### POST-SEASON TICKET INFORMATION

#### 2012 BIG TEN BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

Women's Basketball Big Ten Tournament tickets will go on-sale beginning November 14 at 8:30am. There is a special incentive to buying your tickets early - \$20 off (a 30% savings) of the original \$70 price tag. Until January 31, all-session Women's Basketball Big Ten Tournament tickets will only cost \$50. The tournament will be held in the Conseco Fieldhouse in Indianapolis, IN on March 1-4, 2012.

You can order your tickets online at UWBadgers.com or by calling the Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office at 1-800-GO-BADGERS. The reduced price will only last for a limited time and on January 31 all-session tournament tickets will revert to the original price of \$70.

After January 31, the Athletic Ticket Office will no longer be selling Big Ten Tournament tickets. For ticket availability, please contact TicketMaster at 1-800-745-3000 or visit TicketMaster.com.

#### 2012 NCAA TOURNAMENT

If Wisconsin qualifies for the 2012 NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament, the Athletic Ticket Office will accept requests from season ticket holders and donors to athletics at the Captain's Club level and above (minimum \$50 contribution during the 2011 calendar year). If tickets remain after the request period, tickets will be sold to the general public. Details on how to place a request will be communicated in late February.

### PARKING INFORMATION

#### SEASON TICKET HOLDERS ORDERING PARKING

Advance sale parking is only available on a season basis. Current permit holders should accept their current parking assignment or make a request for a lot change on their season ticket application. Season ticket holders who would like to purchase a season parking permit (\$80) may also make that request on their season ticket application. All parking requests will be filled first based on annual giving level and then priority points within each giving level.

#### SINGLE-GAME PARKING

Single-game parking is available for purchase on a first-come, first-served basis. This policy is in place only from the attendants at lots with availability. Lots will be determined once season parking assignments have been completed, just prior to the start of the season.

### DROP-OFF LOCATION FOR PATRONS WITH DISABILITIES AND WHEELCHAIR ASSISTANCE

A drop-off location for patrons with disabilities is located in front of the Kohl Center on Dayton Street. Wheelchair assistance is available from our Guest Services staff. Contact Guest Services prior to game day at 608.263.7894 or on game day at 608.263.5645.

# GENERAL INFORMATION

## DEADLINE FOR ORDERS

Women's basketball current season ticket orders are due by Friday, September 9, 2011. Orders not received by this date will be considered late and may be subject to loss of season tickets.

## PAYMENT

Order your tickets and parking online at UWBadgers.com. It's safe, secure and eliminates additional paperwork and mailing costs. If you have never used the online system, you will need to activate your account using your patron number and pin number located on your order form above your name and address. If you choose not to order your tickets online, please mail the WHITE copy of the order form with the appropriate payment. Please do not order season tickets by fax. Orders by phone will be accepted during regular business hours (8:30am-4:30pm, Monday-Friday). Payment can be made by check, cash, MasterCard, Visa, Discover or American Express Card.

## CONTRIBUTIONS

Individuals who contribute a minimum of \$50 to Wisconsin Athletics will receive priority points. Please refer to your 2011 Giving Opportunities brochure or call the Wisconsin Athletics Development Office at 608.262.1000 for more information.

## ADDRESS CHANGES

It is the patron's responsibility to inform the Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office of any changes to your address by September 9. Address changes should be submitted on the season order form, in a separate letter, or online at UWBadgers.com.

## MAILING OF TICKETS

Season tickets and parking will be mailed approximately October 5 via first class mail. Single-game and package tickets will be mailed no later than seven days prior to the game via first class mail.

## WILL CALL

Tickets ordered within seven days of a game will be left at Will Call. Before game day, Will Call tickets may be picked up during regular office hours at the Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office located at Camp Randall Stadium (Gate 1). Office hours are 8:30am - 4:30pm, Monday - Friday. The Kohl Center Will Call window, located in the main ticket lobby inside Gate B, is open one hour prior to tip-off on game day. A photo I.D. is required to pick up tickets at Will Call.

## ADMISSION POLICY

All patrons two years of age and older must have a valid ticket for admission. Children under the age of two may be admitted without a ticket, provided they sit on the lap of a parent or guardian.

## ACCESSIBLE SEATS

Patrons needing to make accessible seating arrangements should contact the Athletic Ticket Office prior to game day, as seats are limited and subject to availability. Patrons may inquire about availability beginning October 24.

## REFUNDS

Ticket and parking refunds or exchanges are only granted if an order is not filled. Acceptance of payment does not constitute final acceptance of your order. Refunds will not be made due to a game time or date change. The Athletic Department is pleased to recognize supporters who make contributions to its program in part by offering donors priority for various ticket, parking and special event benefits. Since such opportunities can vary each year, contributions are non-refundable.

# SEASON TICKET INFORMATION

## RESERVED SEASON TICKETS

Reserved season tickets are available in sections 107-109 and 121-123 at a cost of \$85 per season ticket regardless of age.

## GENERAL ADMISSION SEASON TICKETS

General admission season tickets are available in addition to reserved season tickets. General admission season ticket holders are not tied to a specific location, as they may choose to sit in any general admission section. General admission season ticket holders may NOT sit in any reserved season ticket sections (107-109 and 121-123). General admission season tickets are a tremendous value at \$50 for adults and \$20 for youth (ages 2-17) and senior citizens (age 55+).

## FAMILY SEASON TICKET PACKAGE

The Family Season Ticket package allows your entire family to enjoy Wisconsin basketball at a tremendous savings. For only \$99, you will receive four general admission tickets to all home games.

## ADDITIONAL SEASON TICKETS

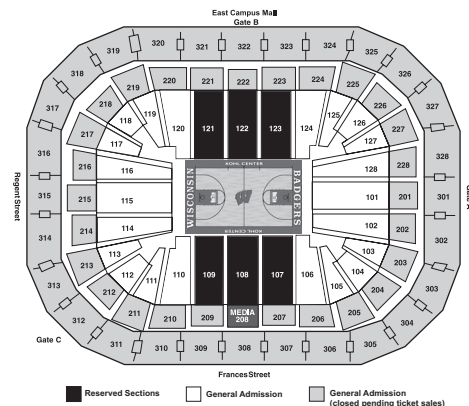
If you would like to request additional season tickets, please indicate this in the comments box located adjacent to your season ticket line when ordering online. If you are not ordering online, please write this request on your order form and include payment. Seats are currently available, though additional seats will most likely not be adjacent to your current season tickets. If you would like both your additional and current seats to be together, and are willing to re-locate your seats to do so, please indicate that desire when ordering your season tickets.

## CURRENT SEASON TICKET HOLDERS REQUESTING SEAT CHANGE

Keep the following points in mind if you wish to request a seat improvement:

- Changes are based on availability, annual giving level and descending priority points order within each giving level.
- The number of years requesting seat changes does not factor into the request process and requests are not carried over from the previous year.
- Requests for seating changes should be in writing and placed on, or attached to, your ticket application. If you are ordering online, please place your request in the comments box located next to your season ticket line.

Each request is reviewed by the Athletic Department, but the volume of requests may not make personal consultation feasible. Decisions are based on the best judgment of the Athletic Department. The Athletic Department reserves the right to change any seat assignment without prior notice, thus there are no guarantees.



# SINGLE-GAME TICKET INFORMATION

## HOME SINGLE-GAME TICKETS

Home single-game tickets will go on-sale on October 10, 2011 at 8:30am. If necessary, the standard ticket lottery system will be used for those purchasing tickets at the ticket office. All reserved single-game tickets are \$7.00. Reserved single-game tickets MUST be purchased in advance, as there will be no day-of-game reserved single-game tickets for sale. All day-of-game sales will be general admission tickets. Adult general admission single-game tickets are also \$7.00. UW student, youth (ages 2-17) and senior citizen (age 55+) general admission single-game tickets are \$3.00.

## RAYOVAC FAMILY FOUR PACKS

Family Four Packs will go on-sale on October 10, 2011 at 8:30am. Family Four Packs are \$28, which includes four general admission tickets, four food vouchers good for a hot dog and soda, and a \$5 Rayovac gift card. Additional tickets are \$7. Family Four Packs are only available through advanced purchase. They are not available the day of the game.

## THREE-GAME PACKAGES

Three Game Packages will go on-sale on October 10, 2011 at 8:30am. Three Game Packages, which represent about a 30% discount off of regular ticket prices, are \$15.00 for adults and \$6.00 for youth and seniors. All Three Game Packages are general admission seating.

## GROUP TICKETS

Group tickets go on-sale October 10, 2011 at 8:30am. A group consists of 15 or more people and provides tremendous savings over regular single-game ticket prices. Group tickets are affordably priced at \$3.00 for adults and \$1.00 for youths (age 2-17), UW students and senior citizens (age 55+). All group seating is general admission, so your group has the ability to choose their seats on the day of the game. General admission seating is decided on a first-come, first-served basis.
