Wyoming Golf Continues Success in the Classroom and on the Golf Course

- Cowboy Golf Earns 3.35 grade point average as a team this fall
- Cowgirl Golf Earns 3.15 grade point average as a team this fall
- The University of Wyoming Cowboy golf team was honored as one of the top academic teams in the country in 2010, by being selected as a Golf Coaches Association of America (GCAA) All-Academic Team. The Cowboys are among the top-64 teams in the country in terms of average team grade-point average. A total of 64 teams were named All-Academic Teams by achieving at least a 3.0 average GPA.
- Gabe Maier ranks 6th in MWC and 215th nationally
- For the first time in Cowgirl history every Cowgirl golfer averaged under 80 for the fall season

Wyoming Alumni earns PGA Tour Card

Former University of Wyoming Cowboy golfer David Hearn recently made the PGA TOUR for the upcoming 2011 season. He earned his TOUR card by finishing inside the top-25 money winners on the Nationwide Tour this past season.

Hearn, a native of Brampton, Ontario, finished 21st on the Nationwide Tour's money list in 2010. He played in 25 events and finished in the top 10 five times and the top 25 nine times. He finished the season with a stroke average of 69.88. Hearn is no stranger to the PGA TOUR, as this is the second time he has earned his TOUR card.

Hearn, 31, played at Wyoming from 1997-2001. He was a First Team All-Mountain West Conference selection in 2001 and qualified for NCAA Regionals three times. He held UW's record for lowest single-season stroke average (a 72.40 in 1999-00) until last season when current Cowboy Gabe Maier broke that record with a stroke average of 71.83.

Cowgirl Golf Signs Two for the 2011-2012 Season

Wyoming women's golf coach Josey Stender announced last November the addition of two student-athletes, Samantha Stancato and Emily Woodard, for the 2011-2012 golf season.

"Sam and Emily are proven competitors and will be great additions to our already deep roster," Stender said. "Both young ladies are long off the tee and fit the athletic model that has been very successful for us. "Emily and Sam are also outstanding students which will help continue our academic tradition in Wyoming golf."

Woodard, of Cheyenne, Wyo., is a 5-foot-11 right-hander who will graduate from Cheyenne Central High School. She was a four-year letterman in golf, and also lettered in indoor and outdoor track. She won the state championship twice and was the runner-up in her senior year. Academically, she was an honor roll student all four years and in the National Honor Society in her senior year. "Emily is one of the best female players to come out of Wyoming in a long time and she knows how to win," Stender said. "She has been very successful in nationally ranked events, high school and statewide amateur tournaments. We are fortunate to keep a competitor like her in her home state to represent the Cowgirls."

Stancato hails from Colorado Springs, Colo., and attends Coronado High School. The 5-foot-7 student-athlete carried a 79.4 scoring average in her tournaments last season. She finished tied for first at an event Nov. 6-7 in Arizona on the Future Collegians World Tour, shooting a 148(+8) over two rounds. Academically, she was on the 3.75 GPA list for three years and was a member of the academic all-state team. "Sam is a determined hard worker with a great mind set for the game," Stender said. "She has great fundamentals and continues to add wins, both nationally and regionally, to her resume."

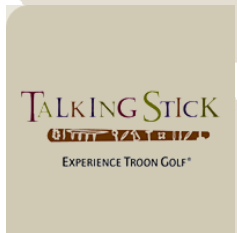
