Scouting the Lobos: Wyoming begin the 2011 Mountain West Tournament on Friday, Nov. 18, against the New Mexico Lobos. The Lobos, who come into the tournament as the fifth seed, finished the regular season 14-13 overall and 6-8 in the Mountain West. They are led by Ashley Rhoades with 3.88 kills and almost one block per set. UNM returns three starters and ten letterwinners in the Mountain West a year ago. This is 67th meeting between the two schools. Wyoming leads the series 36-30. The last time the two teams met was Nov. 10, 2011 as the Cowgirls swept the season series with a 3-2 win over the Lobos in Albuquerque. Wyoming defeated New Mexico at home on Oct. 15, 2011, 3-0, in Laramie. UNM is coached by Jeff Nelson who is in his fifth season.

University of Wyoming Cowgirl Volleyball 2011 Notes

2011 Player and Team Notes

Purdy inching her way into the record book: Junior Jodi Purdy has made her move into the Cowgirl record book this season. With 387 kills this season, she currently has 1,135, which is eighth all-time in school history. Also has 940 career digs which is seventh all-time and 101 career service aces which is eighth all time.

Keyes with the Assist: In just two short years, sophomore setter Rachel Keyes has put her stamp on the Wyoming record book. With 789 assists this season, she currently ranks 11th all-time in school history with 1,229.

Back-to-Back 20-win seasons: For the second time in school history, the Wyoming Cowgirl volleyball team has won at least 20 games in consecutive seasons. They currently have a 20-10 overall this year, while compiling a 22-10 mark overall a year ago.

The number 9: With a 3-2 win over TCU (11/12/11), the Cowgirls reached nine conference wins for the season. It's the most conference wins for a Cowgirl team in Mountain West history. The third place finish is also the highest they've ever finished since being members of the league.

Purdy Named Co-MWC Player of the Week: Wyoming outside hitter Jodi Purdy has been named Mountain West Conference Volleyball Player of the Week for matches played from Nov. 7-11. It marks the second time this season and the third time in her career that she has earned the honor. Purdy, a 6-0 junior from Winterset, Iowa, led the Cowgirls to two big 3-2 road wins at New Mexico and TCU last week. The wins put Wyoming in a third-place tie with TCU to end the regular season and give UW the No. 4 seed in the 2011 MW Volleyball Championship this week in Albuquerque, N.M. Purdy recorded a double-double of 15 kills and 14 digs to go along with five blocks at New Mexico on Thursday, Nov. 10. At TCU on Nov. 12, Purdy had another double-double with 15 kills and a career-high 23 digs. Purdy leads the Mountain West with 20 double-doubles on the season. For the week, Purdy averaged 3.00 kills, 3.70 digs and 0.90 blocks per set, while hitting .237. She averaged 3.65 points per set over 10 total sets.

Purdy Named Co-MWC Player of the Week: Wyoming outside hitter Jodi Purdy was named Mountain West Conference Volleyball Player of the Week for matches from Oct. 3-9. It marks the second weekly honor of her career. A 5-11 junior from Winterset, Iowa, she led the Cowgirls to a 2-0 record last week, including a come-from-behind 3-2 win over No. 23 Colorado State. Earlier in the week, Purdy recorded 15 kills and 18 digs in a 3-1 win at Northern Colorado. Against Colorado State on Saturday in Laramie, Purdy recorded 16 kills and a career-high 21 digs as the Cowgirls beat CSU for the first time since 1997. Purdy also recorded her 1,000th career kill in the match. For the week, Purdy averaged 3.44 kills, 1.22 blocks and 4.33 digs per set, while hitting .220. She averaged 4.28 points per set over nine total sets.

Kitic and Purdy named to the All-Tournament Team: Senior Tamara Kitic and junior Jodi Purdy were named to the All-Tournament Team at the Hampton Inn Invitational. Kitic averaged 2.43 kills and 1.29 digs while recording a career high ten digs. Purdy tallied 69 kills (4.93 kps) and 47 (3.36 dps) and finished with a season high 21 kills against College of Charleston.

Kirby and Purdy named to the All-Tournament Team: Redshirt freshman Erin Kirby and junior Jodi Purdy were named to the All-Tournament Team at the UniWyo Cowgirl Classic. Kirby averaged 3.00 kills and 3.40, while hitting .411 (30-7-56). Purdy, from Winterset, Iowa, tallied 43 kills (4.30 kps) and 30 digs (3.00 dps) for the weekend.

Coffman and Keyes named to the All-Tournament Team: Junior Camille Coffman and sophomore Rachel Keyes were named to the All-Tournament Team at the Sheraton Inn Drake Invitational. Coffman averaged 2.70 kills, while hitting .420 (27-6-50) for the weekend. Keyes averaged 6.40 assists and 1.80 digs per set.

-The Cowgirls return two starters (Jodi Purdy, Reese (Roehrkasse) Plante along with seven other returning letterwinners who played a significant role last season. Of those returning players eight of the nine played in at least 17 matches or more in 2010, including one junior, three sophomores, two redshirt freshmen and two true freshmen.

-The top returning player for the Cowgirls is junior outside hitter Jodi Purdy. An All-MWC selection in 2010, she led the team in kills (3.21 kps), aces (0.39 saps) and points (3.95 pps). In conference action, she ranked fourth in aces (0.35 saps), sixth in kills (3.16 kps) and points (3.82 pps).

University of Wyoming Cowgirl Volleyball 2011 Notes

Cowgirl Volleyball Selected Fifth In Preseason Poll: Wyoming Cowgirl outside hitter Jodi Purdy, today, was selected to the pre-season All-Mountain West Team for the second year in row, while the team was picked to finish fifth in the MW pre-season poll.

An All-Conference selection last season and the MWC Freshman of the Year in 2009, Purdy returns after averaging 3.21 kills and 3.95 points a year ago, while adding 2.61 digs. In league action, she finished with 3.16 kills, 2.93 digs and 3.82 points per set, and ranked among the top ten in both kills and points. Purdy is the top returning player in kills after ranking seventh in the league.

A voting panel comprised of the eight Mountain West head volleyball coaches chose defending league champion Colorado State as the favorite to win the 2011 MW regular season title. The Rams collected five first-place votes and 60 total points. New Mexico, the 2010 runner-up, was selected to finish second with 56 points and claimed the three remaining first-place votes. San Diego State received 51 points for third place in the poll, while TCU earned 41 points for fourth place. Carrie Yerty

(Washington State, 1992)

University of Wyoming, Head Volleyball Coach

Carrie Yerty, who spent 12 years at the University of Memphis, begins her fourth season as the head coach with the Wyoming Cowgirl program. She was named the head coach on January 22, 2008 and is the 12th head coach in school history.

During the 2010 campaign, the program continued to make significant improvement under Yerty. They started off the year with an 11-0 record, which was the longest winning streak since 2002, and continued onto a 16-2 mark, the best start in school history. With a 22-10 record overall, it was the fourth most wins in school history and only the sixth 20-plus win season for the program. The Cowgirls went 7-9 in league play, which were the most victories since the 2006 season. They defeated BYU for the first time since Oct. 15, 2004 and in Provo since Sept. 22, 1984. For the second season in a row, Jodi Purdy garnered post-season honors as she was named First Team All-MWC. Eleven Cowgirls were selected Academic All-MWC, six MW Scholar Athletes and JennaRae Jester was named First Team Academic All-District VII and to the 2010 ESPN Academic All-America Volleyball Second Team.

In her first season with the Cowgirls, they went 5-20 overall and 4-12 in league play. She recorded her first victory at the University of Wyoming over Cleveland State (9/13/08). Her first Mountain West Conference win came with a 3-0 sweep of the Utah Utes (9/20/08), who at the time were receiving votes and finished the season ranked 16th in the Bison/AVCA Coaches Poll. Four Cowgirls earned Academic All-MWC honors, three were named MWC Scholar Athletes and Carissa Lee was named ESPN the Magazine Third Team Academic All-District VII.

In 2009, the team more than doubled their number of victories as they finished 13-18 overall and 3-13 in league play. It was the most wins for a Cowgirl team since 2006. Newcomer Jodi Purdy garnered MWC Freshman of the Year honors as she led the team in kills and points, following closely in digs and service aces. She was the first Cowgirl since 2007 to earn post-season honors. Ten Cowgirls earned Academic All-MWC and JennaRae Jester was selected to the ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District VII Second Team.

Over the first two seasons in her rebuilding and recruiting process, Yerty signed nine newcomers which included Jodi Purdy who was named MWC Freshman of the Year. They are also getting it done in the classroom. The 2008 team was one of 71 Division I Institutions to be named by the American Volleyball Coaches Association as a recipient of the 2008-09 AVCA Team Academic Award. The Cowgirls had an overall grade point average of 3.352 for the 2008-09 Academic Year. The 2009 squad followed that up by earning the AVCA Team Academic Award for the second consecutive year. They were one of 94 Division I teams to win the award with a team gpa of 3.364.

The longest tenured head coach in Memphis volleyball history, she posted the best record among all Conference USA head volleyball coaches from 2001-2007, accumulating a 164-77 (.680) record during that time span. She is also the winningest volleyball coach in University of Memphis history, posting a career head-coaching mark of 233-174 (.572). Under Yerty's leadership, she amassed 123 wins in those five seasons, including a school record 30-6 finish in 2003 and two appearances in the C-USA Championship title match.

In 2007, she helped lead Memphis to another 20-win season with a mark of 23-12 overall and an 11-5 record in conference play. Three Tigers garnered post-season honors, including Shelby Burton who was named AVCA All-Midwest Region for the second straight year. She was also named First Team All-Conference USA, while her teammates Laura Côté and Ashley Liford were recognized on the Second Team.

Under her guidance in 2006, the Tiger volleyball program produced three AVCA All-Americans and First Team All-Conference USA performers in Shelby Burton, Laura Côté and Heather Watts. In other post-season honors, Christen Clayton was tabbed as the conference's Libero of the Year and Heather Watts was the Setter of the Year. Yerty's emphasis on athletic performance and academic achievement resulted in ESPN The Magazine naming Côté and Clayton to their list of Academic All-District honorees, as well as Ashley Liford's selection to the C-USA All-Academic Team. In addition to individual student-athlete academic honors, her teams have been recognized by the AVCA for their team GPAs. The 2006 team received the C-USA Sport Academic Award after posting a 3.485 GPA for the 2006-07 school year—the highest GPA ever to be recorded by any team in Memphis history. The squad also garnered the Game Plan/AVCA Team Academic Award for the second consecutive year. The 2005 squad was tabbed as one of 54 Division I teams to win the Game Plan/AVCA Team Academic Award. The 2005 Tiger team had a 3.327 cumulative GPA for the school year.

Yerty began the rebuilding process when she took the helm of the Tiger volleyball program on July 15, 1996, replacing former head coach Penny Lucas-White less than six weeks before the start of the season. She inherited a squad that finished 13-20 the previous year and featured just five returning players. In her first year, the Tigers finished 8-27 overall and 1-13 in Conference USA.

In just her second season as head coach, Yerty made one of the biggest turnarounds in the program's history. Never had a Tiger squad won less than 10 matches one year and finished above .500 the next. She guided the 1997 Tigers to a 19-14 overall record, 6-10 conference mark and a fourth place finish, including a victory over the Australian National Team at the Montana State Tournament. The Tigers also made strides in the Conference USA postseason tournament, winning their first-round meeting with UAB and advancing to the second round, where they dropped a 3-1 decision to top-seeded and eventual NCAA participant Houston.

In 1998, Yerty led her team to their first win in school history over the University of Houston, and for the second-straight season, Memphis advanced to the second round of the C-USA Tournament. The Tigers finished the season with an 18-14 overall record and a 6-10 mark in conference. It was the first time since 1994 that a Tiger volleyball team had recorded back-to-back winning seasons. Memphis had its second All-Conference USA honoree in 2001 when senior Amie Hamilton earned Second Team accolades, the first Tiger to earn an all-conference honor under Yerty and the first to do so since 1995.

Yerty saw her commitment to long-term success move forward in 2003 when she guided the Tigers to a 30-6 mark and its' first-ever appearance in the Conference USA Championship match. That team was just the second team in C-USA history to hit the 30-win mark. The Tigers' .833 winning percentage was the best single-season mark in school history. Three student-athletes were named to the Conference USA All-Conference teams in 2003. Senior Brittany Barnett was named to the Second Team, while Heather Watts and Tiara Gilkey both earned Third Team honors. For her stellar senior campaign, Watts garnered C-USA Setter of the Year and First Team honors, while Gilkey earned Second Team All-Conference accolades that same year.

Yerty led Memphis to its second-consecutive 25-win season in 2004, as the Tigers advanced to the semifinals of the Conference USA Tournament for the second-straight year. Memphis' 27-10 mark in 2004 marked the third time since 1990 that the Tigers won 27 matches in a school-best 7-0 start. The .730 winning percentage is the third-highest since 1994.

Through it all, Yerty continued to stress academic excellence as well as athletic achievement. Heather Watts earned her third-straight Academic All-District First Team honor in 2004. Watts became the program's second Academic All-America recipient, earning Third Team honors in 2003 and First Team in 2004. Watts joined former Tiger April Harriman, who earned Second Team honors in 2000, as the program's Academic All-America honorees. Watts also earned ESPN the Magazine Academic All-American Second Team honors in 2004, before receiving an NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship, which was the first ever in school history. Over her 12 seasons, Yerty blazed recruiting trails that resulted in four Academic All-America honorees, seven All-Conference USA honorees, two C-USA All-Freshman Team honorees, one C-USA Defensive Player of the Year, one C-USA Libero of the Year and four AVCA All-Region and three AVCA All-American honorable mentions. Additionally, since the 1996-97 school year, players on Yerty's squads that have completed their eligibility have received their college diplomas at a 93 percent clip.

Prior to becoming the Tigers' head coach, Yerty was an assistant coach at the University of Arizona during the 1995 season where, among her on-court coaching duties, she also served as the recruiting coordinator. One of her recruiting classes at the University of Arizona was ranked in the top five in the nation by recruiting magazines. On the court, she worked closely with the squad's middle blockers as she helped lead the Wildcats to a 14-14 overall record. She also supervised the academic study table and assisted with scheduling and travel, as well as working closely with camps and clinics. Yerty broke into the collegiate coaching ranks in 1992 when she accepted an assistant coaching position at Eastern Washington in Cheney, Wash. Yerty served under former head coach Pamela Parks at EWU for three years, working closely with the middle blockers and serving as the recruiting coordinator.

Yerty's coaching background goes much deeper than the collegiate level. She, along with her husband, Lee, founded the Northwest All-Star Volleyball Touring Camp in 1991, in which they managed and conducted in excess of 25 customized instructional clinics and camps for junior high and high school athletes and coaches. Two years later, Yerty founded and coached the New Balance Volleyball Club team in Spokane, Wash., for girls 16 and under. She directed that squad from 1993-95, and then served as the head coach for one year of the Club Cactus Juniors Volleyball Club in Tucson, Ariz., for the 18-Elite age group. A seasoned club team coach, Yerty was selected as a representative on the Junior Olympic National Team selection committee, evaluating and selecting players for the elite squad at the Southern California tryout. Yerty has been very active in the community with FCA and has volunteered at several FCA camps for young women. She also served a three-year term on the AVCA Coaches' Committee and chaired the Policy and Procedures Committee with the AVCA.

As a college student-athlete, the former Carrie Couturier (Yerty) was a four-year standout as a middle blocker during her collegiate days at Washington State University. She earned Pac-10 All-Freshman honors following the 1988 season when she set a school record with 69 solo blocks. In 1991, she earned First Team All-Pac-10 honors in her final collegiate season after helping the Cougars to a 23-12 finish and a then school-best fourth-place showing in the Pac-10. As a senior, she led the Pac-10 in hitting percentage (.333) and in service aces (55). She was third in the league in kills with 432 and ranked fourth with an average of 3.8 kills per game. An All-West Regional and Honorable Mention All-America selection, Yerty received an invitation to participate on the U.S. Olympic Developmental Team in San Diego in 1992. Yerty is currently second in school history in career kills (1,548), while holding the school marks in solo blocks (196) and block assists (431). In the Pac-10, Yerty still ranks as the league's sixth all-time blocker with 617 total blocks, while also ranking second in all-time solo blocks (196). Most recently, Yerty was named to the Pac-10 All-Decade Team, as well as the WSU All-Decade Team.

A standout at Sam Barlow High School in Boring, Ore., she was named to the Reebok All-America team and was Oregon's Female Athlete of the Year in 1988. Yerty also played on the Portland Volleyball Club while in high school. Her squad is still the only club outside of California to ever win the Davis Volleyball Festival, which continues to rate as the largest women's athletic event in the world.

A 1992 graduate of Washington State, Yerty earned her degree in secondary education. She then completed her graduate studies to earn her master's degree in sport and leisure commerce from the University of Memphis in December of 2004. Born March 4, 1970, she is married to Lee Yerty, who is the Director of Operations for the Cowgirls. The couple has three sons, WesLee, Jace and Cade.

Jill Stucky

Associate Volleyball Coach, Wyoming, 1996

Jill (Jones) Stucky begins her fourth season at the University of Wyoming and her first as an associate head coach. Stucky came from the University of Kansas in Lawrence where she spent ten seasons as an assistant coach. Among her many duties, she was the main recruiting coordinator, travel coordinator, responsible for opponent scouting and video breakdown, along with being a liaison for the student-athletes with many facets of the athletics department such as team equipment, housing, academic services and the training room. In 2004, she had one of the Top Ten recruiting classes in the country. She was also the Big XII Conference Representative for the Assistant Coaches Committee through the American Volleyball Coaches Association. One of their best seasons was a 22-11 overall record and a third place finish in the Big XII in 2003. They also made three NCAA Appearances.

Prior to that, she spent one season as an assistant coach at Barton County Community College in Great Bend, Kan., under current Kansas head coach Ray Bechard. During that year, she helped the Cougars to a 59-3 record and a Final Four appearance at the NJCAA Tournament. Her duties included assisting with practice, strength and conditioning, along with day to day operations. While at BCCC, she also served as an athletics academic advisor on top of her coaching duties. As an athletics academic advisor, she oversaw the academic advisement for baseball, men's and women's track and volleyball.

Her playing career began at the University of Wyoming where she was a three-year letterwinner for the Cowgirls. She was a team captain as a junior. In 1994, she helped the Cowgirls to a 17-13 record and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament. As a senior, she led the team in service aces, digs and kills, and still ranks among the Top 15 in each of those categories in school history. An excellent student, she earned Western Athletic Conference Scholar Athlete honors in addition to being named to the School of Education's Dean's List. Stucky received a bachelor of arts and sciences degree in English from Wyoming in 1996 and continued her education by earning a master's degree in sports administration from Kansas in 2002.

She has also been involved in several volleyball camps throughout the region. She has worked camps at Wichita State, Wyoming, Colorado State and Barton County Community College in addition to the University of Kansas camps and satellite clinics.

Her coaching experience also reaches beyond the collegiate ranks, as she previously served as the head coach of the USAV Sport-2-Sport 17-and-Under Elite Team in Lawrence, Kan., and the 18-and-Under Elite Volleytech Sports Club team in Great Bend, Kan. She was also the head coach of the Snowy Range 18-and-Under Volleyball Club team in Laramie, Wyo. in 1997.

Vilis Ozols

Assistant Volleyball Coach, University of Guelph (Canada), 1985, MBA, UC-Denver, 1992

Ozols joins the Cowgirl Volleyball program for his first season in 2011. He came to Wyoming from the University of Colorado where he spent last season as an Assistant Coach with the Buffs. He has an extensive background in the sport of volleyball.

Prior to CU, he coached Denver's Mullen High School from 2007-2010. He led them to top-ten state finishes in those four years (second, third, seventh and ninth-place finishes) and the first Centennial League Conference Championship in the school's 66-year history. The team also won the District and Regional Championships three times. Several of his former players moved onto collegiate volleyball careers. Previous to that, he coached several club and All-Star teams, which helped him earn a Canadian National Championship.

Ozols played collegiate volleyball at the University of Guelph in Canada and was a four-time First Team All-Conference selection, a three-time conference player of the year and was inducted into the UG's Athletic Hall of Fame. He is also a former Canadian Jr. National Volleyball Team member (NORCECA Silver medalist, Jr. World championship qualifier), a First Team All-Canadian selection and a former competitor on the AVP Pro Beach Volleyball Tour.

He has an MBA from the UC-Denver and is the founder and president of the Ozols Business Group. He is an international business speaker who has presented to audiences on three continents, in nine countries and in all 50 U.S. states. Ozols has authored three business books, numerous audio and video programs and is a frequent contributor of magazine and trade publication articles.

Ozols and his wife Andra have four children.

Director of Volleyball Operations, Washington State, 1986

Lee Yerty, who is a 25 veteran of Division I Athletics, is set to begin his fourth year at the University of Wyoming. He joined the Cowgirl staff after spending 11 years at the University of Memphis as an assistant strength and conditioning coach. He trained all sports including the Tiger volleyball program, and for two years he was the Director of Strength and Conditioning for eight Olympic Sports, which included men's and women's tennis, women's basketball, volleyball, men's and women's golf, cross country and women's soccer. During his time there, he also worked with men's basketball, baseball, football and track and field.
