University of Wyoming Football Postgame Notes

Following a 35-10 Home Loss Versus BYU on Nov. 17, 2007

Postgame Notes

- * With today's loss, the Cowboys finished 4-2 at home this season.
- * Twelve Cowboys played in their final home game at War Memorial Stadium today. Those seniors include Wade Betschart, Luke Chase, Sean Claffey, Jacob Doss, Michael Ford, Troy Lewis, Hoost Marsh, Michael Medina, John Prater, Julius Stinson and Billy Vinnedge.

Offensive Notes

- * The Cowboys had their best passing day of the season today as they threw for 268 yards. Wyoming's previous season high was 260 yards at Air Force.
- * With his seven receptions for 71 yards, senior Michael Ford moved into 10th place on UW's all-time career receiving yards list with 1,851 yards. He passed Archie Gray who had 1,787 receiving yards from 1972-74. He also moved up on UW's career receptions list and currently ranks seventh with 154 career receptions. On that list, he moved past Gordy Wood (151 receptions from 1987-90) and Mike Jones (152 receptions from 1990-93).
- * Junior Wynel Seldon scored his 18th career touchdown in today's game. He has 17 rushing TD's and one receiving TD in his career. He now ranks 11th in career TD's scored in school history.
- * Sophomore Karsten Sween had the third best game of his career in terms of passing yards with 217 yards today. His career high is 253 against Virginia in 2007. He also threw for 227 at Boise State earlier this season.
- * After missing the first 10 games of the season with a torn hamstring, senior quarterback Jacob Doss returned to the field today. He completed seven of 11 passes for 51 yards in today's game.

Defensive Notes

- * The last two games, the Pokes have given up over 400 yards of total offense in each game--505 to Utah and 497 to BYU. Those are the only two games this year that the Pokes have allowed over 400 yards of total offense to an opponent.
- * For the first time this season, Wyoming allowed over 300 yards passing to an opponent. BYU threw for 362 yards against the Cowboys.
- * Redshirt freshman Chris Prosinski had a career high 13 tackles in today's game. His previous career high was six last week against Utah.
- * Senior John Prater also had a career high 12 tackles in today's game. His previous career high was 10 last weekend against Utah.
- * Senior Julius Stinson broke up three passes in today's game and has now broken up 11 passes this season.

Special Teams Notes

- * With a 20-yard field goal in the second quarter of today's game, senior Billy Vinnedge has now made nine consecutive field goals.
- * Sophomore Mitch Unrein and senior Julius Stinson each blocked a field goal in today's game. The Cowboys have now blocked four kicks this season, two by Stinson (a field goal and an extra point), one by Unrein (field goal) and one by sophomore John Fletcher (extra point).
