

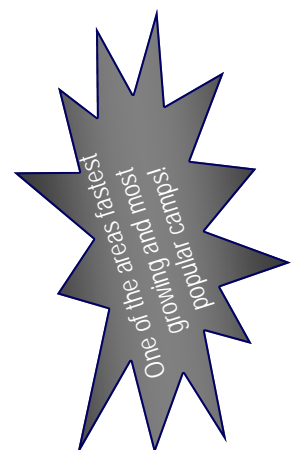

About Coach Alexander...

- Coach Alexander just finished his third season as the Xavier Women's soccer coach and now has an overall record of 20-31-5. The future of the Xavier program looks bright with back-to-back outstanding recruiting classes, including our most recent class (2007) that was regionally ranked.
- Alexander came to Xavier after spending two years as the top assistant at Notre Dame, helping to guide the Fighting Irish to the 2004 NCAA Div I Championship. In his two years on staff at Notre Dame, Alexander helped lead the Irish to a composite 45-4-2 record and back-to-back Big East titles.
- Prior to Notre Dame, Coach Alexander spent 10 years as a highly successful youth club in the Dallas area. He became known for his ability to develop technically superior athletes.



Amber Alexander Camp Director

Amber spent three years on staff at XU and has worked the last two Academy Camps. Prior to our camp she worked camps at Notre Dame and other summer camps across the country. Amber is the daughter of Xavier Head Coach Alvin Alexander.

REFUND POLICY

****PLEASE READ****

A deposit fee of \$200 for residential and \$100 for all other camps will be subtracted from the total fee, **but is non-refundable for any reason and will be applied to the following years' camp tuition.** No refunds will be issued upon expulsion or voluntary withdrawal from camp once camp has begun.

PARENTAL PERMISSION INDEMNIFYING RELEASE

In consideration of the Alvin Alexander Soccer Academy allowing my minor child to play soccer in said camp, I/we, the undersigned parents or legal guardians of _____, a minor, do hereby agree as follows:

1. I/we grant permission for said minor child to participate in any and all of said camp activities.
2. I/we grant to said camp, the camp director any and all of its coaches, agents and employees or representatives permission to supervise, in a reasonable manner, our minor child in her participation in any and all camp activities.
3. I/we hereby release and forever discharge said camp, camp director, Xavier University, the Society of Jesuits, any and all coaches, agents, employees or representatives of said organizations, individually as a group or entity, from any and all claims, demands, damages, actions, causes of actions or suit, or whatever kind and nature may arise out of minor child at said camp.
4. I/we further agree to protect the aforesaid individuals, groups, and/or entities against any claims, demands, damages, actions, causes of action or suits whatever kind and nature which may arise out of participation of my minor child in said camp and to reimburse any loss or damage the aforementioned individuals, groups or entities may have to pay, if any litigation arises out of the participation of my child in said camp.
5. I/we further state that to the best of my/our knowledge my/our child is physically fit and able to play soccer. I/we agree to furnish a doctor's statement to that effect if requested by the camp director. It is understood that the camp does not take responsibility for the physical fitness of players and that as players and/or guardians; we have the responsibility for the physical condition of our minor child.
6. I/we further certify that we have health and hospitalization insurance under which said child is insured. I/we further grant the camp director to have my/our child treated by a physician in the event of illness or injury and I/we cannot be immediately contacted.
