- The pre-game flight was cancelled due to the weather.
- Auburn team captains were WR Kodi Burnns and CB Walter McFadden.
- Auburn won the toss and deferred to the second half. West Virginia chose to receive and Auburn defended the south end zone.
- Kickoff was at 7:50 p.m. CT.
- The start of the game was delayed by 1:03 due to lightning.
- Between 6:39 p.m. CT and 7:50 p.m. CT 3.75 inches of rain fell at the stadium.
- Game attendance was announced as 87,451.

## TEAM NOTES

- Auburn has now won its last 18 games in which Gene Chizik was part of the coaching staff.
- Auburn is now 18-3 in night games at Jordan-Hare Stadium since the 2000 season.
- Auburn has now won 23 of its last 27 games played in September.
- Auburn is now 6-3-1 all-time against current members of the Big East Conference.
- Auburn has now won 52 consecutive games when scoring 30 or more points. The Tigers have not lost when scoring at least 30 points since a 56-49, four-overtime loss to Georgia in 1996.
- Auburn continued its streak of having scored in every quarter this season and has scored in double digits in 10 of the 12 quarters.
- West Virginia scored first on a 1-yard rush by Noel Devine. It marked the first time this season that Auburn did not score first.
- Auburn trailed 21-20 at the half. It marked the first time this season that the Tigers trailed at halftime.
- Auburn trailed 30-27 at the end of the third quarter. It marked the first time this season that Auburn trailed after three periods.
- Auburn came back to win after trailing for the third straight game. The Tigers trailed 7-3 against Louisiana Tech and 17-14 against Mississippi State.
- Auburn had five interceptions against West Virginia, the most since it had five at Tennessee in 2004.
- Auburn forced six turnovers against West Virginia (4 interceptions, 1 fumble), the most since New Mexico State committed six in 2007.
- With 49 points against Mississippi State and 41 against West Virginia, it marks the first time for Auburn to post back-to-back 40-point games since 2003 when it scored 45 against Vanderbilt and 48 against Western Kentucky.
- Auburn has combined to score a total of 127 points in its first three games, the most it has in its first three games of the season since 1996 when it had 136 against UAB, Fresno State and Ole Miss.
- Auburn finished the game with 400 yards of total offense, combined with 556 against Louisiana Tech and 589 against Mississippi State, it marked the first time since 2004 it had three consecutive games of 400 or more yards of total offense when it had 400 against Tennessee, 472 against Louisiana Tech and 522 against Arkansas; the last time Auburn did it to open a season was in 2000 when it tallied more than 400 yards in its first four games.

## INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Eltoro Freeman made his first career start at Auburn.
- Ben Tate rushed for 75 yards, moving past James Joseph (1986-90) for ninth place in Auburn history in career rushing yards. Tate now has (2,308) rushing yards during his career.
- Eric Smith had a 28-yard catch in the first quarter and a 37-yard reception in the second quarter. Entering the game, he had two receptions for three yards during his career.
- Wes Byrum made a 46-yard field goal in the first quarter and a 42-yarder in the second quarter. He now has 37 career field goals, which ranks seventh in school history.
- Byrum also established a career best streak with five consecutive made field goals.
- Mike Blanc forced a fumble with a sack midway through the first quarter which was recovered by Antonio Coleman. It was Blanc's second sack of the season and his first career forced fumble. It was Coleman's second career fumble recovery and first since 2007.

- Darwin Adams caught a 19-yard touchdown pass in the first quarter, a 4-yard score in the second quarter, and a 17-yard TD pass in the fourth quarter. He became the first Auburn player to catch three touchdown passes in a game since Alexander Wright had four touchdown catches against Pacific in 1989.
- Adams now has four career touchdown receptions, all in the last two weeks.
- Neiko Thorpe had his third career interception and first of the season early in the second quarter.
- Demond Washington had his first career sack in the second quarter.
- Chris Todd's 82-yard touchdown pass to Mario Fannin in the third quarter was the seventh-longest pass play in Auburn history, and tied for the 13<sup>th</sup>-longest play from scrimmage in school history.
- Paired with a 93-yard touchdown pass from Todd to Terrell Zachery in the season opener, it marked the first time in school history that Auburn has had two pass plays of at least 80 yards in the same season, and the second time Auburn had two scoring plays from scrimmage of 80 yards or more in the same season (1983 -- runs of 84 and 80 yards).
- Todd finished the game with career highs of 284 passing yards and four touchdown passes. His previous highs were 255 yards vs. Louisiana Tech and two touchdowns on two occasions.
- Todd became the first Auburn player to throw four touchdown passes in a game since Daniel Cobb had five TD passes against Louisiana Tech in 2001.
- Jake Ricks intercepted a pass in the fourth quarter. It was his first career interception.
- Walter McFadden intercepted a pass in the fourth quarter. It was his fourth career interception.
- Craig Stevens tipped and intercepted a pass in the fourth quarter for a touchdown. It was his first career interception.

## WVU Game Notes at Auburn – September 19, 2009

The lightning/rain delay marked the first for a Mountaineer team since WVU took on Virginia Tech in Morgantown on Oct. 5, 1991.

Today's game captains for West Virginia were senior quarterback Jarrett Brown, senior linebacker Reed Williams, senior offensive lineman Selvish Capers and senior punter Scott Kozlowski. Williams and Brown are permanent game captains while the coaching staff will the other two captains on a game-by-game basis.

There was just one first-time starter for the Mountaineers; Josh Taylor got the start at defensive end in place of Scooter Berry. A total of 33 Mountaineers now have at least one game of starting experience. Tops on that list are Berry (25), offensive lineman Selvish Capers (22), linebacker Reed Williams (17) and defensive lineman Chris Neild (17).

Today's attendance of 87,451 is the third-largest crowd to ever see West Virginia play (96,455 at Penn State/1991; 88,272 at Ohio State/1987).

Jarrett Brown's 58-yard completion to Bradley Starks in the first quarter tied a career long pass for Brown and set a career-long reception for Starks. Starks' previous long catch was a 55-yarder from Brown last week against East Carolina.

WVU's opening scoring drive marked the fifth scoring drive of 2:05 or less this season. It's the second scoring drive of 0:49 yards was its third under one minute so far this season.

Devine's second touchdown rush, a 71-yard run, marked the longest play from scrimmage for WVU this season. It was also the longest touchdown rush by a Mountaineer since Devine scored on a 92-yard touchdown run against Syracuse last year. The touchdown was his fourth of the season and 14<sup>th</sup> of his career. It was also the fourth-longest rush of his career.

Devine's 12-yard touchdown run on WVU's opening drive of the second half was his third of the game and 15<sup>th</sup> of his career. It marked a career-best for single game touchdowns by the junior (Marshall and Oklahoma in 2007).

Josh Taylor's sack of Chris Todd in the first quarter was the first of his career.

Jock Sanders' six-yard touchdown reception from Jarrett Brown was his first of the season and eighth of his career.

WVU's 21 points in the first quarter are the most by the Mountaineers in a quarter since putting up 21 points in the first quarter against North Carolina in the Meineke Car Care Bowl last season.

With his 128-yards rushing against the Tigers, Noel Devine moved up four spots to ninth all-time in WVU career rushing. He passed Major Harris (2,161/1987-89) Garrett Ford, Sr. (2,166/1965-67), Bob Gresham (2,181/1968-70) and Undra Johnson (2,211/1985-88).

Devine rushed for over 100 yards for the 10<sup>th</sup> time in his career and second time this season (112 vs. Liberty).

Ovid Goulbourne's 13-yard interception return in the second quarter was the first of his career.

Sydney Glover's sack of Chris Todd in the third quarter was his first of the season and third of his career.

Jarrett Brown reached the 200 yard passing mark in the third quarter. It marks his third-straight 200-yard passing performance.

Tyler Bitancurt's 28-yard field in the third quarter was his fifth of the season and first since kicking four in the season-opening win against Liberty.

WVU has now scored at least 30 points in each game this season, marking the first time since 2007 and first under coach Bill Stewart that WVU has scored 30 or more in three consecutive games (last was 38 vs. Miss. St., 31 at Rutgers, 38 vs. Louisville).

Jock Sanders' 12 receptions tied a school record for most receptions in a game with four other Mountaineers. He is the first Mountaineer since 1998 (David Saunders vs. Miami) to amass that total in a game.

Sanders' 115 yards receiving also mark the first 100-yard receiving effort by a Mountaineer since Darius Reynaud 134 yards against Marshall in 2007.

WVU falls to 60-2 when scoring 30 or more points in a game since 2000. It marks the first game since a 44-34 loss at Louisville on Nov. 2, 2006, that WVU failed to win a contest when it scored 30 or more points in a game.

## Auburn Head Coach Gene Chizik

"First of all, I would like to say that I wish I had 87,000 game balls because our fans were a huge reason we won that game and I went them to know that. We had thousands of students (15,000) to stay here through that whole thing. Everybody came early and nobody left because of the weather, and I promise you that was one of the huge reasons we won the game and momentum swings happen because of our fans. We played a good football game tonight at times. I'm really, really proud of our football team because we had to overcome more adversity than probably we did in either of the previous two weeks. It is a sign of a football team that is believing and coming together when you can overcome some of that adversity. We are growing as a football team. We didn't play well tonight in so many ways, but we won the game, and at the end of the day, I am so proud of our guys because they had to fight and claw and scratch back to win it. That is who they were tonight."

### *On the turnovers*

"The turnovers were the difference in the game. There is no question about it. That is a really, really good offense. We knew they were good. The wet field right now ... we just weren't tackling well. I don't know if it was the wet field. I certainly don't want to make excuses. We weren't tackling well. That was the deal early in the game. That and the combination they are really good on offense. The difference to me was there was no question about it were the turnovers in the game were the huge momentum swing differences in the game. Obviously, we had five interceptions and those turnovers were huge and I think it changed the game."

### *On Jarrett Brown, West Virginia's quarterback*

"There is no question. He is a great quarterback. We said all week the thing that makes him really, really explosive is not only does he have a great arm, not only does he have great accuracy with his throws, he has great scramble ability. On the first long throw that you saw, we had him wrapped up and blitzed him two or three times and missed him and some sloppy tackling. Again, he is a very good player, and I have to give him a lot of credit. Yes, when we had him bottled up, that's when obviously, we were cutting down on big plays."

### *On AU wide receiver Darvin Adams*

"Darvin has really come on. Again, he had another good night tonight. We were proud, not just him but offensively when we need to have some big plays in there to get us back in the game and some momentum swings, he was obviously a part of a few of those."

### *On AU quarterback Chris Todd*

"I think Chris obviously there were things in the game with the one interception. But, overall if you look at his performance right now, he had four touchdown passes. I am really proud of Chris because again when you look at those situations and things are not going well ... there are a lot of times when the offense wasn't moving the football. You never looked in his eyes and saw anything but confidence and all he ever needed was another chance and he came back and delivered. I am really proud of his performance. He like the rest of the team have a long way to go."

### *On the win*

"I think it is huge. No. 1 this was a really, really good football team. I wasn't sure exactly where we were at to be honest with you. I know that our execution on both sides of the football is not percentage wise where we want to be right now. I know that there are some things that we still need to get adjusted on some of our special teams units. What I did like tonight was I did see that our football team whatever the circumstances were against a really good team will fight and claw and scratch until the end to win it. I couldn't be more proud of our guys right now."

### *On Auburn*

"I mean just the whole game. What I always like to do is I like to see their eyes. I want to see what they look like. I want to see what their body language looks like. It is really important for me be able to go over there to both sides of the ball and our special teams, and I want to see those guys eyes when the game is coming down to the end. I want to see who is ready to go and who doesn't have that far away look. I just told them with five minutes left in the game I told the defense, 'you are going to have to go out there two more times minimum and stop them, and that is just the way it is.' I was proud to see they did it."

### *On the hour delay to kickoff because of lightning and heavy rain and what did the team do during it*

"I don't know. We both had the delay. We just kind of tried to stay loose and we stretched and relaxed and got our pads off when it became a long delay. Really we just tried to relax and stay focused on the game, but stay loose and stare at each other for a long time."

## HEAD COACH BILL STEWART

### *Opening Statement...*

"We lost a very close game. A lot of pain in there. Not physical but mental. We are going to talk about mental in a couple of phases. I was very proud of the way our guys played a tough, physical football game. I thought it was a heck of a game. I thought both sides played physical. Both sides played hard and I'm glad we got that football game under our belt. It's over and we should have come out on top but we didn't. With that being said, there are a couple of reasons why we didn't come out on top. I wasn't pleased with the turnovers. We can't have five picks on a fumble. And I really wasn't pleased with the mental mistakes. What we call mental mistakes are what someone may call a physical mistake. Things like holding or chop block, I call that mental and that's what we call mental at West Virginia University. We know how to use our hands and use our feet and we know not to chop block. We do not teach illegal tactics like chop block. I look at stats, but that was a heck of an offensive showing. The defensive coaches are probably pulling their hair out but that was a tough game. I was very impressed at how hard and how physical we played, particularly on the road for the first time. We have a young offensive line, we all know that. They battled and they played tough. We have a young secondary mostly safeties, we know that. I was pleased at the way they played but you cannot make mistakes. I have a bunch of heavy hearts in there (locker room) it starts off with me, the staff, and the players and everyone else involved. It was not fun to lose but I am proud of our effort."

### *On concentrating on the run...*

"They got a little hot on us and they made some nice plays. That last touchdown pass, you know I do special teams, and more on the offense, but I saw they jammed their wide receiver. Our safety (Robert Sands) almost got to it. It was a nice throw. When they stretch you horizontally, which they did, we had a nice jam, and I thought we had a chance to intercept it."

### *On quarterback Jarrett Brown's injury...*

"He is good. He just got whacked sideways. It wasn't anything like (Oklahoma QB Sam) Bradford's injury. He got body slammed, he is fine. I was going to put the young guy (Geno Smith) in anyhow."

### *On quarterback Jarrett Brown forcing too much on the interception...*

"He's in his third game that he has started. Eighty plays, 500 yards, 32:50 time of possession and it just aches. Kicking game and kick off return, we stuffed them. I thought we were going to break the gates two or three times. I was really pleased with our special teams."

### *On Auburn speeding up the tempo...*

"It was a pretty fast game, you don't get that anymore. We were 10-of-15 on third down and I was tired of hearing about third downs. They were 9-of-18."

### *On the biggest drive in the second quarter...*

"When the ballgame was 21-10 and he (Brown) threw that pick. If he wouldn't have thrown that, it's 28-10 right there and we still came back. Missed the extra point. ### *On what the team did during the rain delay...*

"I told a few jokes. I did not know what to do. We were not going to go out there and get scorched. That lightning, we don't mess with that and I am so glad that is the way college football is. It was the right thing to do and it did not hurt us. I remember, I told the guys back in the old days we used to go out in the rain and start hitting. For the young people, you do not know what I am talking about, but all you older guys know."
