### **Kevin McCloskey: Asst Coach/Camp Director**

Kevin began his first season as an assistant men's soccer coach in June 2007. McCloskey spent the 2006 season as an assistant coach at Northern Kentucky University. While at NKU, the team made an appearance in the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament and finished the year ranked seventh in the country.

Prior to his stint at Northern Kentucky, McCloskey served as an assistant coach and head junior varsity coach at Urbana University. In 2003-04 he was assistant coach at the University of Rio Grande, when they were crowned Conference Champions, NAIA Region IX Champions and the NAIA Division I National Champions.

McCloskey also spent four years at Rio Grande as a player. He led the squad to three AMC Conference Championships, two NAIA Region IX Championships and two appearances in the NAIA National Tournament. McCloskey also earned several individual awards as the midfielder was named First Team All-Conference, First Team All-Region and earned mention as an NAIA All-American.

McCloskey was a member of the Northern Ireland Football Association U16 and U18 National Team in Belfast, Ireland from 1996-98.

A member of the Ohio South Soccer Association since 2002, McCloskey played professionally with the Cincinnati Kings from 2004-07 and has been a member of the Ohio South Soccer Association Camp Staff since 2002.

### **Mike Popejoy: XU Asst Coach/Goalkeepers**

Mike joined the staff in January 2005 and helped out in all aspects in preparation for and during the spring season.

Popejoy holds a United States Soccer Federation National "B" Coaching License and earned his master's degree in education from Marygrove College in 2002. He also received bachelor's degrees in physical education and health education from the College of Mount St. Joseph in 1995.

Schureck, the fifth head coach in the 30-year history of the Xavier men's soccer program, compiled a 76-63-16 overall record in eight seasons as a head coach, including a 46-25-9 mark in Atlantic 10 competition.

In seven years as Head Coach, Coach Schureck is a proven winner and developer of talent. In his second season at Xavier he has taken them to the A-10 tournament for the first time in nine years. As a player, Coach Schureck was a four year starter and three year captain at his goalkeeper position at Xavier University.

He translated his playing success to coaching and under his guidance, Coach Schureck's players have been getting noticed: 2 NSCAA All-Americans, 14 All-Region, 17 All-Ohio, 23 All A-10 Conference, including the 2000 A-10 Player of the year and the 2003 Ohio Player of the Year. He has had 10 players continue their careers professionally with 2 being part of the US Soccer National team.

In 2000, Coach Schureck was named the Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year while winning the A-10 regular season crown. In 2003, Coach Schureck's team received their highest ranking in school history by reaching #8 in the NSCAA coaches' poll.

Coach Schureck is active in youth soccer as a member of the Ohio South State staff and Region II ODP staff. He has experience as a director of coaching for youth clubs and is a former scout for talented youth with US Soccer.
