**Recap of the NCAA Men's Championships:**

**Day One:**  
Wyoming Cowboy senior diver Mark Murdock begin competition at the 2011 NCAA Championships on Thursday in Minneapolis, on the 1-meter springboard. "Mark could have been a little better on the front end of his dives, but overall I think he dove pretty well," Wyoming diving coach Pat Bukowski said. "There is a lot of great divers here and Mark just needs to settle in. I think he will have a lot better day tomorrow on the 3-meter."

In the 1-meter preliminaries Murdock placed 30th with a score of 272.85. Unfortunately, Murdock's did not secure him a spot in the 1-meter finals, but he will continue competition Friday.

**Day Two:**  
Wyoming Cowboy senior diver Mark Murdock completed his second day of competition at the 2011 NCAA Championships in Minneapolis on the 3-meter springboard.

"Mark hit three of his dives today, but did not hit his other three and that hurt him," Wyoming diving coach Pat Bukowski said. "With the platform tomorrow it should be our day."

In Friday's 3-meter preliminaries Murdock placed 28th with a score of 313.05. His score did not qualify him for the finals, but he will continue the NCAA Championships on Saturday.

**Day Three:**  
Wyoming Cowboy senior diver Mark Murdock earned Honorable Mention All-American honors with a 12th-place finish (351.20) on the platform, Saturday during the 2011 NCAA Men's Swimming and Diving Championships in Minneapolis.

"Mark was on the bubble of getting into the top 16 in the prelims, but nailed his last dive to get him into

the consolation finals,” Wyoming diving coach Pat Bukowski said. “I knew he had this in him this year it was just a matter of getting his confidence up.” Murdock began his final day at the NCAA Championships on the platform. He dove in the preliminaries where he placed 16th with a score of 322.40. His 16th-place finish was good enough to get him in the consolation final. In the consolation finals, Murdock went on to place 12th with a score of 351.20. With his 12th-place finish in the consolation final he earned Honorable Mention All-American honors, the first Cowboy diver to do so since Andy Welsh in 1984. He is also the first Cowboy since Scott Usher in 2005 to score for UW at the NCAA Championships. His 12th-place finish gave the Cowboys seven points at the championships and finished them in 33rd-place of 37 teams.

“In the consolation finals Mark put a great list together,” Bukowski added. “He did a great job today. Words can’t really describe how proud of him I am.” With Saturday’s platform Murdock finished his competition at the NCAA Championships with three top 30 finishes.

### Recap of The NCAA Women’s Championships:

#### Day One:

Cowgirl Swimmer Kelsey Conci competed in the 50 freestyle at the 2011 NCAA Women’s Swimming and Diving Championships in Austin, Texas.

Conci swam in the 50 freestyle preliminary rounds on Thursday morning where she placed in a tie for 40th with a time of 22.74. Unfortunately, her time was not fast enough to get her into the finals.

#### Day Two:

Wyoming Cowgirl Swimmer Kelsey Conci became the first Cowgirl to earn Honorable Mention All-American in 19 years, on Friday at the NCAA Women’s Swimming and Diving Championships in Austin, Texas. Conci placed 10th in the 100-yard backstroke with a time of 52.36, which broke her own Mountain West Conference and UW school record of 52.50.

In the 100 back preliminary rounds, Conci swam very well according to Johnson, and placed 16th with a time of 53.28. Her finish was good enough to put her in the ‘B’ heat of the finals.

In the finals, Conci swam in the outside lane of the pool lane eight, and still was able to break her MWC and School record with a time of 52.36. According to Johnson, her time in the finals would have placed her in seventh of the ‘A’ heat.

#### Day Three:

Wyoming Cowgirl swimmer Kelsey Conci finished her excellent run at the 2011 NCAA Women’s Swimming and Diving Championships. Conci swam in the 100-yard freestyle placing 42nd with a time of 49.57. Conci swam in the 100 freestyle prelims and placed 42nd with a time of 49.57. Her time did not put her in

the finals and concluded her swimming season. Conci had an excellent performance at the NCAA Championships placing 10th in the 100 backstroke on Friday, making her the first Cowgirl to earn Honorable Mention All-American honors in 19 years. Her finish in the 100 back gave her seven points for the Cowgirls as a team at the championships. Her seven points put the Cowgirls on the scoreboard of the NCAA Championships for the first time in 19 years. Her score would finish the Cowgirls in 38th-place at the championships. She swam in the 50 freestyle on Thursday placing in a tie for 40th with a time of 22.74.
