DEPOSIT: A \$100.00 **non-refundable** deposit is due with your application. The balance of camp cost is due at registration. We request that you pay by money order, or cashiers check. No personal checks please.

DISCIPLINE: Any violation of camp rules will result in immediate dismissal from camp with no refunds!

In football, a "senior prospective student-athlete" shall not be permitted to enroll, participate, or be employed at any such sports camp or clinic. For purposes of this legislation, a senior "senior prospective student-athlete" is a prospective student-athlete who is eligible for admission to a member institution or who has started classes for the senior year in high school. A preparatory school or two-year college student is considered to be a "senior prospective student-athlete" for purposes of this rule. A "senior prospective student-athlete" may attend a camp or clinic, provided the student-athlete does not participate in any physical activities.
