## **CAMP INFORMATION**

**EQUIPMENT:** This is a full contact camp. All football pads are required. Mouthpieces may be purchased at camp.

**HOUSING:** All campers will be housed in UW campus dormitories. Campers MUST provide their own bedding, towels and personal care items! Coaching staff will be staying in the dorms with the campers each night.

**MEALS:** All campers will receive generous, well balanced meals in our campus dining facility.

**APPLY EARLY:** SPACE IS LIMITED!

**COACHES:** Please call to reserve space by MARCH 28, 2008.

**ALL TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL APPLICATIONS AND DEPOSITS MUST BE RECEIVED BY MAY 9, 2008!**

**DEPOSIT:** A \$100.00 **non-refundable** deposit is due with your application. The balance of camp cost is due at registration. We request that you pay by money order, or cashiers check. No personal checks please.

**DISCIPLINE:** Any violation of camp rules will result in immediate dismissal from camp with no refunds!

**PARKING:** There are numerous parking options when arriving on UW's campus this summer. Should you have questions concerning parking, please contact UW Transportation and Parking services @ 307-766-9800. Parking passes will be available for purchase at registration.

### **Per NCAA rules:**

In football, a "senior prospective student-athlete" shall not be permitted to enroll, participate, or be employed at any such sports camp or clinic. For purposes of this legislation, a senior "senior prospective student-athlete" is a prospective student-athlete who is eligible for admission to a member institution or who has started classes for the senior year in high school. A preparatory school or two-year college student is considered to be a "senior prospective student-athlete" for purposes of this rule. A "senior prospective student-athlete" may attend a camp or clinic, provided the student-athlete does not participate in any physical activities.
