QUICK HITS

★ San Diego advanced to the WNIT Final Four with a 58-47 win at Washington on Sunday. Senior Morgan Woodrow scored a game-high 21 points for USD. San Diego will face Oklahoma State on Wednesday at 7:00 p.m. CT in Stillwater, Okla. The Final Four matchup will be televised nationally on CBS Sports Network.

★ The Toreros are seeking to become the second WCC team ever to win a WNIT championship (Santa Clara, '91).

★ San Diego recorded its first ever postseason victory in a 60-58 win over Cal State Northridge in the first round of the WNIT. The Toreros have also defeated Pacific, Texas Tech and Washington en route to the Final Four of the WNIT. The Toreros' 26 wins this season surpassed the previous program mark of 22 wins.

★ After advancing to its third consecutive NCAA Sweet 16, No. 11 Gonzaga fell 79-62 to No. 2 Kentucky on Sunday in Kingston, Rhode Island. Senior Kayla Standish paced the Bulldogs with 25 points. The Zags end the season with a 28-6 record.

★ BYU senior Haley Steed was named one of eight finalists for the Nancy Lieberman Award, given to the nation's top guard. The winner will be announced during the NCAA Final Four weekend April 1 through 3.

BYU senior Kristen Riley is the 2012 WCC Women's Basketball Player of the Year. Riley led the WCC with 9.3 rebounds and was fifth in the conference with 14.4 points per game during WCC play. The senior forward shot .439 from beyond the arc, good for second in the WCC.

★ BYU senior guard Haley Steed was named the WCC Tournament MVP after averaging 10.5 points and eight assists in two games for the Cougars in Las Vegas. Steed also had averaged two steals and had a 2.7 assist to turnover ratio.

★ BYU sophomore center Jennifer Hamson earned a spot on the all-tournament team after scoring 13.5 points per game and pulling down 8.5 rebounds per contest. Hamson also shot 60% from the field.

★ Gonzaga redshirt-sophomore Haiden Palmer was named to the all-tournament team after she scored 21 points per game and shot 58% from the field. Palmer also had seven steals in two games for the Bulldogs in Vegas.

★ BYU sophomore Dani Peterson scored a career-high 18 points along with 12 rebounds as BYU defeated San Diego in the semifinals of the WCC Basketball Championships. Peterson led the WCC with a .786 shooting-percentage in Vegas to earn a spot on the all-tournament team.

★ Gonzaga senior Kayla Standish scored 24.5 points per game and 6.5 rebounds per game in the WCC basketball championships to garner all-tournament honors. Standish's 31 points against Saint Mary's in the semifinals was the second highest point total in the tournament and just three points off of the WCC tournament record.
