is the second best turn-around in the nation this season. Coastal Carolina is tops with a 17-game improvement.

★ Junior **Vernon Teel** and sophomore **Drew Viney** were selected to the All-WCC First Team, while freshman **Ashley Hamilton** was selected to the All-WCC Freshman Team. Viney and Teel become just the 11th LMU duo to take home first-team All-WCC honors.



Pepperdine Waves (7-24 / 3-11 WCC)

★ The Waves fell just short against rival Loyola Marymount, 87-84, in the first round of the West Coast Conference Tournament.

★ Sophomore guard **Keion Bell** led the Waves with 25 points against the Lions, marking his 15th game this season with 20 or more points. Sophomore forward **Taylor Darby** posted a career-high 18 points on 6-for-9 shooting and added 12 rebounds for his second double-double of the season.

★ Bell and junior forward **Mychel Thompson** earned All-West Coast Conference honorable mention. Bell needs just 13 more points to become the 35th player in Pepperdine history to surpass 1,000 career points.

★ There are no seniors on Pepperdine's 2009-10 squad, and 11 of the 15 players are underclassmen. The roster features four juniors, seven sophomores and four true freshmen.



Portland Pilots (21-11 / 10-4 WCC)

★ The Portland Pilots closed out their season with an 81-73 loss at Northern Colorado in the first round of the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT).

★ The consecutive postseason appearances (2009-2010) marked the first time in school history, while the 21 victories matched a Division I school record. The Pilots also matched the best WCC record in school history with a 10-4 mark this season.

★ Senior guard **Nik Raivio**, the team's leading scorer, missed the final 15 games of the season with a lingering Achilles' strain.

★ Seniors **T.J. Campbell** and **Robin Smeulders** were named to the All-WCC first team, while juniors **Jared Stohl** and **Luke Sikma** earned honorable mention honors. The four players recognized were the most of any school in the league.

Saint Mary's Gaels (28-5 / 11-3 WCC)

★ Saint Mary's defeated Richmond, 80-71, and Villanova, 75-68, to earn a spot in the Sweet Sixteen.

★ The Gaels (28-5) have tied the record for the most wins in program history and won their first NCAA Tournament game since 1959.

★ Senior center **Omar Samhan** owns the SMC single-season scoring record with 709 points this year, ranking 11th on the WCC's all-time single season list. He also ranks second on the Gaels' career scoring list with 1,831 career points, trailing former SMC standout Daniel Kickert's school record of 1,874 points by 43 points.

★ Samhan was named the WCC Defensive Player of the Year and was joined on the All-WCC first team by junior **Mickey McConnell**, while **Matthew Dellavedova** was selected to the All-WCC freshman team.



San Diego Toreros (11-21 / 3-11 WCC)

★ The Toreros defeated Santa Clara, 61-59, in the first round of the Zappos.com WCC Tournament before falling to Portland, 72-57, in the quarterfinals.

★ Senior guard **Brandon Johnson** closed out his brilliant career as USD's all-time leader in points (1,790) and assists (525). He is the only player in WCC history to lead his team in both career statistical categories. Johnson's 1,790 career points rank 17th on the WCC's all-time list, while his 525 career assists rank just outside the WCC's top 10.

★ Senior **Roberto Mafra** set a new USD single-game record with seven blocked shots in the Toreros' win over Santa Clara.

★ Freshman forward **Chris Manresa** was selected to the WCC All-Freshman team. In WCC play he scored in double-digits four times and notched two double-doubles.



San Francisco Dons (12-18 / 7-7 WCC)

★ San Francisco ended its season with an 84-76 loss to Loyola Marymount in the quarterfinals of the Zappos.com WCC Basketball Championships.

★ Senior forward **Dior Lowhorn** was named to the All-WCC first team for the third consecutive season. Lowhorn scored 18 points and grabbed nine rebounds in his final game in the Green and Gold. For his career, Lowhorn topped 2,000 points, finishing with 2,003. The fifth-year senior scored 230 as a true freshman at Texas Tech in 2005-06. Lowhorn finished his career ranked fourth on the Dons' all-time scoring chart with 1,773 points.

★ USF's seven WCC triumphs are the most since going 8-6 in 2007.

★ Sophomore forward **Angelo Caloairo** provided the Dons with a big lift this season, ranking third on the team in scoring with 8.9 ppg. Caloairo developed into one of the top three-point shooters in the conference, knocking down .491 percent of his attempts from beyond the arc.



Santa Clara Broncos (11-21 / 3-11 WCC)

★ The Broncos ended the season with a 61-59 loss to San Diego in the first round of the Zappos.com WCC Basketball Championships.

★ Sophomore forward **Marc Trasolini** and freshman point guard **Robert Smith** earned league honors. Trasolini was named to the All-WCC honorable mention team and Smith was named to the five-man WCC All-Freshman team. Trasolini led the team with 13.7 ppg, 6.1 rpg and 1.6 bpg, while Smith is second on the team with 12.1 ppg.

★ Sophomore guard **Kevin Foster**, the 2008-09 WCC Co-Newcomer of the Year, missed a majority of the season with a right foot injury. Foster, who was averaging 19.8 points per game this season, injured his foot in the final minutes of Santa Clara's 79-68 victory at UC Santa Barbara on Dec. 1.

★ The Broncos featured the seventh-youngest team in the country (statsheet.com).

2010 WCC ALL-CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL TEAM ANNOUNCED

Gonzaga's Matt Bouldin Named WCC Player Of The Year

SAN BRUNO, Calif. — The Gonzaga Bulldogs captured their record 10th consecutive WCC regular season title crown and were reward with three of the four yearly conference awards. Gonzaga senior Matt Bouldin was named the WCC Player of the Year, while freshman Elias Harris was named the Newcomer of the Year, and head coach Mark Few was selected as the Coach of the Year. Saint Mary's senior Omar Samhan was named the conference's Defensive Player of the Year.

Bouldin becomes the 11th different Gonzaga player to earn the league's top honor and the ninth Bulldog to be selected Player of the Year in the last 10 years. Bouldin is the senior leader for the Bulldogs' squad which tied Connecticut (1951-60 Yankee Conference) and UNLV (1983-92 Big West) for the second-longest conference regular season title winning streak in NCAA history. UCLA is first with 13 straight Pacific-10 Conference titles from 1967-79. Bouldin, who was named to the Naismith Trophy Mid-Season Top 30 list and is a finalist for the Cousey Award, leads the Bulldogs in scoring at 16.0 ppg, assists with 4.14/game and assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.87. He has 1,617 career points to rank ninth all-time, his 428 career assists rank fifth and his 166 steals are third.

Samhan becomes the third Saint Mary's player to earn WCC Defensive Player of the Year honors. The San Ramon, Calif. native follows former teammate Diamon Simpson, who took home the award the previous two seasons. Samhan enters the WCC Tournament as the Gaels' all-time leader in blocked shots with 243. He currently ranks third on the WCC's career blocked shots record and is just four blocks shy of moving past 2009 WCC Player of the Year John Bryant of Santa Clara, for second place. Samhan also ranks second on the Gaels' career rebounds chart and 14th on the WCC's all-time list with 1,056 career boards.

Harris becomes the second Gonzaga player to earn WCC Newcomer of the Year honors, joining J.P. Batista (2005), since the award replaced the WCC Freshman of the Year award in 2003-04. The freshman from Speyer, Germany has made an immediate impact in the Zags' lineup ranking second on the team in scoring (15.1 ppg), while leading the team in rebounding (7.4 rpg).

The top coaching honor is Few's WCC record eighth overall, with all of them coming in the last 10 years. No other coach in WCC history has won more than four. Gonzaga has won at least 20 games in each of Few's 11 years on the Bulldog bench. This season, he has led the Zags to a 24-5 record and their 10th consecutive WCC regular season title.

WCC Ranked No. 9 In Non-Conference Strength Of Schedule

West Coast Conference men's basketball teams have played very challenging non-conference schedules, leading to the WCC's No. 9 non-conference strength of schedule rating, according to the latest Collegiate Basketball News report.

WCC Best In The West Against The BCS

West Coast Conference teams are proving to be formidable opponents for teams from the BCS conferences. Of the four conferences primarily located in the West Region – WCC, Pac-10, Big West, and WAC – the WCC owns the most wins and the highest winning percentage against teams from the six BCS conferences with a 14-17 record. The Pac-10 is second with a 9-24 (.272) mark against teams from other BCS conferences, followed by the Big West (2-19; .095), and the WAC (0-7).

Gonzaga Edges Portland For Top Spot in 2009-10 WCC Preseason Coaches Poll

Gonzaga was selected as the favorite to capture an unprecedented 10th consecutive West Coast Conference men's basketball regular season title in the 2009-10 WCC Preseason Coaches Poll. The Zags received six first place votes and tallied 48 points to narrowly edge out Portland, which received the remaining two first place votes and collected 44 overall points. Saint Mary's was picked third with 34 overall points, followed by San Francisco and Santa Clara, which tied for fourth with 26 points. Conference play will start on Friday, Jan. 8 with Saint Mary's at San Francisco and San Diego at Santa Clara.
