Wisconsin defeated North Dakota, 4-1, in the third-place game of the 2009 WCHA Final Five on March 21.

Series Notes

The games will mark the 154th and 155th meeting of the series ... UW went 3-2-0 against UND last season, splitting in Grand Forks and Madison, and winning in St. Paul, Minn. ... the Badgers have won the last two games in the series ... UND sophomore forward David Toews was teammates with UW sophomore forwards Derek Stepan and Jordy Murray at Shattuck-St. Marys ... UW equipment manager Nate LaPoint is a 2009 UND graduate and brother of current UND junior defenseman Derrick LaPoint ... UND rookie Mike Cichy was teammates with UW junior goalie Brett Bennett last year with the Indiana Ice of the USHL ... after an 0-6-1 start, Wisconsin got its first victory of the year last year on Nov. 1 at North Dakota ... UW is 5-1-0 in its last six games at Ralph Engelstad Arena

Saturday against the Huskies.

The league's leading scorer in both league and overall statistics, his 1.60 points-per-game rank second in the country among all players and leads all defensemen. His 24 total points share third in the nation among all players and leads the country's defenders. His seven goals also lead the nation's defenders.

► Senior Blake Geoffrion (Brentwood, Tenn.) tallied his first career hat trick last Friday against Michigan Tech. The hat trick was the first for a Badgers since Jack Skille on Jan. 27, 2007 against Minnesota State at the Kohl Center.

All three of Geoffrion's goals came on the power play, which tied the UW record for power-play goals in a game by one player. Five other Badgers have accomplished the feat, including, most recently, John Byce against Michigan Tech on Nov. 5, 1988.

Key Notes to Consider

► Wisconsin (10-5-1, 7-4-1 WCHA) wraps up the 2009 portion of its 2009-10 season with a trip to North Dakota (9-5-2, 6-5-1 WCHA).

► Wisconsin head coach Mike Eaves is two WCHA victories away from 100 for his career. The Eaves-led Badgers are 98-81-29 in WCHA games since the start of the 2002-03 season.

► Wisconsin's 7-3 victory at No. 7/8 Michigan State on Nov. 27 was its first game of the season against a team ranked at the time of the game. Beginning this weekend, nine of Wisconsin's next 10 games are against teams currently ranked.

According to USCHO.com's RPI, Wisconsin has played the 13th toughest schedule in the nation to date.

► Junior defenseman Brendan Smith is on a career-high seven-game scoring streak after posting two goals and five assists last weekend against Michigan Tech. Smith has five goals and 15 points over his last seven games, which is more points than any other WCHA defenseman has for the entire season.

Smith posted his second career four-assist game last Friday in an 8-2 victory over Michigan Tech, then scored the game-winning tally on his way to a two-goal, one assist night in a 6-0 victory last

▶ Wisconsin's power play has three or more goals in three of its last four games and is 10-for-22 (45.5 percent) during that stretch, despite an 0-for-4 game mixed in. The Badgers went 7-for-13 on the power play last weekend, including a 4-for-8 performance last Saturday against Michigan Tech. The four power-play goals were the most in a game for the Badgers since going 4-for-8 on Oct. 20, 2007 against Robert Morris.

Wisconsin's power play sits fourth in the WCHA and 17th in the nation at 21.3 percent (19-for-89) after ranking 8th (9-for-67 - 13.4 percent) in the WCHA and 48th in the nation just four games ago.

▶ Wisconsin is near the top nationally in a host of statistical categories.

▶ Freshman forward Derek Lee (North Vancouver, British Columbia) scored his first career goal last Friday night and became the 20th different Badger to score a goal this season. That leads the nation.

Lee has points in four of his last five games, including both games last weekend against Michigan Tech. He has 1-6=7 in 12 games this season.

▶ Twenty different Badgers have scored goals this year to lead the country, after freshman Derek Lee tallied his first career goal last Friday against Michigan Tech. Mercyhurst ranks second with 19 different goal scorers.

▶ Senior forward Michael Davies and junior defenseman Brendan Smith both scored two goals against Michigan State on Nov. 27 to become the sixth and seventh Badgers this season to have scored two goals in a game. Senior Ben Street scored twice against Alaska Anchorage on Nov. 14, senior Aaron Bendickson did so on Nov. 13 against UAA, while senior forward Blake Geoffrion had two goals on Nov. 6 against Minnesota and sophomore forwards Derek Stepan and Jordy Murray had two-goal games the previous weekend against New Hampshire (10/30-31).

The last UW hat trick came Jan. 27, 2007 by Jack Skille against Minnesota State.

▶ Wisconsin's penalty kill went a perfect 4-for-4 last Saturday against Michigan Tech, going perfect for the first time after three games with at least one power-play goal allowed. The Badgers were 13-for-18 on the kill (72.2 percent) over the three-game stretch. Wisconsin still ranks ninth in the nation on the penalty kill at 87.7 percent (71-for-81).

▶ Head coach Mike Eaves won his 150th career game at Wisconsin with a 4-1 victory at St. Cloud State on Nov. 21, 2009. The 2009-10 season marks the eighth season for Mike Eaves as head coach at Wisconsin. He is 153-116-35 during his career for the Badgers.

▶ In the UW's 10 victories this season, it has outscored opponents 56-13. Wisconsin has outscored opponents 66-32 for the year.

▶ Wisconsin sits 10-0 when scoring at least four goals and also when leading after two periods.

▶ The Badgers reached the 10-win plateau on Dec. 6, the earliest since the

2005–06 team won its 10th game on Nov. 25. UW won its 10th game last season on Dec. 27, reached 10 wins during 2007–08 on Jan. 18 and in 2006–07 on Jan. 12.

► The Badgers have scored first in 11 of their 15 games this season and sit 9-2-0 in those contests. Two of UW's first goals have come in the first 30 seconds of a game. Blake Geoffrion scored at the 24-second mark on Nov. 6 against Minnesota and Craig Smith tallied 14 seconds into the game against Alaska Anchorage on Nov. 13. Geoffrion leads the Badgers with three goals to open games.

► Wisconsin opened with home series in four of the first five weekends and went 6-3-1, with eight games played at home (5-2-1) and two on the road (1-1-0). Last season, the UW opened with six of its first eight games on the road and started 1-6-1. The Badgers were on the road five of the first seven weekends in 2008–09.

The Badgers are in the midst of three of four weekends on the road. They are 4-2-0 so far during the stretch, including 2-2-0 on the road.

► The UW defensive corps currently sits second in the nation with a 3.50 points-per-game average behind RIT (3.53 in 15 GP). Badger defensemen have 16 goals and 56 points through 14 games. The goal total is tied for second in the country behind RIT (19).

Wisconsin's defensemen finished last season as the second-highest scoring defense in the country with 118 points, 30 goals and a 2.95 points-per-game average. Defenseman Jamie McBain finished as the team's leading scorer.

► Six Badgers have played at least 100 games, including fifth-year senior Ben Street (144), senior Michael Davies (128), senior Blake Geoffrion (122), senior Ben Grotting (122), senior Aaron Bendickson (120) and senior John Mitchell (112).

► The Badgers are 0-6-11 in overtimes since ending the 2006–07 season with a 4-3 overtime victory against St. Cloud State in the 2007 WCHA Final Five third-place game. The Badgers have played in just one overtime game this season, skating to a 1-1 tie against Colorado College on Oct. 17.

Wisconsin last won an overtime game at home on Oct. 7, 2005 during a 3-2 victory over St. Lawrence at the Kohl Center.

Up Next

► The Badgers play host to the 21st annual Badger Hockey Showdown on Jan. 2-3 at the Kohl Center. UW opens with Merrimack, while Ferris State and Yale meet in the other semifinal. The field for this year's Showdown currently has a combined record of 35-18-5.

► There are 11 current Badgers who have been drafted by NHL teams, including five defensemen. Of the 11 draft picks, three have been drafted in the first round and four have been drafted in the second round. Also, there are three pairs of Badgers whose NHL rights are owned by the same team, including Derek Stepan and Ryan McDonagh (New York Rangers); Blake Geoffrion and Craig Smith (Nashville) and Jake Gardiner and Justin Schultz (Anaheim).

► Three current Badgers have fathers who have played in the NHL including Blake Geoffrion (Danny), Patrick Johnson (Mark) and John Ramage (Rob). A fourth, Derek Stepan (Brad), had a father drafted by an NHL team.

► For the second consecutive season, Wisconsin will skate with five defensemen drafted in either the first or second round of the NHL draft.

Junior tri-captain Ryan McDonagh, the 12th pick in the 2007 draft by Montreal, leads the way. McDonagh was traded to the New York Rangers this past summer.

► Sophomore forward Jordy Murray is the son of current St. Louis Blues head coach Andy Murray.

Kohl Center Facts, Folklore and Traditions

- ▶ The Kohl Center, which opened in 1998, is the second-largest on-campus rink in the nation. The only on-campus facility with a larger capacity is Value City Arena (17,500) in Columbus, Ohio. The building is the third-largest rink played in regularly by college hockey schools, behind Value City Arena and Qwest Center Omaha (16,680).
- ▶ Wisconsin has won at least 10 games in a season at the Kohl Center on six occasions.
- ▶ The Kohl Center played host to NCAA regional action for the first time in 2008 when the 2008 NCAA Midwest Regional took place on March 29-30. The building had previously played host to the 1998 NCAA Women's Volleyball Championships, a 2002 NCAA Men's Basketball Regional and 2007 NCAA Women's Ice Hockey Quarterfinal contest.
- ▶ The Kohl Center cost \$76.4 million to construct and is named after U.S. Senator Herb Kohl, a 1956 UW graduate who donated \$25 million towards the project.
- ▶ The Kohl Center ice sheet is 200 feet long by 97 feet wide.
- ▶ Thirty of Wisconsin's 34 Kohl Center sellouts have come after Jan. 1.
