Lady Rams to Open Home Court Against Rival UNCG Spartans


The Winston-Salem State Lady Rams will get their first taste of home cooking on Tuesday evening when the team hosts the UNC-Greensboro Spartans (1-2), Tuesday evening at the C.E. Gaines Center.

The Lady Rams will look to take advantage of home court after taking a pair of road losses at the Tiny L. Laster Memorial Tri-Match on Friday. The Lady Rams had a great effort against the U.S. Naval Academy, falling 3-1 to the Midshipmen, but ran out of gas when they played host Hampton in the final match of the day. The Lady Rams will have a chance to put an end to their early struggles with some solid play on their home court, Tuesday evening.

Last season, 75% of the team's wins came on their home court and the team will look to stay hot there this season.

Last Time Out

The Lady Rams capped the 2009 Tiny L. Laster Tri-Match on a down note when the team took a 3-0 loss to the Hampton Lady Pirates by scores of 10-25, 9-25, and 14-25. WSSU senior Annika Barnwell led the Lady Rams with seven kills in the match while junior Ashley Harris was close behind with six kills. UNC-Greensboro will head into Tuesday's match after splitting a pair of matches at the 2009 Hilton Green Hokie Invitational. After taking a 3-1 loss to host Virginia Tech in their first match of the day, the Spartans bounced back from a 2-1 deficit to take a 3-2 win over the Montana Grizzlies. UNCG hitter Catherine Hanners took home all-tournament honors for her efforts on the

Battered Rams

The Lady Rams are still struggling with the injury bug as a number of key players remain on the sidelines recovering from injuries. WSSU sophomore setter Alexandria Brown missed last weekend's action as she still recovers from a season-ending knee injury suffered last fall while fellow sophomore Kameryn Craig still recovers from an offseason knee injury.

Ball Hog

WSSU senior outside hitter Annika Barnwell is currently leading the Lady Rams on offense and defense as she has the team lead in kills (12) and blocks (3) early this season.

New Face, New Potential

The Lady Rams will welcome some incoming firepower with the addition of freshman outside hitter Lindsey Wilborn, who is the sole newcomer to the 2009 squad. Wilborn is a talented freshman from Union Pines High School in Pinehurst, North Carolina. She is a strong athlete who could help the team right away if she adjusts to the college game.

Returning Ram

WSSU assistant coach Chasity Clarke returns to help guide the next generation of Lady Rams after a career as one of the top players in WSSU history. Clarke made her mark in the WSSU record books as she holds Lady Rams' career records in kills (946), attacks (2,600), and digs (743). After serving as an assistant coach for two seasons at Carver High

School in Winston-Salem, N.C., she returns to WSSU and will look to pass on her legacy of excellence.

Coaching Match-Ups

WSSU head coach Douglas Hunter will begin his third season at the helm for the Lady Rams with an 8-56 career record... He will look to lead a resurgence for the team beginning with a strong performance this weekend.

UNC-Greensboro will head into Tuesday's match under the guidance of new head coach Patrick Nicholas. He is in his first season leading the Spartans after spending the last two seasons as an assistant coach at Marshall University. Nicholas is in his ninth career season as an NCAA Division I head coach after stops at Troy and Lehigh.

Members of the MEAC

Winston-Salem State University is a proud member of the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference and has been for the past three seasons. Though the Lady Rams will not count in the MEAC standings and are ineligible for athletic honors until the completion of WSSU's transition to NCAA Division I.

Up Next for the Lady Rams

The Lady Rams will get something like home cooking in their next competition when the team takes part in the 2009 High Point Classic in nearby High Point, North Carolina. The team will take on the Charlotte 49ers on Saturday, followed by a pair of Sunday matches against host High Point and Davidson.

Head Coach Douglas Hunter

Douglas Hunter joined the Winston-Salem State University staff in the spring of 2007 when he took the reins as the team's fourth head coach in school history. He is entering his third season as head coach of the Lady Rams volleyball program and continues to lead the team's development as an NCAA Division I program and a member of the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference.

Under his guidance the Lady Rams have seen some of the top players in school history take the court for the Lady Rams as the squad continues to build upon its rich history.

With a wealth of experience and a strong knowledge of the game, Hunter is well-prepared to lead WSSU volleyball into the next chapter of its storied history. Championships seem to follow Hunter as he has been a part of six Central Intercollegiate Athletics Association championships.

Hunter joined the WSSU coaching staff following a five-year stint at rival North Carolina Central where he served an assistant coach since 2002. During his tenure at NCCU, Hunter was a part of three CIAA championships (2004, 2005, and 2006) as well as the team's first appearance in the NCAA Division II Regionals in 2004, followed by another appearance in 2005. Well-versed in CIAA volleyball, Hunter also spent seven seasons as an assistant coach at St. Augustine's College in Raleigh, North Carolina. Hunter once again helped guide the Lady Falcons to CIAA championships in 1997, 2000, and 2001. Once again, Hunter was a part of school history helping to guide the team to its first NCAA Division II Regionals for the first time in school history.

Prior to heading into the CIAA competition, Hunter spent two seasons as head coach of the Long Island Big Apple Volleyball Club (16s). In addition to his duties as head coach, Hunter acted as the team's technical director. He also spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Mercy College in Dobbs Ferry, New York.

Before heading to the sidelines, Hunter spent 15 years as an executive member of the Jamaica Volleyball Association serving a number of positions in the association as its Vice President, Technical Director (1992) and chairman of several committees during his tenure.

As a player, Hunter has a wealth of experience playing in Jamaica and playing in the USAV Men's Hi A Club with the DVC.net as well as playing on the International Jammers Volleyball Club in the Men's Open Club. He was a well-decorated player earning Best Middle Blocker, Best Defensive Player, and Best Passer honors with the Jamaica Volleyball Association during his career from 1984 to 1994. He also earned Men's Hi A All-Region honors in 1998. He was also an official with the USAV, the FIVB, and JVA Nationals.

Hunter is a 1999 graduate of St. Augustine's College where he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Computer Information Systems. He is also a 1992 graduate of the University of Technology in Kingston, Jamaica.
