Mountain West Conference Embarks on Another Season: The 2006 volleyball season marked the eighth year for the existence of the Mountain West Conference. Air Force, Brigham Young, Colorado State, New Mexico, UNLV, San Diego State and Utah joined Wyoming in forming the conference. TCU Horned Frogs joined the MWC beginning in July of 2005.

Utah won the regular season championship, while the Colorado State Rams took the MWC Tournament title in 2006. Three teams participated in the 2006 NCAA Women's Volleyball Championships, which included BYU, Colorado State and Utah.

Player and Team Notes

-The Cowgirls return four starters (Angie Hellbaum, Lauren Scott, Rachel Smith, Tasha Weishahn) along with four other returning letterwinners, who saw significant playing time in 2006. In all they return eight letterwinners.

-Of those returning players, they played in 16 matches or more in 2006, including four juniors, three sophomores and a true freshman.

-One of those top returners is senior Rachel Smith, who led the team in kills with 387 (3.79 kpg), which was fourth in the league, while adding 2.00 digs and 29 total blocks. In conference matches, she was averaged 3.33 kpg, which was eighth in the MWC, in addition to averaging 1.89 digs per game.

-Wyoming returns six of seven major statistical category leaders to the team from 2006. Smith led the way in kills (3.79 kpg) and points (4.23 ppg) followed by Lauren Smith with 93 total blocks. Setter Tasha Weishahn was first in assists (11.08 aspg) and aces (.30 sapg) while libero Samantha Eley recorded 377 digs for a 3.85 average.

-The Cowgirls welcome six newcomers to this year's squad which are all freshmen. Jenna Arneson (6-1, OH, Dove Canyon, Calif.), Kayla Govier (6-3, MB/RS, Arvada, Colo.), JennaRae Jester (6-2, RS/MB, Cheyenne, Wyo.), Angela Ostrander (6-0, OH, Lingle, Wyo.), Chantilly Watson (5-11, MB, Spanaway, Wash.), Lauren Whitney (5-11, OH, Coto de Caza, Calif.)

-Two Cowgirls earned All-Tournament Team awards during the 2006 season. Outside Rachel Smith was named MVP of the UniWyo Cowgirl Classic and to the CenturyTel/Premier Classic. Lauren Scott was named to the All-Tournament team at the UniWyo Cowgirl Classic and the Hilton Las Cruces Classic.

-Wyoming schedule features three teams that participated in the 2006 NCAA Tournament. All three will come out of the Mountain West Conference in BYU, Colorado State and Utah. Two of those teams, BYU and Utah, each finished the season ranked in the final AVCA Coaches Poll, while CSU received votes.

-Six individuals garnered Academic All-MWC honors this past season as well. Angie Hellbaum, Nicki Kent, Carissa Lee, Lauren Scott, Andrea Seele and Natasha Weishahn all earned the award.

A Recap of the UNLV match: The Wyoming Cowgirl volleyball team (13-15 overall, 7-9 in the MWC) closed out their season with three game loss (30-22, 30-25, 30-23) to the fourth seeded UNLV Rebels (20-9 overall, 10-6 in the MWC) in the opening round of the MWC Tournament, on Thursday, in Las Vegas.

"Unfortunately, we struggled once again at the tournament," said head coach Pat Stangle. "It was a match that you have to get ready for and obviously we didn't. It's something we need to figure out, because we certainly have the ability to play a lot better than we did."

Rachel Smith led the way for the Cowgirls with 14 kills, six digs and three block assists. Senior Andrea Seele also finished in double-figures with 12 kills and three block assists. Outside hitter Annie Meyers had 13 digs followed by Carissa Lee with ten. As a team, Wyoming hit .167 (46-22-144) for the match and had six total team blocks.

UNLV was led by Maria Aladjova and Lauren Miramontes who both had 13 kills, while three players finished with double-digits in digs. They hit .342 (51-12-114) for the match and had 13 total team blocks.

The Cowgirls opened up the first game by taking an early 6-3 lead, which was answered with a 7-1 run by UNLV to give them a three-point lead, 10-7. They extended that by scoring the next four of seven to make it 14-10. Wyoming scored three straight to pull within one, but the Rebels responded with a 7-3 run to go up by five, 21-16. Unfortunately, the Cowgirls could not pull any closer as UNLV took the first game 30-22.

In game two, Wyoming took a small 3-1 lead, but UNLV answered with a 9-3 scoring run to gain a four point advantage, 10-6. The Cowgirls pulled to within three, 12-9, unfortunately the Rebels ran off three straight points to extend the lead to six, 15-9, and eventually nine, 21-12. A 7-5 run by Wyoming pulled them to within six, 25-19, and then three, 27-24. It wouldn't be enough as UNLV scored the final three of four to win the game, 30-25.

The Cowgirls took the lead once again to begin game three, 5-2. UNLV would respond with a 5-2 run to even it up at seven all. Over the next several points, there were five lead changes and five ties to make it 14-14 all. The Rebels went on a 4-2 run to take a two point lead, 18-16, but Wyoming quickly tied it up at 18. Unfortunately, UNLV scored the next five of seven to take a three-point lead, 23-20. The Cowgirls pulled to within one, 23-22, but in the end they couldn't overcome the deficit as they fell 30-23 in the game and 3-0 in the match.

The Cowgirls finish the year with an overall record of 13-15 and a 7-9 mark in the Mountain West Conference.

University of Wyoming, Head Volleyball Coach

Pat Stangle, who had been the top assistant at the University of Washington for two years, enters his fourth season as the head volleyball coach at the University of Wyoming. He was named head coach on Jan. 22, 2004 and became the 11th head volleyball coach in Cowgirl history.

He recorded his first Division I career coaching victory on Sept. 2, 2004 as Wyoming defeated Idaho State, 3-2. His first conference win came on Sept. 24, 2004 against New Mexico.

In his first season, he guided the Cowgirls to a 13-14 overall record and a fifth place finish in the MWC with a 6-8 mark, while outside hitter Rachel Smith garnered Co-Freshman Player of the Year honors. On Oct. 15, 2004, the Cowgirls defeated the BYU Cougars, in Laramie, 3-1. It was the first time since Nov. 17, 1989 when both teams were members of the High Country Athletic Conference and only the fourth time in the series history. Wyoming also won a home and away conference series for the first time since becoming members of the MWC as they swept Air Force and New Mexico, and at the time their six conference victories were the most since the beginning of Mountain West Conference play.

In 2005, he led the Cowgirls to a 12-16 overall record and a 7-9 mark in the Mountain West Conference for a sixth place finish in the league. The seven conference victories were the most since becoming members of the MWC. He also earned his 25th win as a Division I Coach as the Cowgirls defeated the New Mexico Lobos, 3-0, on Nov. 19, 2005 in Laramie.

During the 2006 campaign, Wyoming finished with an overall record of 13-15 and 7-9 in the MWC which placed them fifth in the league. The Cowgirls tied the most wins in a conference season with seven, which they also did in 2005. They also swept the season series against Air Force and New Mexico during conference play.

Stangle came to Wyoming after two years at the University of Washington. As an assistant (2002-03) for Jim McLaughlin, he served as the team's recruiting coordinator and assisted with the offense as well as in all administrative aspects of the program. During that time, the Huskies compiled a record of 43-20 overall and 19-17 in the PAC 10. In 2003, they finished 23-9 overall and 10-8 in the conference, while advancing to the Elite 8 in the NCAA Tournament.

"There is great support for the program from the administration on down. The facilities make that very apparent. After spending time there, and talking with several people including Barbara (Burke) it's obvious there is something special happening. For us to come, it had to be special because we had an outstanding situation at Washington.

"I'm also excited because I think it is a great fit for our family. Professionally and personally, this is the right move for us."

Prior to his tenure at Washington, Stangle spent five years as head women's volleyball coach at Seward County Community College (Liberal, Kansas), where he helped the Lady Saints to three straight appearances in the NJCAA national championships. Under Stangle's direction, Seward also won three straight NJCAA Region VI titles from 1999-2001 and two Jayhawk Conference championships. He coached 18 NJCAA All-Region Players and six NJCAA All-Americans during that time. In his five-year tenure, Stangle posted an impressive record of 225-34 and earned both conference and district coach-of-the-year honors.

Prior to Seward, Stangle coached two seasons at Central College in McPherson, Kan., where his teams qualified twice for the regional tournament - a first in school history. His eight-year combined head coaching record currently stands at 307-86.

A 1988 graduate of Hardin-Simmons University in Abilene, Texas, Stangle played middle blocker on the Cowboy volleyball team that participated in the 1986 NCAA Division I Midwest Regional Championships at Ohio State. Stangle owns a bachelor's and master's degree in business administration, the latter of which he received in 1993 from the University of Texas-San Antonio.

Stangle and his wife, the former Melissa Peterson, have three children, Casey (13), Haley (10) and Doak (7).

Michelle Patton returns for her fourth season at Wyoming after spending the previous two and a half seasons at the University of Washington as a volunteer assistant coach. A four-year letterwinner with the Huskies from 1994-97, her main duties included team defense and working with the setters. During that time, she also was the head coach of the Seattle Athletic Club men's team for two years.

A three-year starter at setter, Patton helped lead the Huskies to three NCAA tournament appearances, including a trip to the Sweet 16 as a senior in 1997. She still ranks second on the UW career list for assists with 2,655 and seventh for aces with 97. Patton played in over 300 games at Washington, earning Pac-10 Honorable Mention All-Academic honors her final three seasons.

After graduating in 1999 with a degree in English and a minor in speech communications, the Richmond, Calif., native worked as a content editor for HomeGrocer.com in nearby Renton, Wash.

Teron Uy (pronounced we), who completed his second year with the program in 2006, joined the Wyoming coaching staff after his second stint at the University of Washington. From 2004 to 2005, Uy was the volunteer assistant coach where he was primarily in charge of training the setters.

His coaching debut was highlighted by Courtney Thompson's selection to the AVCA All-America First Team and Washington's appearance in the NCAA Final 4 in 2004. From 1994-98 under then head coach Bill Neville and 2001-03 under current head coach Jim McLaughlin, he was the technical director in charge of individual, team, and opponent statistical and video analysis through the use of Ark Technologies and Data Volley.

In between stints at the University of Washington and even doubling up one year, Uy spent three years as an assistant coach from 2000-02 at Seattle University.

From 1996 through 2005, he was the technical director of Sudden Impact Volleyball and chartered developing training philosophies and methodologies to be used as well as developing coach training. Other duties included general operation of the club, along with coaching teams of varying age groups. Uy has also been involved as a summer camp instructor with the Junkyard Dawgs Volleyball Camps, Nevillizms Satellite Camps and the Jim McLaughlin Volleyball Camps

Uy earned his bachelor's degree in computer science from Santa Clara University in 1991.
