Check-in & Registration

Participants are required to check in during the designated hours specific to each camp (see Daily Schedules). Fundamentals Camp registration begins at 12 noon.

Camp Facilities & Medical Staff

WWU's Carver Gym houses five full courts. Trainers will be on duty for all camp sessions. Each camper is responsible for his own medical insurance and/or any bills incurred.

Camp Housing and Meals

First class university residence halls are used at WWU for our camp housing. Trained staff members provide 24-hour supervision. All-you-can-eat meals will be planned and prepared by the university's excellent food service staff.

Cancellations, Refunds, Late Registration

Your tuition, less a \$50 non-refundable registration fee, will be returned without question if you cancel your enrollment prior to June 10, 2012. At any time after June 10, refunds (less the \$50 nonrefundable registration fee) will be made for medical reasons only.

Requests for refunds must be accompanied by a signed excuse from your physician. Campers who must leave during the camp due to illness or injury will receive a prorated refund based on the number of room and board days used. No refunds will be given to campers who voluntarily leave or who are sent home for disciplinary reasons or violations of University rules and policies. Registrations will be taken on a space available basis. Please call the camp to verify availability of spots before sending registration forms and/or money.



What to Bring

For your comfort and safety during the camp, please plan to bring casual clothes, workout gear (one week of changes), personal toilet articles (toothbrush, shampoo, soap, etc.), sleeping bag, pillow, and towels. You may also desire to bring spending money for snacks and souvenirs.
