Postgame Football Notes
Following a 37-15 loss to Temple
on Dec. 17, 2011**

Team Notes

- University of Wyoming Athletics Director Tom Burman announced before today's game that Wyoming Head Football Coach Dave Christensen has agreed in principle to a new five-year contract. No other terms were released at the time of the announcement.

Offensive Notes

- Freshman quarterback Brett Smith had 127 yards passing and 65 yards rushing for 189 total yards Saturday, giving him 3,329 yards in 13 games this year. That total puts him No. 3 all-time on the UW single-season total offense list.
- With three turnovers, Wyoming lost the turnover battle for only the second time this year. The only other game in which Wyoming was behind in the turnover battle was against Utah State.
- The Pokes went 4-for-4 on fourth-down Saturday. Prior to Saturday, Wyoming was 5-14 (36 percent) on the season.
- Freshman running back Kody Sutton scored his first career touchdown Saturday, with a 14-yard catch-and-run TD late in the fourth quarter.
- Freshman wide receiver Dominic Ruffan caught nine passes for 24 yards, a career mark in receptions. His previous high was six versus New Mexico.

Defensive Notes

- Senior linebacker Brian Hendricks had 13 tackles, moving him to No. 11 on UW's all-time list. Hendricks finished his Wyoming career with 309 tackles, just two shy of tying for 10th place.
- Senior defensive end Gabe Knapton had seven stops, giving him a total of 368 for his career.
