## QUICK HITS

★ This year marked the first time since 2005 four West Coast Conference teams participated in the NCAA Tournament.

★ All four WCC first round matches went to overtime, with San Diego (UC Irvine) and Portland (Oregon State) advancing via penalty kicks on the road. Santa Clara (Cal) and Pepperdine (LBSU) fell in OT at home.

★ West Coast Conference members have made 65 NCAA Tournament appearances, 19 Final Four appearances, and have won three national titles (Santa Clara in 2001, Portland in 2002, 2005).

★ San Diego senior Natalie Garcia is the WCC Defensive Player of the Year, and Santa Clara senior Bianca Henninger is the winner of the first-ever WCC Goalkeeper of the Year award.

★ Pepperdine's Lynn Williams garnered WCC Freshman of the Year recognition, and Waves' head man Tim Ward was voted WCC Coach of the Year by his peers.

## WCC PLAYER OF THE YEAR



Stephanie Ochs, USD

San Diego senior striker Stephanie Ochs became the first Torero to ever be named West Coast Conference Player of the Year. Ochs tied for the conference lead with 13 points during WCC play, while registering nine assists in eight WCC matches. Overall, Ochs has scored 8 goals with 13 assists this season.

## **WCC Women's Soccer All-Conference Teams Announced** *San Diego, Pepperdine take two top individual honors each*

**SAN BRUNO, Calif.** – After sharing the 2011 West Coast Conference title, Pepperdine and San Diego each claimed two WCC individual accolades. San Diego senior Stephanie Ochs is the WCC Player of the Year, and teammate Natalie Garcia is the Defensive Player of the Year. Pepperdine's Lynn Williams is the Freshman of the Year, while Tim Ward was recognized by his peers as the Coach of the Year. Santa Clara senior Bianca Henninger was named the inaugural West Coast Conference Goalkeeper of the Year.

Ochs becomes the first San Diego player to be recognized as the WCC Player of the Year. The Toreros reeled off seven straight conference wins to earn a share of the 2011 WCC championship for the first time in school history. Ochs tied for the conference lead with 13 points during WCC play, while leading the West Coast Conference with nine assists in eight conference matches. For the season, Ochs scored eight goals and registered 11 assists.

Ochs' teammate Natalie Garcia was named the WCC Defensive Player of the Year by the league's nine head coaches. The senior becomes the third San Diego player to win the award, joining Brittany Cameron (2008) and Dawn Birdsall (1995) as Defensive Player of the Year honorees. Garcia and the Toreros defense allowed just four goals during conference play, while posting four WCC shutouts – including three straight to end the season.

Santa Clara's Bianca Henninger is the first West Coast Conference Goalkeeper of the Year. Henninger made 26 saves during conference play, posting a pair of shutouts. A leader on the field for the Broncos, Henninger helped her team to a 13-2-5 record while posting a 0.65 goals against average for the season.

Lynn Williams is the first Pepperdine player to be named WCC Freshman of the Year since Lacey Ubaldi in 2000. Williams burst onto the scene in 2011, scoring six goals and dishing out eight assists in her debut season while helping the Waves to their first WCC crown in nearly a decade and their first postseason berth in six years.

After leading his squad to its first WCC title since 2002 and first NCAA berth since 2005, Tim Ward was named the WCC Coach of the Year. Under Ward's guidance, Pepperdine posted a 15-1-4 record in 2011, earning a No. 8 national ranking and the WCC's automatic NCAA berth. It is the second Coach of the Year honor for Ward, who also captured that award in 2002.

For the first time since 2005, four West Coast Conference teams will compete for the Women's Soccer College Cup. Pepperdine, Portland, San Diego, and Santa Clara will all compete in the 2011 NCAA Tournament, which begins on Friday. The West Coast Conference has been represented 19 times in the Final Four, and has produced three national champions.

## **West Coast Conference Announces 2011 Women's Soccer All-Academic Team** *Conference honors excellence in the classroom and on the pitch*

**SAN BRUNO, Calif.** – The West Coast Conference is pleased to announce the 2011 West Coast Conference Women's Soccer All-Academic Team. Four members of this year's team appeared on the 2010 All-Academic Team, and six 2011 All-Academic selections were also voted all-conference for their work on the pitch by the league's nine head coaches.

At the conclusion of each athletic season, the WCC selects an all-academic squad for each WCC-sponsored sport. To be considered, a student-athlete must maintain at least a 3.20 cumulative grade point average, while also being a significant contributor to her team.
