Badger Men's Soccer Milestones

1977 - UW Adds Men's Soccer as a Varsity

Sport: Thirteen years after Bill Reddan introduced soccer as a club sport at UW, Wisconsin added men's soccer to their list of varsity sports in 1977. Reddan was hired as the team's first varsity coach.

1981 - First NCAA Qualification: After a successful 15-2-2 season, the Badgers made their debut in the NCAA tournament. Wisconsin fell, 5-1, to Big Ten foe Indiana in the first round on Nov. 22, 1981.

Oct. 3, 1986 - 100th Program Win: In its ninth season as a varsity sport, Wisconsin battled back from a 1-0 deficit vs. Notre Dame to claim a 2-1 victory. Senior Mike Kottke scored first at 54:09 while Elliot Hurtig secured the UW's 100th win in the 82nd minute of the game.

1991 - Big Ten Regular Season Champions:

Head coach Jim Launder led the Badgers to an undefeated 5-0 Big Ten season to become the regular-season champions. Wisconsin was cut down in the second round of the NCAA tournament by Indiana in a 2-0 overtime loss.

Sept. 11, 1994 - 200th Program Win:

Wisconsin dominated the UWM Panther Classic. Following a 4-0 win over St. Joseph's (Pa.), the Badgers clinched the tournament title and the program's 200th win in a 3-0 victory over Detroit-Mercy.

1995 - NCAA Champions: Wisconsin shut out Bowling Green State (2-0), William & Mary (1-0OT), SMU (2-0) and Portland (1-0) en route to the championship game vs. Duke. The Dec. 10, 1995, game was played in Richmond, Va., on a clear and cold day in front of 21,319 fans — still the second-largest crowd to ever witness a collegiate soccer game. Wisconsin defeated Duke 2-0 to earn the school's first NCAA soccer title. The Badgers still stand as the only team in NCAA history to not allow a single goal in a five-game postseason run.

Sept. 5, 2004 - 300th Program Win: A hat trick by senior forward Jed Hohlbein gave the Badgers its first victory of the season. The 4-1 victory over Dayton was the second of two games played by the Badgers over the weekend in the Big Toe Soccer Invitational. Hohlbein was named the tournament MVP while fellow Badgers Aaron Hohlbein and Nick Van Sicklen were named to the all-tournament team.

Prior to 1991, the Big Ten Conference men's soccer tournament had a separate qualifying round to advance to the Big Ten championship game. These rounds are signified by (N) for Northern Big Ten Tournament and (W) for Western Big Ten Tournament. Between 1984 and 1991, no conference championships were contested. Beginning with the 1991 season until today, the Big Ten has a four-day league tournament which includes quarterfinal, semifinal and championship rounds. The site of the tournament rotates among league schools.
