Equipment: Wear athletic-type clothing (shorts/t-shirts, etc). Wear tennis shoes, bring sweat pants (for sliding), your glove and a sack lunch (if staying for both sessions). If you own a bat, helmet, and water bottle, please bring them, as well.

Pitching/Catching Sessions: Pitchers will focus on how to get the most out of pitches and when and how to use them. Innovative drills and conditioning exercises will help develop pitchers in all aspects of the game. Catchers will learn how to set-up and frame pitches, block balls, protect against wild pitches, field bunts, and take charge of the field of play.

Defensive Sessions: Instruction will include basic softball fundamentals for all levels of play. Skill development will include throwing and fielding. Sessions will also include segments on defensive strategies, conditioning, and circuit training.

Offensive Sessions: Instruction will include basic hitting fundamentals. Individual skill development will focus on hitting, bunting, base running and offensive strategies.
