2008 Horizon League Co-Coach of the Year

127-62 in his seventh overall year; 44-22 in his third year at WSU

Brad Brownell became the seventh coach in Wright State history on March 31, 2006 and hit the ground running as he was introduced a few days later to a large fan reception in the new Setzer Pavilion/Mills Morgan Center.



As he accepted questions from the audience, the fans were hoping the season could start immediately as Coach Brownell showed why WSU chose him from many applicants to guide the future of the promising Raider program.

Since his new appointment, the Raiders have blossomed into one of the top teams of the Horizon League with great recruiting backed up with fine coaching. March 3, 2008, Brownell was named the League's Co-Coach of the Year. He collected 100th win against UW-Milwaukee, beaten nationally-ranked Butler twice and has led the Raiders to the most road wins as a division I team. In just under five years, he has averaged more than 21 wins a season. Additionally, Brownell is one of 15 finalist for the Hugh Durham Coach of the Year Award for mid-major programs. In 2007, he added to his resume a Horizon League Player of the Year, first-team selection, Defensive Team member and two Newcomer Team members. After his team won the Horizon League, he was named the NABC District 10 Coach of the Year which covers Ohio and Indiana. From day one, his focus has been on the student-athletes.

During Brownell's tenure as head coach, the UNCW men's basketball program enjoyed an unprecedented era of success. The Evansville, IN native brings a four-year head coaching record of 83-40 to the Raiders along with two NCAA Tournament berths. UNCW posted a 25-8 mark last season and won the CAA Tournament, beating Final Four participant George Mason University. The Seahawks lost in overtime to George Washington University 88-85. His four-year Colonial Conference record was 61-22 which was the best during the period. Brownell was twice named the CAA Coach of the Year (2003 and 2006) and twice the collegeinsider.com Coach of the Year. Foxsports.com also named him the Mid-Major Coach of the Year last year.

Brownell compiled five All-CAA performers, one CAA Player of the Year, four All-Defensive Team selections, one Defensive Player of the Year and seven CAA All-Academic honorees.

Before taking the helm, Brownell was an assistant or associate head coach under current DePaul University head coach Jerry Wainwright. UNCW posted a 136-103 mark during that eight-year period, including two NCAA and two NIT appearances. During his 12 years in Wilmington, UNCW was one of the best defensive teams in the nation, leading the CAA in defense in all but two of those campaigns.

Brownell earned his Bachelor's Degree from DePaul University in 1991 and completed his Master's Degree at the University of Indianapolis in 1994.

Best Start for WSU head coach: The best start for a WSU head coach has been Ralph Underhill who won 45 games in his first two years 1978-80. Brad Brownell won 44 games in his first two seasons.

Best Two-Year League Record: After setting the mark for the best WSU league record last year with 13 wins, the Raiders now have the distinction of the best two-year mark with 25 wins.

Why Raiders: The nickname and colors were chosen by a student vote in the early 1970's when it was decided to start an athletic program. Many say the name and colors were influenced by popular NFL teams of time: Oakland Raiders and the Green Bay Packers. The logo has evolved through the years from different versions of a pirate and viking to the present day Wolf--the Raider of the Animal Kingdom.

Wright State shot 57 percent in the first half and led 51-29 at the break in rolling to a 76-56 decision over St. Edward's.

WSU led the entire way, scoring the first eight points of the contest on a three and layup from Vaughn Duggins and another three by Todd Brown. The margin was 30-21 until the Raiders closed out the first half with a 21-8 run over the final 6:22, a burst that featured seven points each from Gavin Horne and Troy Tabler.

Wright State shot 57 percent the opening 20 minutes and hit 15 of 19 from the foul line compared to 40 percent from the field and seven of 11 at the stripe for the Hilltoppers.

St. Edward's would get no closer than 16 the rest of the way as the Raiders shot 50 percent from the field in the second half and made seven of 11 foul shots.

Wright State shot 54 percent overall and was 22 of 30 from the foul line while St. Edward's shot 40 percent and hit nine of 13 free throws. The Raiders led in points in the paint (34-24), points off of turnovers (21-13), fast break points (10-2) and points off the bench (36-26).

Duggins led a balanced attack for the Raiders with 11 points while Horne added 10 off the bench, Brown nine, Will Graham eight and Cory Cooperwood eight points and eight rebounds. All but one WSU player that saw action scored.

Illinois State scored seven of the first eight points of the game and held off a Wright State comeback attempt in the final minutes as the Redbirds defeated the Raiders 69-61.

WSU cut the deficit to 13-11 on a Troy Tabler three at the 12:41 mark of the first half and another triple from the sophomore guard made it 26-23 with 5:28 remaining, but Illinois State followed with a 9-0 run, five from Emmanuel Holloway and four by Osiris Eldridge. Wright State again closed to within five before an Eldridge three in the closing seconds made it 41-33 at the break.

The Redbirds extended the advantage to as much as 13 twice in the second half, the second at 61-48 with 7:14 remaining, but WSU responded with an 11-1 burst over the next six minutes, capped off by a Will Graham layup, to make it 62-59 with just under a minute to play.

A short jumper in the lane by Lloyd Phillips and two Cham Oguchi foul shots, though, gave Illinois State a seven-point cushion and the Raiders would get no closer than five the rest of the way.

ISU shot only 28 percent in the second half to finish at 44 percent for the game while Wright State hit for just 31 percent the final 20 minutes to end up at 39 percent. The Redbirds made 11 of 15 foul shots in the second half to go 15 of 21 for the contest while the Raiders were 16 of 20 overall after going six of eight in the second half.

Wright State held the lead late in regulation and in overtime, but Central Michigan would rally back both times and, on a Robbie Harman three in the final seconds, the Chippewas defeated the Raiders 70-68.

Central Michigan scored the first six points of the contest, only to see Wright State go up 13-10 at the 12:23 mark of the first half on a three by Troy Tabler. The Chippewas broke a 26-26 tie with a 9-3 run, but the Raiders scored the final three points of the half to trail 35-32 at the break.

An 8-0 burst, capped off by a Vaughn Duggins three-point play, gave WSU a 40-38 advantage with 16:41 remaining in regulation and the Raiders appeared to be in control as a N'Gai Evans layup at the 4:07 mark made it 59-49.

That would turn out to be the final points for Wright State in the second half, however, as the Chippewas scored the last 10 points to force overtime, including a Harman three with eight seconds left to tie it.

The Raiders later went up 66-61 in overtime on a Todd Brown dunk and 68-64 on a Cory Cooperwood basket with 1:38 to play, but again Central Michigan would rally for the win, starting with a Jeremy Allen three and Harman's triple to win it.

Cooperwood posted a double-double of 16 points and 11 rebounds to lead Wright State while Evans had 11 and Duggins and Brown eight each.

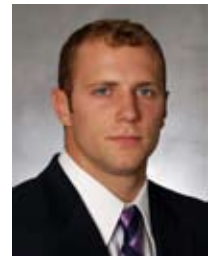
