### 9 years of Division I Coaching Experience

Gyulai's second year with the Cowgirl program was very successful. The team almost doubled their number of wins from the year before as they went 14-8 overall and 5-3 in the MWC to place third. The 14 overall wins and five conference victories were the most

ever in school history, plus the third place finish was the highest a Wyoming team had ever placed in league play. They defeated three conference foes for the first time in school history as well with wins over BYU, New Mexico and San Diego State. The Cowgirls finished the year nationally ranked at #73, first time in program history. With six conference wins over the last two years, Gyulai became the winningest coach in conference play with a 6-10 record. Gyulai brings 9 years of Division I coaching experience. She is a USPTA-P1 Professional.

## Dean Clower

University of Wyoming

3<sup>rd</sup> Year Assistant Women's Tennis Coach



### 8 years of Division I Coaching Experience

Dean Clower begins his third season with the Cowgirl coaching staff after spending the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at Lamar University (Beaumont, Texas). Clower began his collegiate career as a student-athlete at Cowley County Community College

in Arkansas City in Kansas. He was a two-year team captain and was ranked fifth in the nation in doubles as a freshman and sophomore. Clower then moved on to a two-year career at Lamar University. During his senior season, he posted a 48th ranking in NCAA Division I. He became the first player in school history to accomplish that feat. Clower brings 8 years of Division I Coaching experience. He is USPTA certified.
