### McGuff Eclipses All-Time Wins Mark

Head coach Kevin McGuff became XU's all-time winningest coach when his team defeated Kentucky by a 67-44 count on December 2. **McGuff's record at Xavier now stands at 157-66 and his .704 winning percentage is the highest in XU history.** Melanie Balcomb, the current head coach at Vanderbilt and previous record holder at XU, eclipsed Mark Ehlen's all-time mark in her first try as did McGuff. **It took Balcomb 212 games to reach 135 wins ... McGuff won his 135th game in his 196th game.** McGuff is the first coach to lead XU to the postseason in each of their first seven seasons.

### McGuff Moves Up A-10 Charts

Head coach Kevin McGuff is bolting up a couple of lists after leading XU to a 13-1 conference record last season. **McGuff is in eighth place on the all-time Atlantic 10 winning percentage list (regular season games only).** McGuff has a record of **78-29 in A-10 regular season games since the 2002-03 season for a winning percentage of .729, which is the best among active coaches.** McGuff now sits in **ninth** place, in just his seventh season, on the A-10 wins list (regular season games only) with **78.**

### Xavier Ranked No. 9/14

Xavier comes into today's game ranked **No. 9** by the Associated Press and **No. 14** in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll. The Musketeers have now been ranked for **33** weeks in their history. Xavier is **45-9** all-time as a ranked team and the No. 9 ranking by the AP is its highest ranking in that poll ever. XU reached as high as No. 9 in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll in 2000-01.

### XU vs. Ranked Teams

Xavier stands at **9-21** all-time vs. teams ranked in the Associated Press Poll, including **1-0** this season. Xavier was 3-1 during the 2007-08 season as the team downed No. 24 NC State by a 51-49 score on December 12, No. 7 Georgia by a 65-55 count on January 6 and No. 13 George Washington on March 9. Georgia was the highest-ranked team XU had ever beaten at home and the Lady Dogs were the highest-ranked opponent XU had beaten since the team downed No. 3 Tennessee in the 2001 NCAA Mideast Regional semifinal. **2007-08 marked the first year XU had beaten three ranked teams in a season since 1999-00.**

### Xavier Wins Season Opener

XU improved to 26-13 all-time in season openers after its victory over USC. The Musketeers are now 11-8 in season openers on the road and is 15-4 in its last 19 season openers.

### XU Wins Home Openers

The Musketeers are 30-9 all-time in home openers. The Musketeers have had much more success in home openers of late, **winning 18 consecutive home openers** dating back to a 99-68 victory over West Virginia on December 8, 1992. **XU's last loss in a home opener came on 12/3/91; an 83-81 setback to Ohio.** XU No. 14/7 Arizona State 59-46 in the 2009-10 home opener.

### The Series vs. MSVSU

Xavier and Mississippi Valley State have never met. XU is 0-1 all-time vs. teams currently playing in the SWAC.

### Phillips Earns National Recognition

Several preseason prognosticators have recognized Ta'Shia Phillips as one of the best players in the country. Phillips, the reigning Atlantic 10 Player of the Year, has been honored as a Preseason First Team selection by *The Sporting News* and she has also earned a spot on the Wade Trophy, Naismith Award and Wooden Award Preseason Watch List. Over the summer, the Indianapolis native helped Team USA win gold at the 2009 World University Games in Belgrade, Serbia.

### On the Rebound

The Musketeers have been one of the top rebounding clubs in the Atlantic 10 since Kevin McGuff's arrival prior to the 2002-03 season. XU has never finished worse than fourth in rebounding margin since the 2002-03 season and led the league in rebounding margin during the 2003-04 (+5.2), 2004-05 (+4.1), 2007-08 (+8.6) and 2008-09 (+11.2) seasons. **The Musketeers were third in the country in rebounding margin during the 2008-09 season.**

### Avoiding the Big 50

The Musketeers were especially tough for opponents to score on last year as XU held the opposition under 50 points a record **16** time. XU was **first** in the A-10 and **ninth** in the country with a scoring defense of **53.8** points per game. The previous record for holding opponents under 50 points was established during the 2007-08 season when the team turned the trick seven times. **Amazingly, from 1982-2002, XU held its opponents under 50 points only 15 times.** Since Kevin McGuff took over for the 2002-03 season, XU has held opponents below 50 points **44** times.

### Field Goal Pct. Defense = Hat Rack

Since Kevin McGuff became head coach XU has clearly made a point to be a great rebounding team. However, Xavier has also hung its hat on holding the opposition to a low field goal percentage. Since the 2005-06 season, Xavier has held its opponents under 40.0 percent shooting each year. Last season, XU **led the A-10 and the country** with a field goal percentage defense of **33.2**.

### Ta'Shia Reaches 700; Sets New Mark

Junior star Ta'Shia Phillips has accumulated **779** rebounds and she hauled in her 500th against Davidson on December 19. Phillips reached 500 career rebounds in **45 games**, which is faster than any Muskeeteer in team history. Amber Harris was the previous record holder, reaching 500 boards in 56 games. **Additionally, Phillips established a new single-season rebounding record, hauling in 386 boards during the 2008-09 season.** The previous single-season mark was 371, set by none other than Phillips during the 2007-08 campaign.

### Bring on the BCS

Xavier is **35-32** all-time vs. teams from the ACC, BIG EAST, Big Ten, Big 12, SEC and Pac-10. XU broke a school record by playing 10 teams from BCS conferences in 2008-09. XU is **25-20** vs. BCS schools since Kevin McGuff was named head coach prior to the 2002-03 season and finished the 2008-09 season at **6-4** vs. the power conferences. **Xavier will play either nine or 10 BCS teams during the 2009-10 regular season depending on how the Junkanoo Jam plays out.** XU is scheduled to play either Minnesota or TCU in its second game. **XU is 2-0 vs. the BCS this season.**

### New Magic Number

The standard of 80 points had stood as a key to a Xavier victory as the Musketeers won 39 straight when scoring 80 or more from 1999-2002. But since Kevin McGuff has taken over, a new magic number has been established. Xavier has gone **87-4 (.956) in seven seasons under McGuff when scoring at least 70 points.** XU's only losses when scoring 70+ points were an 82-79 overtime loss at Richmond on 1/5/04, a 74-72 loss to No. 22 Maryland on 12/4/04, a 76-72 loss at Charlotte on January 3, 2006 and most recently the 82-71 loss at Florida to open up the 2007-08 campaign.

### On the Rebound

Since the 2002-03 season, Xavier is **122-26 (.824 winning pct.)** when out-rebounding its opponent and is just **30-34 (.469 winning pct.)** when being out-rebounded by its opponent. The Musketeers were **21-3** last season when out-rebounding their opponent. Below is Xavier's year-by-year record when out-rebounding and being out-rebounded.

### Intermission Intuition

Under Kevin McGuff, Xavier is **126-22 (.851) when leading or tied at halftime**, including **20-3** during the 2008-09 season and **2-0** this year. XU is 31-43 (.419) overall when trailing at the break under McGuff.

### 100 and Counting at Cintas

The Musketeers won their 100<sup>th</sup> game at Cintas Center with a 69-52 victory over Penn State on January 30, 2008. XU is **118-28** at Cintas Center since the facility opened up for the 2000-01 season. Below is XU's year-by-year record on its home court.
