# National Tournament History

## Team History

*Wisconsin has qualified for eight national championship tournaments – seven under the NCAA and one under the AIAW.*

**1980**

### AIAW Team Championship

Wisconsin lost in the first round to Northeast Louisiana State, 3-6. In consolation play, Wisconsin lost to California, 2-7.

**1996**

### NCAA Team Championship

The Badgers earned their first-ever NCAA championship win in a comeback 5-3 upset victory over fifth-ranked Wake Forest. UW fell to Florida, 0-5, in the quarterfinals.

**1997**

### NCAA Team Championship

Wisconsin advanced to the NCAA team championship for the second straight year. UW advanced by capturing its first-ever NCAA Midwest regional title. The Badgers defeated 43rd-ranked Northwestern (5-1), 21st-ranked Notre Dame (5-2) and 17th-ranked South Carolina (5-3) to advance to the championship rounds. Wisconsin fell in the first round, losing to eventual national champion, Stanford, 0-5. The Badgers ended the season ranked 18th nationally after spending the entire season ranked in the nation's Top 25.

**1998**

### NCAA Team Championship

Wisconsin qualified for the NCAA Midwest regional where it defeated Michigan, 5-2, before falling to host Notre Dame, 1-5.

**1999**

### NCAA Team Championship

The 37th-ranked Badgers advanced to the NCAA regional championship by upsetting No. 18 Arkansas, 5-4, in the first round. The UW lost in the regional finals to the host, 15th-ranked Tennessee, 2-5.

**2002**

### NCAA Team Championship

Wisconsin received its first invitation to the NCAA tournament since 1999, defeating Notre Dame to advance to the second round. The Badgers topped the Irish, 4-2, winning four singles matches in the tournament's opener before suffering a 4-0 sweep at the hands of No. 16 Northwestern in round two.



The 2002 team advanced to the NCAA tournament for the first time since 1999. In the first round of the tournament, the Badgers upset Notre Dame 4-2.

**2004**

### NCAA Team Championship

The 50th-ranked Badgers took a trip back to the NCAA Championship, but were eliminated in the first round by No. 24 Tennessee, 4-3. Wisconsin came just points away from advancing, but dropped a third-set tiebreaker in the fourth position. Freshmen Caitlin Burke and Kaylan Caiati each won their singles matches for the Badgers, who earned the doubles point, 2-1.

**2005**

### NCAA Team Championship

The No. 34 Wisconsin women's tennis team earned its second-straight trip to the NCAA Championship, but dropped a 4-1 decision to No. 20 William & Mary, 4-1. No. 85-ranked Caitlin Burke earned the Badgers' only team point, defeating No. 107 Candice Fuchs, 6-4, ret., in the second position. The doubles team of Burke and Katie McGaffigan won at No. 1 doubles, beating Megan Moulton-Levy and Megan Muth, 8-2.
