WCC Champion

The 2010 West Coast Conference men's soccer championship race came down to the final moments of the season with Santa Clara University and Loyola Marymount University sharing the regular season title. Both teams finished atop the standings with 25 points, as Santa Clara finished 7-1-4 and Loyola Marymount went 8-3-1.

The Broncos earned the West Coast Conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Men's Soccer Championship based on a 1-0-1 head-to-head record this season against the Lions. The tournament berth marks Santa Clara's 19th NCAA tournament appearance and 11th WCC title, its first since 2007. After a two-year playoff hiatus, the Broncos were picked to finish fifth in the seven-team WCC this season.

NCAA Tournament Results

Santa Clara earned the West Coast Conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Men's Soccer Championship based on a 1-0-1 head-to-head record this season against the Lions. The tournament berth marked the Broncos' 19th NCAA tournament appearance and 11th WCC title, its first since 2007.

Santa Clara fell 2-1 in the first round of the 2010 NCAA College Cup tournament at Sacramento State on Thursday, November 18th. Junior forward Eric Masch scored the equalizer for the Broncos in the 58th minute, but the Hornets came through with the game-winner with four minutes left in the match to advance.

THE WCC'S NCAA TOURNAMENT TRADITION

The West Coast Conference has been represented in the postseason classic 84 times since the competition began in 1959, with the league claiming five national titles during that stretch. San Francisco's participation dates back to the inaugural event, and the Dons pace all WCC teams with four national crowns. Santa Clara owns the fifth national title, sharing the 1989 championship with Virginia. SCU also appeared in the national championship game in both 1991 and 1999, while San Diego played for the NCAA title in 1992. Portland advanced to the College Cup in both 1988 and 1995. WCC teams have made eight College Cup appearances since 1988, with Santa Clara making the conference's last trip to college soccer's "Final Four" in 2003.
