At Lady Buff Basketball Camp, the goal of our staff is to help each girl improve herself in the fundamentals of basketball with special emphasis on shooting and defense. In addition, special attention will be given to development of self-confidence, positive mental attitude, motivation and having fun!

## CAMP DIRECTOR

### KRISTA GERLICH, WTAMU HEAD COACH

In her second year at the helm of the Lady Buffs, Krista Gerlich has carried on the proud tradition of the program. Last season, Gerlich led the Lady Buffs to a sixth consecutive 20+ win season and a fifth-straight NCAA-II Regional Appearance on her way to earning Lone Star Conference South Division Coach of the Year accolades. In addition to being a standout on the sidelines, Gerlich enjoyed a spectacular career as a player, helping her alma mater of Texas Tech claim the 1993 NCAA National Championship.



## CAMP STAFF

Joining Coach Gerlich as instructors at the camp will be West Texas A&M assistant coach Kevin Baker, graduate assistants Courtney Nowlin, a former Angelo State standout, and Jennifer Brock, who completed a



impressive Lady Buff career in 2006-07, director of basketball operations Vinay Patel and some of the area's finest high school and middle school coaches. Also helping out during the week will be members of the Lady Buffs who bring their Lone Star Conference Championship experience to the court.

## WHO'S ELIGIBLE

For Camps 1-3, girls from 3rd grade through high school are eligible to participate. Instruction will feature positional play, team concepts, and fundamentals. Position Camp (June 6-8) will be limited to players entering 6th grade and above, with emphasis on individual skills at the guard, wing and post position. **Remember, the NCAA now allows graduating seniors to attend summer camps. Elite camp limited to players entering ninth grade and above.**

## CAMP FEATURES

- Each girl receives plenty of individual work and attention. All drills and instruction are under simulated game conditions.
- Campers will have the opportunity to participate in Free Throw, 3-Point Shot and Hot Shot Contests.
- Each girl will gain experience in working together and living together, which is an important part of life itself.
- Awards and certificates will be given for outstanding play with special awards presented at the close of camp.
- Special activities such as swimming, bowling and racquetball are available.
- Concession stands will be available for campers to purchase soft drinks and snacks throughout the day.
- A Maroon and White All-Star game will be played Thursday morning after the demonstration at 10 a.m.

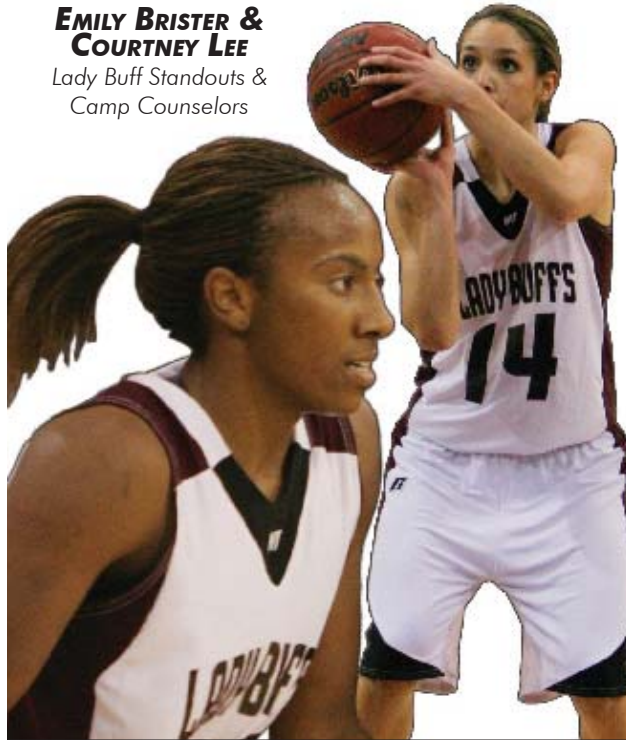

### FIRST UNITED BANK CENTER The Home of Lady Buff Basketball

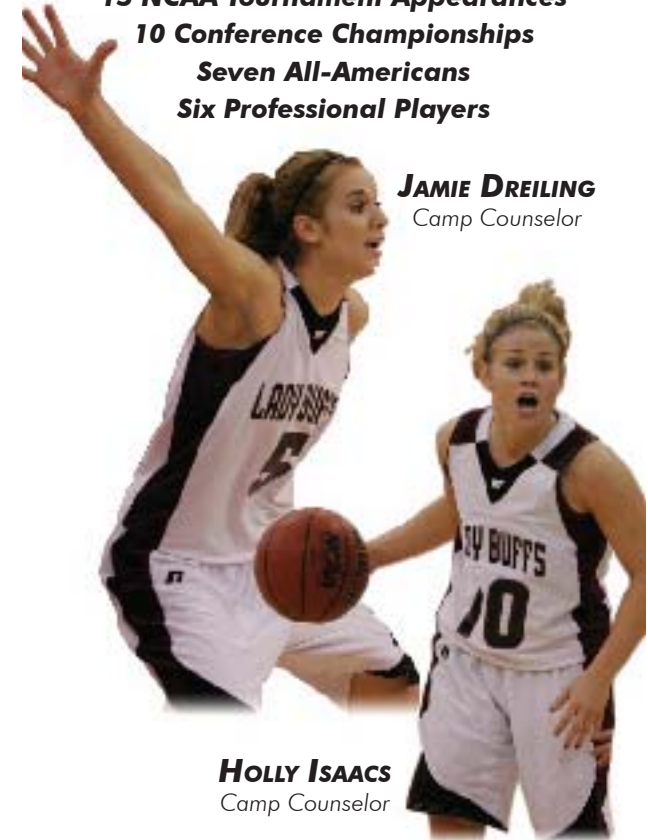

Featuring a state-of-the-art sound system and scoreboard with a large video screen, the 75,000 square foot building is the place to be for exciting Lone Star Conference basketball.

The arena hosts WTAMU graduation, concerts, high school basketball playoffs and other events. The 2002 NCAA Division II National Championship Volleyball tournament also was held in the center.
