HISTORY OF THE WESTERN WRESTLING CONFERENCE

Formed April 27, 2006, the Western Wrestling Conference began as an eight-team wrestling-only alliance. Competition in the league began in the 2006-07 season. Charter members of the Western Wrestling Conference included the United States Air Force Academy, Fresno State University, North Dakota State University, the University of Northern Colorado, the University of Northern Iowa, South Dakota State University, Utah Valley University and the University of Wyoming.

Members of the WWC qualify for the postseason by competing in the NCAA West Regional, which also serves as the yearly conference tournament.

Four of the members already competed in the NCAA West Regional qualifier in 2006-07, including Air

Force, Fresno State, UNI and Wyoming. Northern Colorado, North Dakota State, South Dakota State and Utah Valley all transitioned to the Division I level. UNC, NDSU, SDSU became eligible for the NCAA Championships in 2006-07, while UVU gained entry into the postseason in Division I in 2009-10.

Fresno State dropped its program prior to the 2007 season, and Northern Iowa withdrew from the league in 2012, leaving six original members.

Entering its ninth season in 2014-15, the WWC continues to strive to be one of the top wrestling leagues in the nation. In the previous eight seasons, the WWC has tallied 15 All-Americans.
