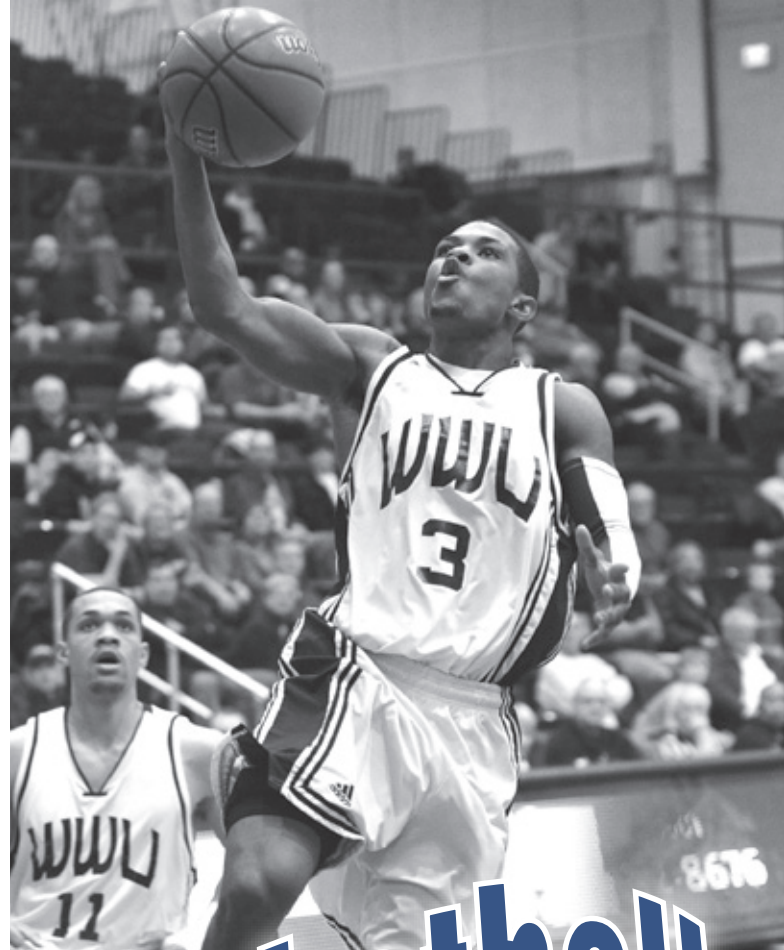

## **Fundamentals Camp July 29th – August 1st**

Fundamentals Camp is designed to develop the individual skills and abilities of each player, regardless of skill level. This camp is open to all boys ages 9–18. Players are divided into teams by age and ability. Each player is expected to attend all sessions daily. The curriculum for camp is based upon fundamental skill development and competitive interaction.

WWU Head Assistant Coach Tony Dominguez serves as the Camp Coordinator. Coach Dominguez has accumulated over 20 years coaching experience at both the high school and collegiate level. ## **Costs and Application**

- Overnight camper . . . . . \$315 US
- Commuter campers (lunch & dinner) . \$230 US
- Commuter campers (lunch only) . . . . \$215 US

The camp fee includes all materials, a reversible camp jersey and room and board. A \$50 deposit must accompany your registration. Space is limited and applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis.

## Camp Housing and Meals

First class university residence halls are used at WWU for our camp housing. Trained staff members provide 24-hour supervision. All-you-can-eat meals will be planned and prepared by the university's excellent food service staff.

## Cancellations, Refunds, Late Registration

Your tuition, less a \$50 non-refundable registration fee, will be returned without question if you cancel your enrollment prior to July 13, 2012. At any time after July 16, refunds (less the \$50 nonrefundable registration fee) will be made for medical reasons only.

Requests for refunds must be accompanied by a signed excuse from your physician. Campers who must leave during the camp due to illness or injury will receive a prorated refund based on the number of room and board days used. No refunds will be given to campers who voluntarily leave or who are sent home for disciplinary reasons or violations of University rules and policies. Registrations will be taken on a space available basis. Please call the camp to verify availability of spots before sending registration forms and/or money.
