- The Badgers (16-14 overall, 8-10 Big Ten) wrap up the regular season with a split week of play against two ranked teams. Wisconsin travels to No. 19 Minnesota (16-11, 9-9) on Wednesday for a 7 p.m. match from the Sports Pavilion. UW returns home on Friday to host No. 8 Purdue (25-4, 14-4) at 7 p.m. in the UW Field House.
- Wisconsin is currently tied for seventh place in the Big Ten standings at 8-10, only one match behind sixth-place Minnesota. Nebraska clinched at least a share of the 2011 Big Ten title with its win over Wisconsin on Saturday and a loss by Purdue.
- Friday is Senior Night and the Badgers will honor seniors **Janelle Gabrielsen** and **Elle Ohlander** in a pre-match ceremony.
- The 64-team bracket for the 2011 NCAA Tournament will be announced on Sunday at 5 p.m. live on ESPNU. Thirty-three conference champions will receive automatic bids while 31 teams will receive at-large berths.
The Badgers must win at least one match this week to meet the minimum requirement of participating in the tournament—an overall winning percentage above .500.
- The Badgers have won eight Big Ten matches this season, the most conference wins since 2007. UW also equalled its overall victory total from 2010. Wisconsin was 16-15 and 5-15 in the Big Ten last season.
- Wisconsin has swept two Big Ten opponents this season, the first time it has won both matches over two conference opponents since 2007. The Badgers won matches against Michigan and Iowa this season.

HONORING THE SENIORS

Friday is Senior Night and the Badgers will honor seniors **Janelle Gabrielsen** and **Elle Ohlander** in a pre-match ceremony.

Gabrielsen, a 6-0 setter/right-side hitter, has played in 120 matches and 443 sets as a Badger. She ranks sixth in career assists with 3,389 and seventh in assists per set with 7.65. Gabrielsen also ranks ninth in career digs with 1,094.

Ohlander, a 6-6 middle blocker, has played in 87 matches and 260 sets. She has 389 kills (1.50/set) and 192 blocks (0.74/set) in her career.

SURPASSING LAST SEASON'S WIN TOTAL

The Badgers have won eight Big Ten matches this season, surpassing their five total conference wins from 2010 and recording the most conference wins since 2007.

UW also equalled its overall victory total from 2010. Wisconsin was 16-15 overall and 5-15 in the Big Ten last season.

SWEEPING BIG TEN OPPONENTS

Wisconsin swept two Big Ten opponents this season, the first time it has won both matches over two conference opponents since 2007. The Badgers won two matches against Michigan and Iowa this season.

UPSETTING RANKED TEAMS

Wisconsin has beaten four ranked teams this season, the most for the program since beating four ranked teams in 2006.

The Badgers downed then-No. 24 Ohio State (3-1) in Columbus on Oct. 2. The following weekend, UW upset then No. 18 Michigan (3-1) in Ann Arbor on Oct. 8. Wisconsin upset then-No. 6 Penn State (3-2) on Nov. 6 before downing then-No. 24 Michigan (3-1) last Friday.

NCAA RPI UPDATED

Wisconsin dropped one spot to 53rd in the NCAA RPI released Nov. 21. The RPI is one of the primary tools used by the NCAA committee to select teams to the tournament.

Illinois leads the rankings while Nebraska is third and Purdue fifth. Minnesota is 10th and Penn State moves up to 11th. Michigan drops one spot to 23rd, Michigan State moves up to 29th and Ohio State falls to 49th. Northwestern is 91st, Indiana is 137th and Iowa is 145th.

BADGERS IN NCAA STATS

UW ranks among the top 90 teams in the country in four statistical categories, released Nov. 21. The Badgers are 66th in blocks per set (2.37) and 70th in assists per set (12.53). Wisconsin is also 72nd in kills per set (13.44) and 87th in hitting percentage (.223). A total of 322 teams are included in the rankings.

Individually, **Annemarie Hickey** is 79th in digs per set with 4.68 and 110th in service aces per set with 0.34. **Alexis Mitchell** is 119th in hitting percentage at .321 and 151st in blocks per set with 1.00.

WISCONSIN IN BIG TEN STATS

Wisconsin ranks among the top-six teams in two statistical categories this week. The Badgers rank third in the league in digs per set with 15.57 and sixth in opponent hitting percentage (.184).

Individually, sophomore **Annemarie Hickey** leads the league in digs per set with 4.68 and ranks fifth in service aces per set with 0.33. Junior **Alexis Mitchell** is ninth in hitting percentage at .321.

In Big Ten-only matches, Wisconsin is fifth in digs per set (15.44). Mitchell ranks fifth in hitting percentage at .314. Hickey is fifth in digs (4.41) and tied for sixth in service aces (0.30) per set.

GABRIELSEN IN THE TOP 10

Senior **Janelle Gabrielsen** ranks sixth on the UW career list for assists with 3,389 helpers, moving past current assistant coach **Colleen (Neels) Bayer**. Gabrielsen also ranks ninth on the career list with 1,094 digs. She needs just 12 digs to move into eighth on the dig list.

Gabrielsen became the 12th Badger to tally a 1,000 digs on Oct. 22 at Indiana. She became just the second Badger to record 3,000 assists and 1,000 digs, joining Bayer. The 6-1 setter/right-side hitter currently also ranks seventh in assists per set with 7.65.

Gabrielsen needs to play in six more sets to move into the top 10 for sets played. Marisa Mackey (1995-98) ranks 10th, having played in 449 sets.

HICKEY LEADS BIG TEN IN DIGS PER SET

For most of the 2011 season, sophomore **Annemarie Hickey** has led the Big Ten in digs per set. The 5-8 libero currently leads the league with 4.68 digs per set.

The 5-8 libero has tallied double-figure digs in 28 of 30 matches this season, including a career-high 33 at N.C. State on Sept. 2.

Hickey has led the Badgers in digs in 26 matches this season, including nine matches with 20-plus digs. She has had 20-or-more digs in six of her last 10 matches

HICKEY MOVING UP SEASON LISTS

CHAPMAN BRINGS THE OFFENSE

In her last 11 matches, freshman **Ellen Chapman** has recorded double-digit kills to up her season average to 2.77 kills per set. The 6-5 outside hitter is averaging 3.38 kills per set over the last 11 matches. She had a career-high 21 kills vs. No. 24 Michigan on Nov. 11.

Chapman has had double-figure kills in her last 11 matches. The 6-5 outside hitter has four double-doubles this season, including at Nebraska last Saturday, leading the team with 10 kills while adding 10 digs.

WORKMAN WORKS THE BACK ROW

Freshman **Caroline Workman** recorded a career-high 14 digs vs. No. 6 Penn State on Nov. 6. A 5-5 defensive specialist from Los Angeles, Workman plays back row for **Bailey Reshel**.

Workman has had double-figure digs in four matches this season. Over her last seven matches, she is averaging 2.31 digs per set. Workman averages 1.44 digs per set on the season.

GABRIELSEN, THOMAS RECORD TRIPLE-DOUBLES

Senior **Janelle Gabrielsen** and freshman **Courtney Thomas** have both recorded two triple doubles this season.

Gabrielsen recorded her UW best third career triple-double vs. No. 24 Michigan on Nov. 11. The 6-1 setter/right-side hitter had 10 kills, 32 assists and 11 digs. She also had a triple-double at Duke on Aug. 27, tallying 11 kills, 20 assists and 12 digs.

DID YOU KNOW?

- ▶ The Field House is listed in the National Register of Historic Places.
- ▶ Construction on the Field House began in 1929 with the dedication on Dec. 18, 1930. Original capacity was 8,000 as the "Barn" was built without the upper balcony. The balcony was added in 1939, raising the seating capacity to 12,000.
- ▶ The facility had a dirt floor for many years and an eighth-of-a-mile cinder track ringed the perimeter of the building.
- ▶ The Field House was the home of the UW boxing team from 1933-60, when boxing was an NCAA sport. An all-sport record crowd of 15,200 watched the Wisconsin vs. Washington State boxing match in 1949.
- ▶ Muhammad Ali suffered one of his few losses as an amateur boxer during the 1959 Pan American Games trials.
- ▶ Notable speakers in the Field House include then-presidential candidate John F. Kennedy in 1960, Archbishop Desmond Tutu, Reverend Jesse Jackson, Bob Hope and the Dalai Lama.

▶ Other events held in the Field House include basketball, wrestling, concerts, carnivals and Native American pow wows.

Gabrielsen totaled her first career triple-double as a freshman, recording 13 kills, 15 assists and 10 digs at Michigan on Nov. 8, 2008.

Thomas picked up her second triple-double of the season against Michigan State on Nov. 12. The 6-0 setter/right-side hitter had 10 kills, 23 assists and 13 digs vs. the Spartans. Thomas had her first triple-double at Michigan State on Oct. 7, tallying a career-high 16 kills and 15 digs while adding 26 assists.

They are just the third and fourth Badgers to record a triple double, joining Mary Penosky (twice in 1987) and Susan Temple (twice in 1988).

THAT'S A LOT OF POINTS!

Wisconsin lost the third set to No. 6 Penn State on Nov. 6 by a score of 34-32, the second-highest single set total under 25-point scoring.

The highest mark was set earlier this season when the Badgers downed Michigan State 34-32 in the third set on Oct. 7. Wisconsin's previous high was 30 points vs. the Spartans on Oct. 29, 2010. UW's single-set point total is the highest for a Big Ten team this season and ranks fifth all-time under 25-point set scoring.

DOUBLING UP

Freshman **Courtney Thomas** has team-leading 15 double-doubles this season. Senior **Janelle Gabrielsen** has 12 double-doubles this year to bring her career total to 49.

Freshman **Crystal Graff** had three double-doubles this season while freshman **Ellen Chapman** has four double-doubles.

MITCHELL MOVES ON TO CAREER LIST

Junior **Alexis Mitchell** has moved on to the UW career list for hitting percentage this season. The 6-0 middle blocker ranks sixth at .290 in her third season. Mitchell is hitting a season best .324 this season, which ranks seventh in the Big Ten.

HICKEY RANKS ON MATCH, CAREER DIG LISTS

Sophomore **Annemarie Hickey** ranks among the top-five players on the UW's match dig lists. The 5-8 libero had a career-high 33 digs at N.C. State on Sept. 2, which ties her for fifth on the five-set dig list. She also had 24 digs in only three sets vs. Notre Dame on Sept. 17, which also ties her for fifth.

Hickey also ranks fourth on the UW career list with 3.37 digs per set. She has 717 digs in her career, going over the 700 mark vs. No. 24 Michigan on Nov. 11.

FOLLOWING THE TRENDS

The Badgers are 10-2 this season when they have more service aces than their opponents and 13-1 when they win the first two sets. UW is 15-2 when it hits over .200 and 15-2 when it has a higher hitting percentage. Wisconsin is 15-3 when it has more kills, 13-4 when its opponent hits under .200 and 13-3 when it has more blocks.

BADGERS RANK FOURTH NATIONALLY IN ATTENDANCE

For the 22nd-straight year, Wisconsin ranks among the top-10 teams in national attendance. The Badgers currently rank fourth with 3,754 fans per match. Hawai'i leads the nation with 6,497 fans per match. Nebraska leads the Big Ten with 4,637 spectators per match while Minnesota ranks third with 4,173 fans per match.

Minnesota (16-11, 9-9 Big Ten) won the first set against the Huskers at 25-17 before losing the next three to give Nebraska the win. Sophomore Ashley Wittman, a 6-0 outside hitter, led the Gophers with 15 kills while also adding 13 digs for her 16th double-double of the year. Classmate Tori Dixon, a 6-3 middle blocker, had 13 kills. Senior Jessica Granquist, a 5-8 libero, led all players in the match with 25 digs.

After dropping the first set to the Hawkeyes, Minnesota won the next three to take the match. Senior Ariana Filho, a 6-2 middle blocker, had a team- and career-high 18 kills in the match, while Dixon and Wittman each chipped in 15 kills. Granquist again led all players with 24 digs while redshirt senior Hailey Cowles, a 5-10 outside hitter, added a career-best 23 saves. Dixon and Filho each had a match-high five total blocks.

Wittman's team-high 4.54 kills per set is second-highest among all Big Ten players. Dixon (.351) and Filho (.337) are third and fifth, respectively, in hitting percentages in the conference. Dixon also adds 0.33 service aces per set, good for sixth in the Big Ten. Junior Mia Tabberson, a 6-2 setter, leads the Big Ten with 11.84 assists per set. Granquist adds 4.62 digs per set, second highest in the Big Ten.

Junior Ariel Turner, a 6-1 outside hitter, led all players with 17 kills while classmate Tiffany Fisher, a 6-2 middle blocker, and freshman Valerie Nichol, a 6-0 outside hitter, each added seven. Redshirt senior Blair Bashen, a 5-10 defensive specialist, had a match-high 14 digs as one of three Purdue players with double-figure saves in the sweep. Freshman Kierra Jones, a 6-1 middle blocker, had a team-high four blocks.

The eighth-ranked Boilermakers then fell at No. 12 Penn State in four sets. Turner shared the match lead with a team-high 18 kills, while Jones added eight kills and two blocks. Bashen led Purdue with 17 digs and redshirt sophomore Rachel Davis, a 6-0 setter, added 16 save.

Turner leads the Big Ten with 4.83 kills and 5.44 points per set, while Fisher leads the conference with her .396 hitting percentage. Davis adds 10.92 assists per set, good for fifth in the Big Ten. Bashen averages 4.07 digs per set, eighth highest in the conference. Jones (1.27) and Fisher (1.00) are fifth and 10th, respectively, in the Big Ten in blocks per set.

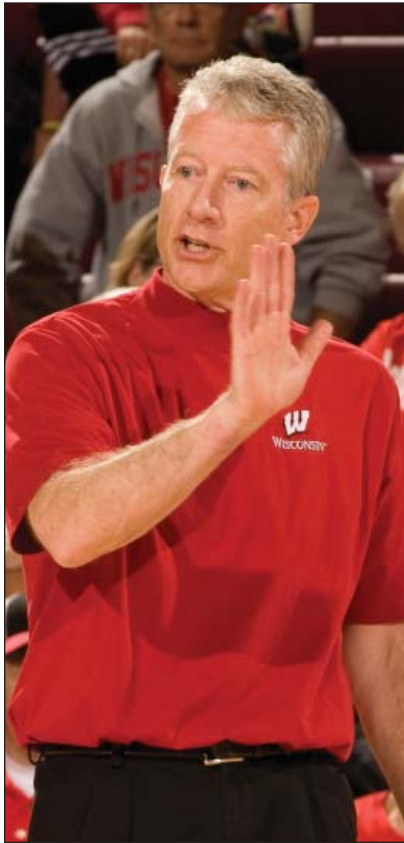
