The College Cup Kicks Off



Four West Coast Conference men's soccer teams were selected to participate in the 2004 NCAA Tournament. **San Francisco**, the WCC regular season champions, earned the conference's automatic bid, while **Loyola Marymount**, **Portland** and **Santa Clara** received at-large bids. The four bids from the WCC were the fourth most of all the Division I conferences. The Big Ten led all conferences with six teams, while the ACC and Big East had five representatives. The top 16 teams among the field were seeded and awarded a first round bye. Wake Forest (13-5-1) was the No. 1 seed in the tournament, followed by No. 2 Indiana (14-4-1), No. 3 Maryland (15-5-1), No. 4 Virginia (17-4-0) and No. 5 Notre Dame (13-2-3). The second round will be played on Tuesday, November 23rd. Winners of the second round matches will move on to play the third round on November 27th, while the NCAA Quarterfinals will also be played on campus sites on December 4th. The Home Depot Center in Carson, Calif. will host the 2004 NCAA College Cup, December 10-12th.

San Francisco, who captured its first conference title since 1994, and first solo crown since 1991, will host Horizon League Champion Wisconsin-Milwaukee Saturday at 1:00 p.m. in the first round of the NCAA men's soccer tournament. The winner advances to play at UC

Santa Barbara the following Tuesday. **Loyola Marymount** will host Cal State Northridge in the first round of the NCAA Men's Soccer Tournament. The game is set for Saturday at noon at Sullivan Field on the campus of LMU. **Portland** earned an at-large bid to the 48-team 2004 NCAA Men's Soccer Tournament and will play Washington (11-6-2) in the first round this Friday, November 19 at 6 p.m. in Seattle. The Pilots (11-7-2) were one of 25 teams to earn an at-large selection, after 23 programs earned automatic playoff bids via conference titles. **Santa Clara** University will face the University of California in the first round of the 2004 NCAA Men's Soccer Championship. The Broncos, who advanced to the College Cup a year ago, will travel to Berkeley, Calif. for their match-up on Friday at 1:30 p.m.

The Glendale, Ariz. product scored two first half goals in USF's 4-1 victory over Portland. McDonald then assisted on Aaron Chandler's game-winning goal in the Dons' 1-0 win over Gonzaga. The win over Gonzaga clinched the WCC crown for USF. For his efforts over the week-end, McDonald was selected by *College Soccer News* as a member of its team of the week. McDonald now has four goals and will lead USF into its first round NCAA Tournament match this week against UW Milwaukee at Negoesco Stadium.

GONZAGA BULLDOGS (6-14-0 / 2-10-0 WCC)

Gonzaga finished off its season with a 2-0 loss to Saint Mary's in Moraga and a 1-0 loss to USF in San Francisco ... Against USF, goalie **Dade Smith** made eight saves ... Smith made his fifth appearance and fourth start of the year ... In losing 14 matches, GU was shutout a school-record 13 times ... **Arni Pjetursson** completed his career with 15 goals, good for seventh place on Gonzaga's career list, and 13 assists, which tied him for fourth all-time ... Freshman **George Josten** put together a successful initial campaign with five goals and one assist.



LOYOLA MARYMOUNT (10-7-3 / 8-3-1 WCC)

Loyola Marymount concluded its season with a 1-0 loss to Santa Clara at Buck Shaw Stadium ... LMU surrendered the game-winning goal at the 88:03 mark ... With the loss to SCU, the Lions fell to second place in the WCC standings ... LMU would have won its first-ever soccer championship with a win ... The Lions were led throughout the year by **Armando Melendez** (5 g, 8 ast.) and a pair of freshmen in **Diego Barrera** (5 g, 3 ast) and **Nick Blanco** (5 g, 3 ast) ... Goalie **Robert Flores** collected four shutouts in net ... Melendez is now tied for eighth place all-time with 11 assists ... **Matt Kovar** totaled five assists this year and now places second all-time at LMU with 19 ... LMU will host Cal-State Northridge on Saturday, November 20 at 12 pm at Sullivan Field for an NCAA Tournament match.



PORTLAND PILOTS (11-7-2 / 6-5-1 WCC)

Portland split weekend matches to end WCC play ... The Pilots were defeated by San Francisco, 4-1, and then gained a 3-1 victory over Saint Mary's ... Against USF, **Chris Sanders** netted the Pilots' lone goal as they fell behind 3-1 at the half ... Against Saint Mary's, Portland came out firing and collected 13 shots, nine of which were on goal ... **Heath Pearce** tallied six shots and one goal, while **Alejandro Salazar** had a goal and an assist ... Goalie **Luis Robles** recorded seven saves between the posts and collected his 11th victory ... Salazar scored first at the 15:20 mark as **Miguel Guante** had the assist ... Sanders collected his second goal of the weekend at the 36:28 mark on an assist from Salazar ... **Paul Robinson** finished out the scoring for Portland at the 50:21 mark with a score off a Pearce assist ... Portland will travel to Seattle, Wash. for an NCAA Tournament match against Washington ... The Pilots will play on Friday, November 19 at 6 pm at Husky Soccer Field.



SAINT MARY'S GAELS (5-10-5 / 2-8-2 WCC)

Saint Mary's collected a 2-0 victory over Gonzaga and dropped a 3-1 to Portland decision to finish out its season in Moraga ... Against Gonzaga, **Derek Youpel** posted a goal and an assist in the win, while **Matt Walker** netted his first score of the season ... SMC started quickly as **Jaime Joaquin** and Youpel teamed-up to find Walker in the penalty area for the score in the ninth minute ... **David Blanchard** hooked-up with Youpel just eight minutes into the second-half to finish out SMC's scoring efforts ... The score marked Youpel's team-leading sixth of the season ... Goalie **Brian Mason** collected the shutout and finished the year with five and one-half ... Mason ends the year half a shutout away from tying the single-season mark of six ... **Diego Rovira** led SMC with six shots ... Six different Gaels collected one shot ... Against Portland, Youpel added his seventh score as **Erik Robert** and **Corey Watts** assisted on the goal.



SAN DIEGO TOREROS (7-10-3 / 4-6-2 WCC)

San Diego ended its year with two road losses ... USD was shutout by No. 4 UCLA, 4-0, and then fell to Santa Clara, 1-0 ... The Toreros managed only two shots against UCLA ... Against SCU, USD fell behind, 1-0, in the 26th minute and couldn't convert any of its five shots on goal ... **Ryan Guy** paced USD in scoring with 15 points ... Guy netted three goals and totaled nine assists ... **Michael Caso** added six goals and two assists on the year ... In goal, **Lance Friesz** posted five shutouts.



SAN FRANCISCO DONS (14-4-1 / 9-3-0 WCC)

With a 4-1 victory over Portland and a 1-0 win against Gonzaga, San Francisco wrapped up first place in the WCC and gained the conference's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament ... The WCC title marks USF's first since 1994 and the school's first solo crown since 1991 ... **Aaron Chandler** netted his seventh game-winner and 12th score overall in the clinching win over Gonzaga ... Freshman **Brandon McDonald** assisted on the play ... Chandler has six game-winners in WCC contests and five in one-goal games ... USF recorded 20 shots and ended the regular season by winning nine out of its final 10 matches ... Goalie **Jeremy Uhl** started in net and posted his fifth shutout, all in WCC play ... Against Portland, USF took a 3-1 lead into halftime as McDonald netted two first half scores and **David Martin** scored a third ... Chandler set-up the Martin score, while McDonald scored his two goals on a penalty kick and converted a **Cameron Kolovos** free kick ... Kolovos scored the lone second half goal for USF ... The Dons outshot Portland, 15-9 ... USF's four goals are the most scored against Portland since 1982 ... San Francisco will play UW-Milwaukee in the first round of the NCAA Tournament on Saturday, November 20 at 1 pm at Negoesco Stadium.



SANTA CLARA BRONCOS (15-5-0 / 8-4-0 WCC)

Santa Clara ended its season with two home victories ... SCU thwarted Loyola Marymount's attempt to claim the WCC crown with a 1-0 victory at Buck Shaw Stadium ... **Keith DeVey** netted the game-winner at the 88:03 mark ... The goal was DeVey's fourth and his second game-winner ... **Medhi Ballouchy** set-up the score for his team-leading eighth assist ... Freshman goalie, **Christopher Moreo** made his first collegiate start in goal and recorded the shutout ... Against San Diego, **Erik Ustruck** scored a goal in the 26th minute and SCU's defense notched its 11th shutout of the season ... The score was Ustruck's first of the year ... **Kent Harkness** and Moreo each played 45 minutes in net ... Moreo collected four saves ... SCU will play at UC Berkeley on Friday, November 19 at 1:30 pm in an NCAA Tournament match.

AROUND THE WCC

NCAA History:

Four WCC schools gained NCAA Tournament berths in Portland, Loyola Marymount, San Francisco and Santa Clara. For the second consecutive season, the WCC has been awarded with four postseason entries. Four bids matches the second highest totaled in conference history. Last season, Loyola Marymount, Portland, San Diego and Santa Clara advanced into the tournament. All four WCC schools played into the second round, marking the first time ever that four WCC teams played second round matches in the same season. Santa Clara went on a run to its fifth NCAA College Cup. SCU lost in the semifinals to eventual champion Indiana, 1-0, in double-overtime. In 2001, for the first time in league history, the conference had five teams in the NCAA Tournament. The WCC has been represented in the tournament 67 times and has won five titles. USF has won four titles, while Santa Clara has won one.

USF's McDonald Honored:

Freshman forward Brandon McDonald was selected by *College Soccer News* as a member of its team of the week for his efforts against Portland and Gonzaga. The Glendale, Ariz. product netted two goals in USF's 4-1 victory over Portland and then added an assist in the Dons' WCC title clinching win. McDonald was a McDonald's All-American at Cactus High School. McDonald finished his freshman campaign with four goals.

GAMES TO WATCH

PORTLAND AT WASHINGTON-FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 19 AT 6:00 PM PST

This NCAA Tournament game is a rematch as the two schools met in Portland on September 15. The Pilots came away with a 2-1 victory as Chris Sanders netted the game-winner.

UW-MILWAUKEE AT SAN FRANCISCO-SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 20 AT 1:00 PM PST

The Dons are back in the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1994. USF enters this match-up having won nine out of its last 10 games. Forward Aaron Chandler leads USF with 12 goals and racked up seven game-winners this year.

CS NORTHRIDGE AT LOYOLA MARYMOUNT-SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 20 AT 12:00 PM PST

Loyola Marymount gains an NCAA berth for the fourth straight year and will look to rebound from a 1-0 loss to Santa Clara to end regular season play. Matt Kovar and the LMU defense posted four shutouts in conference play.

SANTA CLARA AT UC BERKELEY-FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 19 AT 1:30 PM PST

A non-conference repeat as UC Berkeley edged Santa Clara, 1-0, at Buck Shaw Stadium on September 26. SCU enters this match on a two-game winning streak and have won four out of its last six. The Bronco defense has notched 11 shutouts this year.
