

## ***About the Camp***

Join the University of Wyoming First Tee for an exciting three days of golf instruction this summer. The camp is designed to cater to the junior golfers' ability, regardless of age. Campers stay on the University of Wyoming campus as resident campers and live just as the current Cowboy and Cowgirl golfers do. Transportation is provided to and from all activities for campers and all meals are included.



Instruction will include but is not limited to: putting, chipping, pitching, bunker play, full swing analysis, course management, mental management and rules instruction. Competitions will be setup to allow the juniors to compete as individuals and teammates. Lessons will incorporate the nine core values: judgment, sportsmanship, respect, confidence, responsibility, honesty, integrity, perseverance, and courtesy.

Evening activities will allow the students to learn more about playing collegiate golf, practice habits, and goal setting. In addition, junior golfers will make life long friends and memories while they are enjoying the game of golf.

## Important Questions

### What is the cost and what do we get?

\$400 includes room, all meals, transportation, instructional swing video, golf drill packet, and camp goodies.

### Is there a cancellation policy?

A \$50.00 administrative fee will be applied to all cancellations. If you cancel after June 1st the \$100 deposit is non-refundable.

### Is there a limit to the number of campers?

In order to provide optimum instruction and attention to each junior golfer the number of campers is limited to 30.

### Are there special parking instructions?

There are numerous parking options when arriving on UW's campus this summer (see below). Should you have any questions concerning parking, please contact UW Transportation & Parking Services at (307) 766-9800.

1. Parking Meters: Meters are located throughout campus at a cost of .25/half hour.
2. Day Permits: Day permits may be purchased for \$4.00 /per day (A, C, or R lot). Please contact UW Transportation and Parking services.
3. Free Parking: The gravel lot east of the football stadium and the golf course are the only free parking available on the UW campus.

All campers must carry their own accident insurance. Your insurance company, policy number, and agent should all be indicated on your application.

The camp is designed to be a fun, educational environment. However, the use of drugs, alcohol, and smoking are prohibited. In addition, any other misconduct can be grounds for dismissal.
