- Auburn has now won his last 17 games in which Gene Chizik was part of the coaching staff.
- Auburn is now 43-28-5 all-time in SEC openers, and is 15-1 in its last 16 openers.
- Auburn is now 58-23-2 all-time against Mississippi State, and has won 20 of the last 27 meetings.
- Auburn is now 17-3 in night games at Jordan-Hare Stadium since the 2000 season.
- Auburn has now won 22 of its last 26 games played in September.
- Auburn has now won 51 consecutive games when scoring 30 or more points. The Tigers have not lost when scoring at least 30 points since a 56-49, four-overtime loss to Georgia in 1996.
- Auburn's scored first on a 1-yard touchdown run by Kodi Burns in the first quarter. The Tigers have scored first in both games this season.

- Ben Tate rushed for a career-high 157 yards, moving past James Bostic (1991-93) and Kenny Irons (2005-06) for 10th place in Auburn history in career rushing yards. Tate now has 2,233 rushing yards during his career.
- Tate had his second 100-yard rushing game of the season and the seventh of his career, which is tied for 11th most in school history. His previous career high was 156 against Tulane in 2006.
- Onterio McCalebb rushed for 114 yards, becoming the first Auburn freshman ever to rush for more than 100 yards in each of the first two games of a season.
- McCalebb became just the fourth Auburn freshman ever to rush for 100+ yards in back-to-back games at any point of a season. The previous three were Carnell Williams in 2001, Darrell Williams in 1989 and Ron O'Neal in 1981.
- Tate and McCalebb both went over 100 yards rushing for the second straight week. It marked the first time in Auburn history that the Tigers had two 100-yard rushers in back-to-back games.

- Darvin Adams went over 100 yards receiving in the first half, marking his first career 100-yard receiving game. He finished with five catches for 116 yards, all in the first half. He entered the game with 83 career receiving yards, including 65 last week.
- Tonight's game also marked the first time in school history that Auburn had two 100-yard rushers and a 100-yard receiver in the same game.
- The last time Auburn had one 100-yard rusher and a 100-yard receiver in the same game was 2006 at Ole Miss, when Kenny Irons rushed for 106 yards and Courtney Taylor had 108 yards receiving.
- Kodi Burns had his first career pass reception on Auburn's second offensive play, gaining two yards.
- Darvin Adams had a career-long 30-yard reception in the first quarter, surpassing a 28-yard catch in last week's game against Louisiana Tech.
- Kodi Burns rushed for three touchdowns, becoming the first Auburn player to have three rushing touchdowns in a game since Mario Fannin had three against New Mexico State in 2007. Burns now has 12 career rushing touchdowns and three this season.
- Antonio Coleman returned a first-quarter interception 20 yards for a touchdown. It was his first career interception, and second career touchdown. He returned a fumble 34 yards for a score in the 2007 season opener against Kansas State.
- Onterio McCalebb's 48-yard touchdown run in the second quarter was his second career touchdown run. It was also the longest run of his career.
- Kodi Burns' 13-yard touchdown pass to Phillip Lutzenkirchen in the third quarter marked the first catch of Lutzenkirchen's career, and the fifth touchdown pass of Burns' career.
- Jay Wisner had his first career reception late in the third quarter.
- T'Sharvan Bell had his first career interception in the fourth quarter.

Auburn Head Coach Gene Chizik

Opening statement...

"Tonight of course it was great to get our first SEC win. It was one of those games. It is a typical SEC deal. It goes back and forth and back and forth. We played with a lot of energy. I thought we answered the bell quite a few times when some adversity hit our team. I am really proud of the way our players responded to a lot of negative things that happened tonight. We didn't play perfect. It was one of those games, but when you play in this league and you play good football teams ... I think Dan Mullen has done a good job with that football team offensively. They have a great scheme. They move the ball. They have good players. Defensively, they rallied and they made it really tough on us tonight. That is a good team, but we are just proud that we came out with a win. Again in the game of trying to get better every week, we certainly have a long way to go before we are where we want to be. I am happy to get the win."

On Auburn's offense...

"We were sporadic at times. The final numbers obviously will tell you that we were very effective in a number of ways. Still, so much room to improve. I thought near the end again we ran the ball well. Again, we will look at it tomorrow. It is never as good as it seems. It is never as bad as it seems. We will see a lot that we need to improve on. I am very proud of our offense and our offensive coaching staff. They have done a great job as well as our defensive coaching staff."

"We have a game plan that we go in and look at. Obviously, you have to adapt and adjust with a number of things as the game goes on. I think Gus (Malzahn) does a great job with that and so does our whole offensive staff. You have guys up top that are looking for specific things. When you see those things, we can counter with a counter punch and that is what we try to do, and I think they do a great job with that. It is just recognizing what the defense gives."

On getting closer to the number of plays you wanted to run...

"We were closer, but we weren't close enough. We were closer, but not close enough."

On getting some players back tonight to provide depth on defense...

"I think that helped us. They were quick huddling and no huddling and doing the same thing back and forth which at the end of the day lets you play a lot of plays if you don't watch it. We had ourselves defensively in a lot of third down situations where we could have got off the field and we didn't and they kept those drives alive. All of a sudden, instead of a three or four or five play drive, you are out there for 14 or 15. That happened to us a couple of times tonight. We have to really go back and look at some things third down to improve on third down percentage. It was great to have those guys back because you are going to play a lot of plays and we need to have them."

On if there was a reason Ben Tate didn't hit the field until the second quarter...

"No. We could be different next week. It depends on what we want to do. I have said all along that our intent is to run the football obviously. We are trying to work every day and to continue to get better doing that. Obviously, our goal is to rush for more than 200 a game. That is what we've set. We've done that two games in a row. Again, our goal is to continue to get better. I have to really give our offensive line a lot of credit. I think again as the games go on, our goal is to try to wear down some of these defensive lines and you are seeing that to some degree."

After the block punt, Auburn's defense really shut down their offense...

"It's not just the defense. I know what situation you are talking about, but one of the things I just told them was that it is everywhere. When the offense has to step it up right now and have to give us some momentum back, this game is a game of momentum swings. The offense had a chance to step up and get some momentum back, and we did. When the defense had a chance to step up and get some three and outs and get some momentum changes, we did. There are guys right now individually ... they are playing special teams, they are playing offense and they are playing defense. When they are back, it is time to step in and deliver because they are playing x amount of plays and they do the same thing. That is why I was proud to see our team in different areas step up and answer the bell when we needed to on all sides of the ball."

On Auburn's special teams with the kickoff out of bounds and the dropped punt return...

"It is a concern. It is a concern. We are going to address that obviously tomorrow. We obviously have a long, long way to go. We covered a lot of kicks. I hope we can cover that many kicks every week, but we have to get better at the little things, and we have to dissect that thing pretty good and figure out where we can get better."

On Kodi Burns...

"It is as good as it gets. It is great. You are looking at great things happening to great kids. As we told him when this whole thing happened, we said you are going to help us win football games. He has played a big role in the first two. It is great to see him contribute and he will contribute in other ways, too."

On Auburn's up-tempo offense at the end of the first halves the last two games...

"The first thing that we are trying to do at the end of these halves is we are trying to make sure that our time management is very efficient. That's the use of time outs and things to preserve some time. We feel like we can score quick or at least get ourselves in a position to kick a field goal fairly quick. So, at the end of every half, every situation and every circumstance may be a little different week to week. If there is a window of opportunity right now where we can try to get some momentum before halftime, we are going to do it."

On Auburn's offense under Gus Malzahn...

"It is very innovative and it is fun to watch. Again from a defensive background and me looking at it and being a part of it, it is problematic in a lot of ways, and he does a great job with that."

On Auburn's interception return for a TD by Antonio Coleman...

"I think that was an awesome deal. That was great. Defensively, Coach (Ted) Roof and our whole defensive staff spend countless hours and countless time in practice right now trying to emphasize the turnovers and take-a-ways. But you don't always know if he is going to score or not. Tonight was just really great in energizing the crowd. It gave our defense pep in our step. It was great to see. We need more. I believe we had two this game and two last game and that is not enough. I think Coach Roof will tell you it is not enough. We have to get the ball out and we have to be able to get it back to our offense more."

"It is what it is. Those momentum swings are huge right now. Hey, you get those people excited in this stadium, it is a huge momentum swing. That's the way it is, and that was one of those situations where he did."

Opening statement...

"It was a disappointing night for us. I know our guys gave a lot of hard work. We have to do a much better job as a coaching staff. I am disappointed in the coaching staff, especially myself tonight, not putting our players in better positions to be successful. Obviously it was completely unacceptable for us to give up over 300 rushing yards. That is not Mississippi State defense. Offensively, we need to convert more on third downs so we can take some of the pressure off of our defense. If we did that tonight, and make big plays, there were plays to be made and their guys made them and we didn't. We have a lot of work to do and clean some things up and find a way to win next week against Vanderbilt."

On problems on defense...

"They had a couple of big ones (mistakes). We missed a couple of big plays and Auburn threw a couple balls up for grabs. Our guys were just inches away. As that went, we lost a bit of momentum and our offense had a couple of herky-jerky drives. We weren't able to keep our defense off the field and that's a big, big contributing factor to that as well."

On how to defend all of Auburn's offensive options...

"They do a good job and they have a good scheme. They had two guys that had over 100-yards rushing and at times we did a good job, we just gave up big plays. You can't do that, you can't give up third down and longs; that's going to come back and get you."

On quarterback Chris Relf's emotions...

"He has a lot of learning to do. He is a young guy without a lot of experience. I think he did a decent job of coming back from the (Antonio Coleman) interception. We have to clean some things up and we have to put him in more positions to be successful. Chris is going to learn from this. He is continually developing. What we have to do is help him build his confidence as a quarterback and get him ready for the future."

On the lack of production from the freshmen...

"We have to give them the ball a little bit more and get those guys in the open field. They did a good job of keeping us off schedule and not letting us get into the flow of things. One of the things we have to do when we get on the road is lean a little more on our older guys with a little more experience."

On Auburn's third-quarter dominance...

"The drive at the end of the first half gave them a little bit of momentum heading into halftime. What gets you is the offensive execution. We came out in the second half trying to build some momentum but we had two straight penalties and that just kills a drive for you. When that happened it boosted Auburn's offense. Their offense got rolling and our offense didn't take back the momentum."

On the blocked punt...

"I don't know who got it. We wanted to go after it and be attacking. Special teams are always going to be attacking. I thought that was going to be a big turning point for us. Obviously it was a big emotional lift for our team."

On Anthony Dixon's performance...

"For his first game of the season, I thought he did a good job running the ball but I would like to distribute it more between the backs and get some more carries for Christian (Ducre) and Arnil (Stallwort). I thought Anthony came out and played hard. I was pleased our guys played with effort for four quarters. There wasn't one play where I didn't see our guys play without effort and that's what we ask of them, to play with effort for all four quarters. If we can take one thing out of tonight it is that we played with effort all four quarters."

On the 3-4 defense...

"It was used to get speed on the edge and try and match up with Auburn's different formations. We were trying to get some faster guys for our defense."

"We had a specific game plan but we just didn't follow through with it. Next week we have another road game so we are going to work hard to prepare for it."
