Individual Skills Camp

The purpose of the skills camp is to develop the fundamental skills of volleyball. Campers will learn strategies for offense and defense as well as specific positional training. The camp is a great opportunity to learn the game of volleyball in a safe and positive environment. Basic skills are stressed in drills while team play is incorporated to teach how all the fundamentals fit in the game. The camp is open to girls entering grades 6-12.

Buckaroo Camp

The "Buckaroo" camp is available for boys and girls younger than 6th grade. Buckaroos must be commuter campers. This camp is designed for the younger pokes. Campers age 5-11 will learn fundamentals and beginning skills in an exciting and nurturing environment. Buckaroos can only be commuter campers and no meals will be provided. The Buckaroo camp runs from 9 AM to 12 noon on July 12th through 14th, 2012.

Arrivals and Departures

Camper registration (and move-in for the dormitories) will be on the first day of camp from 8-10 AM. From check-in/move-in all campers will walk together with staff to the UniWyo Sports Complex at 10:30 AM to begin the first session of camp. Lunch will be the first meal served. The campers will finish the skills camp with a closing ceremony in the UniWyo Sports Complex at 3:30 PM on Saturday, the final day of camp. Parents and families are welcome to attend. Campers will be dismissed from the Lobby of the residence hall at 4:00 PM after their rooms have been inspected. A day schedule for commuter campers will be available for parents at camp registration. The evening camp sessions are open for parents to view player competitions.

Necessary Equipment

T-Shirts, shorts, gym shoes, socks, knee pads, towels, twin bedding, toiletry items and a water bottle are all necessary items. An alarm clock would be a benefit. There will be snacks available at the camp store along with Wyoming Volleyball apparel, including t-shirts, and shorts. Campers must manage their own money.

Camp Rules

Campers will be supervised by coaches at all times. Campers are not allowed to be off campus unless with an organized and supervised camp group. No one is to cross Grand Ave or 15th Street. We will always walk together as a group and never without a camp counselor. Early departures must furnish a written parental notice to the camp director at camp check in and campers must check out with their floor supervisor. Failure to comply with these rules will result in immediate dismissal. All residence halls are 24-hour secure dormitories and will have female staff members residing on each floor as camp counselors.
