THE STORYLINES

- Xavier, 20-10 overall, defeated Fordham 70-59 last night in the semifinals of the 2006 Atlantic 10 Championship as sophomore forward **Josh Duncan** scored a career-high 20 points.
- The Xavier Musketeers, 20-10, have clinched their ninth 20-win season in the last 10 years. With a win, Xavier would earn its ninth postseason tournament berth in the last 10 years, including seven NCAA Tournament berths.
- Xavier is one of only 10 schools in NCAA history to win four games in four days in their conference tournaments. Now XU is trying to do it again and become the first team to turn the trick twice. XU won four games in four days to win the 2004 Atlantic 10 Championship and then went on to the NCAA Tournament "Elite Eight."
- Xavier has won three Atlantic 10 Tournament Championships since joining the A-10 for the 1995-96 season, including two of the last four titles (2002 and 2004). XU also won the A-10 Tournament Championship in 1998. Xavier head coach **Sean Miller** was XU's associate head coach on the championship teams in 2002 and 2004.
- **Sean Miller** is trying to become the first Xavier head coach to win an Atlantic 10 Conference Tournament Championship without a senior starter. XU has won three A-10 titles. XU won six Midwestern Collegiate Conference Tournament titles and only once did XU win the MCC without a senior starter (1986-87 when all-time leading scorer **Byron Larkin** was a junior starter and all-time leading rebounder **Tyrone Hill** was a freshman starter).
- Xavier, 3-0 all-time in Atlantic 10 Championship Game appearances, has compiled a 18-7 (.720) all-time record so far in 11 Atlantic 10 Tournament appearances.
- Sophomore guard **Stanley Burrell**, a member of the 2005-06 Atlantic 10 Conference Second Team, leads the team in scoring at 14.1 ppg. and has scored in double figures in 26 games this season. Burrell is also the team assist leader at 3.2 apg.
- Xavier junior forward **Justin Cage** was named to the Atlantic 10 Conference All-Defensive Team by the coaches for a second straight year. Cage has also increased his offensive numbers lately. In the nine games XU has played since the injury to **Brian Thornton**, Cage has averaged 13.4 ppg. and 6.4 rpg., while shooting 59.1 percent from the field and 84.4 percent from the free-throw line.
- Versatile junior forward **Justin Doellman** leads the team in rebounding (11th in the Atlantic 10 at 6.8 rpg.), blocks (6th in the A-10 at 1.6 bpg.) and steals (7th in the A-10 at 1.6 spg.) and is second on the team in scoring (11.1 ppg.) and assists (2.6 apg.).

BALANCE LEADS TO SUCCESS IN THE 2006 ATLANTIC 10 TOURNAMENT:

Xavier has three players tied for the team lead in scoring at 12.7 ppg. for its three 2006 Atlantic 10 Tournament games: sophomore guard **Stanley Burrell** and junior forwards **Justin Cage** and **Justin Doellman**. A fourth player, sophomore forward **Josh Duncan**, is right behind the three leaders at 12.0 ppg.

XAVIER HAS ENJOYED SOME ATLANTIC 10 TOURNAMENT SUCCESS:

Xavier has compiled a 18-7 (.720) record in 11 Atlantic 10 Tournament appearances. Xavier has won three Atlantic 10 Tournament Championships since joining the A-10 for the 1995-96 season, including two of the last four titles (2002 and 2004). XU also won the A-10 Tournament Championship in 1998. XU head coach **Sean Miller** was XU's associate head coach on the championship teams in 2002 and 2004. XU is 4-0 all-time in first round games, is 7-4 in quarterfinal action, 4-3 in semifinals and 3-0 in championship games.

HOPING TO FIND THAT FOUR-DAY MAGIC AGAIN:

Xavier became the first team in Atlantic 10 history to win four games in four days at the 2004 A-10 Championship at the University of Dayton Arena. Seeded fourth in the A-10 West, the Musketeers beat St. Bonaventure (90-64), top-ranked Saint Joseph's (87-67), George Washington (70-47) and host Dayton (58-49). Only 10 schools in NCAA history have won four games in four days in their conference tournaments. Siena (2002 Metro Atlantic) and Xavier (2004 Atlantic 10) are the only ones to stake that claim over the last five years. **No team in NCAA history has won the four-game conference tourney sweep in four days more than one time.**

MILLER TRYING MAKE XAVIER COACHING HISTORY:

Xavier has won three Atlantic 10 Conference Tournament Championships and won six Midwestern Collegiate Confer-

ence Tournament Championships. Xavier head coach **Sean Miller** is trying to make Xavier history by becoming the first XU coach to win an Atlantic 10 Conference Tournament Championship without a senior starter. In fact, XU has no seniors among its current top seven players in the rotation. XU had three senior starters on its 2004 championship team, including two players (**Lionel Chalmers** and **Romain Sato**) who were drafted by the NBA and a third (**Anthony Myles**) who was the top pick in the Chinese professional draft. XU won six Midwestern Collegiate Conference Tournament titles and only once did XU win the MCC without a senior starter (1986-87 when all-time leading scorer **Byron Larkin** was a junior starter and all-time leading rebounder **Tyrone Hill** was a freshman starter).

XAVIER-SAINT JOSEPH'S SERIES:

Saint Joseph's leads the series 18-12. The two teams split the regular season meetings with Xavier winning 62-58 on January 4 in Philadelphia and Saint Joseph's winning 68-58 on February 28 in Cincinnati. The recap of this year's two regular season meetings are on page 3.

XAVIER-SAINT JOSEPH'S IN THE A-10 TOURNAMENT:

Strangely enough, this will be the third straight year that Xavier and Saint Joseph's have met in the Atlantic 10 Tournament on March 11. The two teams have met twice before in A-10 Tournament action with Saint Joseph's winning in the 2005 semifinals 73-68 (3-11-05) and XU beating then No. 1 SJU 87-67 in the 2004 quarterfinals (3-11-04).

FOR THE RECORD (SAINT JOSEPH'S):

No. 5 Seed Saint Joseph's, 18-12 overall, won its eighth straight game by beating Temple 73-59 last night in the Atlantic 10 Championship Semifinals.

The Regular Season Meeting in Cincinnati: Saint Joseph's 68, Xavier 58 Tues., Feb. 28, 2006 at Cintas Center

Junior forward **Justin Cage** scored 14 points and snared a game-high seven rebounds but it was not enough. One big key was that Saint Joseph's took care of business from the charity stripe, connecting on 24-of-26 attempts while Xavier was just 10-of-19 from the free throw line. Xavier trailed by 10 points, 31-21, with under six minutes left in the first half but closed the half on a 7-0 run that cut the deficit to 31-28 at intermission. XU scored the first basket of the second half to extend the run to 9-0 and cut the lead to 31-30 but got no closer than a point the rest of the game. The Musketeers trailed by only four points, 45-41, at 9:45 of the second half after senior center **Will Caudle** made a free throw but a pair of Saint Joe's three-pointers put Saint Joe's back up by 10 points with 8:53 to go. Xavier would cut the lead to five points with under one minute remaining but the Hawks put the Musketeers away from the free throw line. Junior forward **Justin Doellman** joined Cage in double-figures with 12 points on 3-of-5 shooting from the field despite fouling out with over six minutes left in the game. Cage's 14 points came on 5-of-7 shooting. Xavier's leading scorer, sophomore guard **Stanley Burrell**, scored only five points for XU but did tie a career high with a game-high six assists. Caudle added nine points and was 4-of-5 from the field on senior night. Xavier held an 18-to-12 edge in points in the paint but the Hawks took advantage of 13 Musketeer turnovers, converting the miscues into 19 points.

The Regular Season Meeting in Philadelphia: Xavier 62, Saint Joseph's 58 Wed., Jan. 4, 2006 at Alumni Memorial Fieldhouse

Xavier used stingy defense and a big offensive second half to erase a seven-point halftime deficit and open the Atlantic 10 season with a road win. Saint Joseph's led by as many as 10 points in the first half and 29-22 at halftime thanks in great part to Xavier hitting just 4-of-13 from the free throw line in the first half. St. Joe's led 38-29 with 14 minutes left but XU ratcheted up the defense and went on a 12-0 run to grab the lead at 41-38 with 10:15 left. Saint Joseph's answered with a 7-0 run of its own, holding XU scoreless for almost four minutes, to grab the lead back at 45-41 with 6:32 left. A pair of free throws by senior forward **Will Caudle** capped a 6-0 XU run that gave the Musketeers the lead back at 47-45 with 4:07 left. The teams traded leads a couple times over the next 1:30 and the home team led 50-49 thanks to an offensive rebound and tip-in at 2:46. Xavier took the lead back for good with a 6-0 run over the next 1:30 capped off by a jumper by sophomore guard **Stanley Burrell** that gave XU a 55-50 lead with just 1:16 left. Burrell scored 13 of his team-high 17 points in the second half. Senior forward **Brian Thornton** also came up big in the second half. Thornton scored 10 of his 13 points and grabbed six of his team-high 11 rebounds in the second half. Junior forwards **Justin Cage** and **Justin Doellman** both contributed 10 points. XU held Saint Joseph's, which came into the game as the A-10's top three-point shooting team at 41.5 percent, to just 27.8 percent (5-of-18) from behind the arc.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE? Despite being located in Cincinnati, Xavier has only played seven games at U.S. Bank Arena (previously Riverfront Coliseum) since joining the Atlantic 10 Conference and five of the seven have been in A-10 Tournament play the last two seasons, posting a 1-1 record in last year's tournament and a 3-0 record so far this year. *Xavier's only two non-Atlantic 10 Tournament games here since the 1995-96 season were regular season losses to Purdue (1998-99) and Tulane (1996-97).* Xavier hosted Midwestern Collegiate Conference (previously Midwestern City Conference and now Horizon League) Tournament action at U.S. Bank Arena in 1981 and 1992. XU was 1-1 in the 1981 event and 0-1 in 1992.

FOR THE RECORD (XAVIER): No. 10 Seed Xavier, 20-10 overall, defeated No. 6 Seed Fordham 70-59 last night in the Atlantic 10 Championship Semifinals. XU defeated No. 2 Seed Charlotte 59-55 in the quarterfinals and No. 7 Seed Massachusetts 75-66 in the opening round. The game recaps and box scores for these three games (games 28, 29 and 30) are on pages 7-8.

ANOTHER 20-WIN SEASON...LOOKING FOR ANOTHER POSTSEASON APPEARANCE: Xavier, 20-10, has secured its ninth 20-win season in the last 10 years. With a win in the championship game, Xavier would earn its ninth postseason tournament berth in the last 10 years, including seven NCAA Tournament berths.

XAVIER'S HEAD COACH: Sean Miller (Pittsburgh '92), 37, is 37-22 in his second season. Xavier finished 17-12 in Miller's first season. Miller is the 16th men's basketball head coach in Xavier history. Miller, Xavier's first-ever associate head coach for three seasons under Thad Matta, also spent time as an assistant at Wisconsin (one season: 1992-93), Miami (Ohio) (two seasons: 1993-95), Pittsburgh (one season: 1995-96) and NC State (five seasons: 1996-2001). Miller has coached in 10 postseason tournaments in 13 years as a college coach. Miller was a standout point guard at Pittsburgh, helping Pitt compile an 80-48 record, a Big East title, three NCAA Tournaments and one NIT berth.

SEAN MILLER NAMED TO THE UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH'S ALL-CENTENNIAL TEAM: The University of Pittsburgh Panthers, who are celebrating their 100th year of basketball, have named five-member first, second and third teams to honor the best players in Pitt hoops history. Miller was named to the All-Centennial Second Team.

ATLANTIC 10 CONFERENCE HONORED THREE MUSKETEERS: Senior forward **Brian Thornton**, who is out for the season with an injury, was voted by the Atlantic 10 coaches to the Atlantic 10 Conference First Team, while sophomore guard **Stanley Burrell** was voted onto the Atlantic 10 Second Team. The coaches voted junior forward **Justin Cage** to the A-10 All-Defensive Team for the second straight year. The A-10 sports information directors voted Thornton as the A-10 Men's Basketball Student-Athlete of the Year for the second straight year and voted him to the A-10 All-Academic Team for the second straight year.

IT MUST BE THE SOCKS...You've seen the players with names, initials or jersey numbers to honor someone. Some of the Xavier players have done something a little different. They have honored senior forward **Brian Thornton** by wearing high socks, which had become a trademark style of Thornton. Thornton suffered a season-ending injury in the first half of the LaSalle game on Saturday, February 11. Thornton was the team's leading scorer (15.3 ppg.), leading

rebounder (6.8 rpg.), top field goal shooter (top five in the nation at 64.0 percent) and blocks leader (2.1 bpg.).

XAVIER IS AN ATLANTIC 10 LEADER...TOP THREE IN NINE MAJOR CATEGORIES: Xavier is among the Atlantic 10's top teams in: field goal percentage defense (first at .394), three-point field goal percentage defense (second at .312), assists (second at 15.83 apg.), scoring offense (second at 71.8 ppg.), scoring margin (second at +8.8 ppg.), field goal percentage (second at .462), blocked shots (second at 4.83 bpg.), assist/turnover ratio (second at 1.23-to-1.00) and free throw percentage (third at .726).

TAKING ADVANTAGE OF THE FREE STUFF: Xavier is ranked third in the Atlantic 10 at 72.6 percent. Sophomore forward **Josh Duncan** has hit 87.5 percent (63-of-72) of his free throw attempts. Junior forward **Justin Doellman** is ranked 11th in the Atlantic 10 at 76.6 percent (82-of-107), while junior forward **Justin Cage** is 12th in the A-10 at 73.6 percent (95-of-129).

DEFENSE EARNING ATTENTION: Xavier has held its opponents to 39.4 percent shooting from the field (22nd in the nation in the latest NCAA Division I stats and first in the Atlantic 10), including 31.2 percent from three-point territory (second in the Atlantic 10). *Last season XU opponents shot 43.3 percent from the field, including 37.6 percent from three-point territory.*

RECORD-SETTING EFFORT: The Musketeers turned in the best defensive effort on record at XU by holding Eastern Illinois to 18.4 percent (9-for-49) shooting from the field in the season opening win. The 35 points scored by EIU mark the lowest by an XU opponent since the introduction of the shot clock and the lowest overall since the 1981-82 season.

XAVIER MAKES ITS DEFENSIVE MARK: Xavier has held opponents to 39.4 percent shooting from the field (lowest since opponents shot 38.5 percent in the 1961-62 season). *The XU school record is 36.1 percent (1952-53 season).* Xavier has held its opponents to 63.0 ppg. *It marks XU's second-best scoring defensive mark since holding opponents to 62.3 ppg. in the 1950-51 season.* XU allowed 62.6 ppg. in 2001-02.

UNSELFISH OFFENSE EARNS NATIONAL RANKINGS: Xavier, which dished off a season-high 30 assists against St. Bonaventure (fourth-highest total in school history), is second in the A-10 and 34th in the nation at 15.83 assists per game.

BURRELL A DUAL THREAT...THE TEAM'S TOP SCORER AND ASSIST MAN: 2005-06 Second Team Team All-Atlantic 10 Conference selection **Stanley Burrell**, a sophomore guard, is Xavier's top scorer, which is a familiar role for Burrell. Burrell is first on the team in scoring at 14.1 ppg. Burrell has eight 20-point games this season, including his team-high 22 points to go with a team-high five assists on Wednesday versus UMass, 20 points at URI, 21 points against Fordham and Duquesne, 25 points at Temple, 20 against Cincinnati, 22 at Miami (Ohio) and 20 at Charlotte. **Burrell has scored in double figures 26 times this season, including a streak of 17 straight games in double figures at one point.** In addition to his scoring, Burrell is leading the team in assists at 3.2 per game. *Burrell led Xavier in scoring for the season as a freshman at 12.7 ppg., one of only three Xavier freshmen in history to accomplish that feat.*

When is the last time an XU player led the team in both scoring and assists? **Maurice McAfee** at 15.1 ppg. and 4.2 apg. in the 1999-2000 season.

BURRELL LOOKING DEEP: Sophomore guard **Stanley Burrell** is ranked ninth in the Atlantic 10 in three-point field goal percentage at 39.0 percent (62-of-159) and 10th in treys per game (2.07 per game). *Burrell hit 36.7 percent (61-of-166) as a freshman.* Burrell hit a career-high six three-pointers on a career-high 12 attempts at Temple.

TOURNEY TOUGH: Sophomore guard **Stanley Burrell** has averaged 13.8 ppg. in five career Atlantic 10 Conference Tournament games, including a team-high 22 points in the first round win over UMass and 10 points in the quarterfinal win over Charlotte. Last year Burrell made the 2005 Atlantic 10 All-Championship Team, becoming the first XU freshman ever to earn that A-10 honor.

JUST IN TIME: Xavier junior forwards **Justin Doellman** and **Justin Cage** have helped fill some of the void left by the loss of **Brian Thornton**. In the nine games without Thornton, Doellman has averaged 13.3 ppg. and 6.8 rpg., while Cage has averaged 13.4 ppg. and 6.4 rpg. Doellman and Cage, who have started 87 and 77 straight games respectively, were both starters as freshmen during XU's 2004 Atlantic 10 Tournament Championship and NCAA Tournament "Elite Eight" runs.

DOELLMAN IS A VERSATILE CONTRIBUTOR WHO HASN'T LET AN INJURED HAND SLOW HIM DOWN: Junior forward **Justin Doellman** has been playing with a heavily wrapped shooting hand since breaking two bones in that hand prior to the game at Dayton on February 21. Despite that fact, Doellman leads the team in rebounding (6.8 rpg., including a career-high tying 13 versus Cincinnati), blocks (1.6 bpg., including a career-high tying five versus Cincinnati) and steals (1.6 spg.) and is second on the team in scoring at 11.1 ppg. and assists at 2.6 apg. Doellman recorded his sixth career "double-double" with 19 points (7-of-9 shooting from the field) and 12 rebounds to go with five assists at Rhode Island. He had 15 points and 10 rebounds to go with five assists in the win over Fordham and scored 20 points in the win over Duquesne on 7-of-11 shooting from the field. He had 17 points, nine rebounds, six assists and three steals against George Washington. Doellman contributed 15 points and six rebounds to the regular season win at Charlotte.

DOELLMAN IS A LEADER ON DEFENSE: Junior forward **Justin Doellman** leads the team in steals at 1.6 spg. (seventh in the Atlantic 10) and in blocks at 1.6 bpg. (sixth in the A-10) in addition to being 11th in the A-10 in rebounding (6.8 rpg.), including fifth in defensive rebounding (4.93 per game). Doellman, who blocked a career-high five shots against Cincinnati and at Miami (Ohio), swiped a career-high six steals in the Eastern Illinois win.

DOELLMAN A LEADER ON THE BOARDS AGAIN... AMONG SELECT COMPANY IN XU HISTORY: Junior forward **Justin Doellman** is leading the team in rebounding at 6.8 rpg., including his game-high and career-high tying 13 rebounds against Cincinnati, his 12-rebound game at URI and his 10 rebound games against Fordham, Miami (Ohio) and Troy. He grabbed a team-high nine rebounds against George Washington. *Doellman led XU in rebounding as a sophomore at 6.0 rpg. Did you know that the last four players to lead XU in rebounding in consecutive seasons all went*

on to successful NBA careers? 2003 graduate **David West** (four straight years), 1999 graduate **James Posey** (three straight years), 1994 graduate **Brian Grant** (four straight years) and 1990 graduate **Tyrone Hill** (four straight years).

CAGE ON OFFENSE: Junior forward **Justin Cage** has scored in double figures 16 times this season, including each of the last six games. Cage scored 13 points in last night's semifinal win over Fordham and Thursday's quarterfinal win over Charlotte. Cage had a career-high tying 19 points on 7-of-8 shooting from the field to go with a career-high tying 11 rebounds in the regular season meeting versus Fordham. **Cage has averaged 13.0 ppg. and 6.3 rpg. over Xavier's last 10 games while shooting 58.6 percent from the field.** Cage had 15 points on 6-of-7 shooting from the field against Miami (Ohio). He had a team-high 15 points to go with four rebounds and three assists to go with two blocks and two steals against Illinois. For the season he is averaging 10.0 ppg. and 5.5 rpg.

CAGE IS A DEFENSIVE STANDOUT...AND THE ATLANTIC 10 COACHES HAVE NOTICED: Junior forward **Justin Cage** is the leader of the Musketeer defensive efforts. It has not gone unnoticed. Cage was voted by the A-10 coaches as a member of the Atlantic 10 All-Defensive Team for the second straight year.

DUNCAN MAKING HIS MARK AS A STARTER: Sophomore forward **Josh Duncan** is averaging 11.2 points, 5.2 rebounds and 2.1 assists in 10 games as a starter. Duncan made his 10th collegiate start (ninth straight) last night, scoring a career-high 20 points to go with seven rebounds. Duncan scored 18 points to go with seven rebounds in a career-high 33 minutes of action at Dayton. He made his first collegiate start versus George Washington on February 2, contributing 10 points, a career-high eight rebounds and four assists.

DUNCAN IS DOUBLY TOUGH AGAINST A-10 TEAMS: Sophomore **Josh Duncan** has recorded 12 of his 16 double-figure scoring games this season against Atlantic 10 Conference teams, including 20 points last night versus Fordham and 10 points on Wednesday against UMass. Duncan had 15 points (including 3-of-5 three-pointers), five rebounds and a career-high five assists in 26 minutes at Temple. Duncan had 18 at Dayton.

FRESH HELP: Two Xavier freshmen, guard **Johnny Wolf** and guard/forward **B.J. Raymond**, have been key contributors on this year's squad. Wolf has averaged 15.4 minutes, including 30.7 per game over the last six games, and Raymond has averaged 11.3 minutes a game, including 21.0 minutes a game over the last six games.

EVERYBODY LOVES RAYMOND...EVEN HE'S IN STITCHES: Freshman guard/forward **B.J. Raymond** suffered a laceration on his forehead in the first half of the game at UMass that required eight stitches. Raymond has given XU a lift off the bench in Xavier's last nine games, averaging 6.7 points and 3.1 rebounds in 21.1 minutes per game. He shot 45.2 percent (19-of-42) from the field for those nine games, including 43.5 percent (10-of-23) from three-point territory. Raymond averaged just 6.9 minutes per game through Xavier's first 21 games.

BACK-TO-BACK CAREER EFFORTS FROM RAYMOND:

Freshman guard/forward **B.J. Raymond** posted career highs for points (12) and rebounds (five) and tied a career high for blocks (two) in 21 minutes versus Fordham on February 15. Raymond topped that in the win over Duquesne on February 18 with a new career high for points (16), three rebounds and a career-high tying two blocks in 24 minutes of action. Raymond hit three-pointers on three straight XU possessions over a 1:02 stretch in the second half against Duquesne.

SOLID RATIO FOR WOLF: Freshman point guard **Johnny Wolf** has 57 assists (1.9 apg.) and 21 turnovers this season through 30 games. That translates into an impressive 2.71-to-1.00 assist-to-turnover ratio.

STARTING SOMETHING WITH WOLF: Freshman guard **Johnny Wolf** has started the last six games following the dismissal of senior point guard Dedrick Finn. Wolf has averaged 8.2 points, 3.2 rebounds and 2.5 assists in 30.7 minutes per game as a starter. He scored a career-high tying 10 points in the first round win over UMass, while hitting a career-high three three-pointers for nine points in the quarterfinal win over Charlotte. He had 10 points in the regular season finale at UMass. He also scored a career-high 10 points at Rhode Island on February 25 in his first career collegiate start. Wolf has scored 10 points four times this season, including three of the last six games.

COLE RESERVE: Junior forward **Brandon Cole** suffered a season-ending knee injury in the second game of last season. Cole, a key part of Xavier's 2004 NCAA Tournament "Elite Eight" run, has been working himself back at a steady pace. Cole has logged 6.8 minutes per game in 18 appearances so far this season, including four points, seven rebounds and two steals in a career-high 20 minutes in the first round win over UMass and four points, seven rebounds and two assists in 16 minutes in the win over Charlotte last night. Cole has a solid stat line of 3.3 points and 5.7 rebounds per game in just 15.7 minutes per game during this year's A-10 Tournament.

CAUDLE CONTRIBUTING: Senior forward/center **Will Caudle**, who has averaged 4.8 points and 1.8 rebounds in 10.3 minutes a game so far this season, hit 4-of-6 from the field en route to nine points to go with six rebounds in 13 minutes at Saint Louis. Caudle had 10 points on 4-of-6 shooting to go with five rebounds against Illinois.

STARTING SOMETHING: While freshman guard **Johnny Wolf** made his first collegiate starts in the last six games, junior forward **Justin Doellman** has started 87 straight games, junior forward **Justin Cage** has started 77 straight and sophomore guard **Stanley Burrell** has started 53 of the last 54 games. Sophomore forward **Josh Duncan** took over Brian Thornton's spot in the starting lineup and has started the last nine games and 10 overall this season.

AWAY FROM HOME: Xavier, 9-6 away from home this season (5-5 on opponent courts and 4-1 at "neutral" sites), won at Rhode Island, at Richmond, at Charlotte, at Saint Joseph's, at Miami (Ohio), over Purdue at a "neutral site" (Conseco Fieldhouse) in Indianapolis and over UMass, Fordham and Charlotte in the 2006 A-10 Tournament at U.S. Bank Arena. XU lost at Creighton and to then No. 12 Illinois at a

"neutral site" (United Center) in Chicago in front of 20,000 Illini fans on December 3 in non-conference play and at Temple, UMass, Dayton and St. Louis in A-10 action. *Xavier was 5-8 in games away from Cintas Center last season (3-7 away and 2-1 neutral). XU, 3-5 in A-10 road games last season, was 4-4 in 2006 A-10 road games.*

HOME SWEET HOME: Xavier is 76-14 (.844) at Cintas Center over six seasons, including 11-4 this season. Xavier is 38-10 (.792) against Atlantic 10 teams and 38-4 (.905) against non-conference teams.

DRAWING A CROWD: Xavier has sold out 58 home games in six seasons at Cintas Center, including four this season. **XU has averaged 10,025 fans per game for its 90 games at the 10,250-seat facility.**

BROWN TO REDSHIRT: Head coach **Sean Miller** announced that freshman forward **Derrick Brown** will redshirt this season. Brown, a 6-7 and 210-pound forward from Dayton (OH) Chaminade-Julienne High School.

TRANSFER POINT GUARD WILL HAVE TWO YEARS AT XU: Former Oklahoma Sooners starting point guard **Drew Lavender**, who transferred to XU and has been practicing with XU since October, will be eligible for games next season. The 5-7 and 153-pound Lavender, a former McDonald's All-American prep star at Columbus (OH) Brookhaven High School, played in 63 games over the past two seasons.

THREE RECRUITS FOR 2006-07: **Sean Miller** has signed three players, including **Adrion Graves**, a 6-4 and 185-pound guard from Cincinnati's Hughes High School, a 2005-06 High Honorable Mention All-American by *Street & Smith's* and a 2005 First Team Boys Division I All-Star selection by *The Cincinnati Enquirer*. The second signee is 6-9 and 260-pound forward **Jason Love** from Philadelphia and Abington Friends School, who was named 2004-05 First Team All-Friends League, 2004-05 Second Team All-Montgomery County and a Honorable Mention All-American in the 2005-06 *Street & Smith's* preseason basketball magazine. The third signee is 6-10 and 225-pound center **Charles Bronson** from Panola College in Carthage, Texas. Bronson will have three years of eligibility remaining, beginning with the 2006-07 season.

THORNTON IS XAVIER'S FIRST-EVER ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN IN MEN'S BASKETBALL: Senior forward **Brian Thornton** has been named as an *ESPN The Magazine* CoSIDA Second Team Academic All-American, the first-ever Xavier men's basketball student-athlete to earn Academic All-American honors. He had previously been voted as a First Team Academic All-District 4 selection. Thornton graduated in 2005 from Xavier University with a 3.60 GPA and a bachelor's degree in liberal arts with a business emphasis. He currently holds a 3.30 GPA as a Xavier M.B.A. student. On the court Thornton led XU in scoring, rebounding, field goal percentage and blocks before suffering a season-ending injury on Saturday, February 11.

THE ATLANTIC 10 CONFERENCE HONORED THORNTON: Senior forward **Brian Thornton** was voted by the Atlantic 10 coaches to the Atlantic 10 Conference First Team. The A-10 sports information directors voted Thornton as the A-10 Men's Basketball Student-Athlete of the Year for the second straight year and voted him to the A-10 All-Academic Team for the second straight year.

THORNTON EARNED ATLANTIC 10 PLAYER OF THE WEEK FOR THREE STRAIGHT WEEKS EARLIER THIS YEAR...JOINED SELECT COMPANY: Senior forward **Brian Thornton** was named Atlantic 10 Conference Player of the Week for a third straight week after hitting 7-of-9 from the field en route to 20 points and 12 rebounds in the win over Cincinnati on January 19. Thornton is one of only four players in the 30-year history of the Atlantic 10 to win the award three weeks in a row. Three-time Atlantic 10 Player of the Year and 2003 National Player of the Year **David West** of Xavier won the award four straight weeks at one point in his senior year. The 2004 Atlantic 10 and National Player of the Year **Jameer Nelson** of Saint Joseph's won the award the first three weeks of his senior season. The 1987 Atlantic 10 Player of the Year **Nate Blackwell** of Temple won the award the first three weeks of his senior season. **Thornton earned the honor five times in his XU career, including four times this season and once last year.**

DISTRICT HONORS FOR THORNTON: Senior forward **Brian Thornton** has been named to the 2005-06 NABC (National Association of Basketball Coaches) All-District 10 First Team along with Eric Hicks (Cincinnati), Chris Quinn (Notre Dame), Marco Killingsworth (Indiana) and Terence Dials (Ohio State).

THORNTON WAS A FORCE INSIDE: Senior forward **Brian Thornton** led the team in scoring (15.3 ppg.), rebounding (6.8 rpg., including a career-high tying 12 versus Dayton), field goal percentage (first in the A-10 and top ten in the nation at 64.0 percent), and blocked shots (2.1 bpg., including a career-high five in the win over Dayton). Thornton scored a career-high 27 points on a career-high 11 field goals out of a career-high 13 attempts in the win over Troy on December 22. **Thornton had 10 "double-doubles" in his Xavier career, including five games this season and five games last year.**

THORNTON PASSED 1,000 CAREER POINTS: Senior forward **Brian Thornton** finished his collegiate career with 1,175 points, including 611 for his Xavier career and 564 in two years at Vanderbilt.

THORNTON BROKE A SCHOOL RECORD HELD BY ANOTHER BRIAN: Senior forward **Brian Thornton** shot a school record 61.9 percent (216-of-349) for his Xavier career. That broke the career record previously held by current Phoenix Sun **Brian Grant**, who shot 59.4 percent (656-of-1104) for his four-year career. Grant still holds the record for XU players that have played three or four years for the Musketeers.

FINN WAS DISMISSED FROM THE TEAM: Xavier head coach **Sean Miller** announced that senior guard **Dedrick Finn** has been dismissed from the basketball team. "Today (February 22) it was brought to my attention that Dedrick Finn has violated one of our program's cornerstone policies," said Miller. "Throughout his career we have tried to connect with Dedrick to continue to develop him as a person and have pursued numerous channels to see this through. Dedrick has been made well aware of the importance of following rules and guidelines that all team members must abide by. The fact that he is at the end of his senior year makes his recent actions even more disturbing. Dedrick is on track to graduate in May and we will support his efforts in doing so wholeheartedly. Our current basketball team will move forward with the important and complete understanding that no one player is more important than our program." Finn played in 122 career games, scoring 912 points and dishing off 481 assists. Finn made his 102nd career start at Dayton on February 21, including his 53rd consecutive start. He was averaging 5.0 points and 4.0 assists this season.

Sophomore forward **Josh Duncan** scored a career-high 20 points on 6-of-9 shooting from the field and grabbed seven rebounds to lead three XU players in double figures in scoring. Fordham and Xavier opened the game by exchanging a pair of baskets before the Musketeers went on an 11-2 run over a span of 4:22 to take its largest lead of the half at 15-6 with 12:53 to go in the first stanza. Fordham came all the way back and held a one-point, 27-26, lead with 3:51 left in the first half. The Musketeers outscored the Rams 11-6 over the final four minutes of the half to take a 37-33 halftime lead. After Xavier opened the second half with a basket on the first offensive possession, Fordham scored the next six points and tied the game up at 39-all at the 17:46 mark. The Musketeers regained the lead for good at 42-39 with 17:29 left off of an old-fashioned three-point play from junior forward **Justin Cage**. With Xavier holding a 54-49 lead with 5:48 to go in the game, Duncan corralled a loose ball and drove to the lane where he converted on a jumper to put the Musketeers up by seven points at 56-49. Duncan's made jumper started a 13-5 run over the next 4:36, which gave XU its largest lead of the game at 67-54. Cage added 13 points on 5-of-8 from the floor while also hauling in five rebounds. Junior forward **Justin Doellman** chipped in 12 points and recorded four assists on the night. XU committed a season-low seven turnovers in the win, tying XU's lowest total since having just three in the 2004 A-10 Championship Game against Dayton.
