

**HEALTH HISTORY, TREATMENT CONSENT & MEDICATION  
ADMINISTRATION  
FAQS**

**MY CHILD IS ATTENDING MULTIPLE CAMPS. DO I NEED TO COMPLETE THE MEDICAL INFORMATION FOR EACH CAMP HE/SHE WILL BE ATTENDING?**

No. Once the health form is completed online we will have this information available to us for any camp(s) your child attends.

**MY CHILD IS NOT ABLE TO GET A TETNUS BOOSTER. WILL HE/SHE STILL BE ABLE TO ATTEND CAMP?**

Yes. Your child will be allowed to attend camp without the booster shot.

**IS A PHYSICAL EXAMINATION REQUIRED PRIOR TO ATTENDING CAMP?**

No. A physical is recommended, however, not required.

**DO WE NEED TO LIST OVER THE COUNTER MEDICATIONS MY CHILD WILL BE BRINGING TO CAMP?**

Yes. All medications should be listed on the Consent for Medication Administration portion of the online medical information form regardless of age. If the camper is under the age of 18, all medications must be maintained and distributed by the Health Services Staff.

**MY CHILD WAS NOT TAKING MEDICATION AT THE TIME WE REGISTERED HIM/HER FOR CAMP, HOWEVER, HE/SHE IS NOW TAKING MEDICATION. DO I NEED TO SEND IN A NEW FORM?**

No. Any medications not listed in the medical information portion of the online registration information should be brought to the attention of the Health Services Staff when you check your child in for camp. They will have you write down the required information. If you will not be transporting your child to his/her camp, please have your child present a signed and dated note from you along with the medication information when he/she checks in for their camp. Please note that you can add or change information online up until the start of camp and we encourage you to do so if necessary.

**CAN MY CHILD BRING THE CONFIDENTIAL HEALTH HISTORY, CONSENT FOR TREATMENT AND MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION TO REGISTRATION RATHER THAN MAILING OR FAXING PRIOR TO CAMP?**

We would prefer that all of your child's information be completed online **prior** to him/her checking in for camp. It will ensure the confidentiality of your child's medical information and allows our health services personnel to review any significant medical conditions prior to your child arriving for camp.

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
