- Auburn has now won 53 consecutive games when scoring 30 or more points. The Tigers have not lost when scoring at least 30 points since a 56-49, four-overtime loss to Georgia in 1996.
- Auburn has now scored 181 points this season, which is the most points through four games in school history. The previous mark was 176 in 1986.
- Auburn has now scored at least 40 points in three straight games for the first time in school history.
- Auburn's 54 points were the most in a game by the Tigers since Auburn scored 55 points against New Mexico State in 2007.
- Auburn finished with 560 yards of offense. It marked the first time Auburn had at least 400 yards of offense in four consecutive games since the first four games of the 2000 season.
- Auburn continued its streak of having scored in every quarter this season and has scored at least one touchdown in 15 of the 16 quarters.
- Auburn came back to win after trailing for the fourth straight game.
- Auburn scored 23 points in 5:33 and 30 points in 10:31 after being held scoreless for the first 12 minutes.
- Auburn's 26-point second quarter was the Tigers' highest-scoring quarter since Sept. 9, 1995 against UT-Chattanooga, when the Tigers scored 28 points in the second quarter.
- Auburn continued its streak of scoring in the final two minutes of the first half in every game this season after Wes Byrum's field goal with seven seconds left in the half.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- John Sullen made his first career start at Auburn, making the starting lineup at left guard.
- Chris Todd threw five touchdown passes one week after throwing four touchdowns. It marked the first time in school history an Auburn quarterback threw at least four touchdown passes in back-to-back games.
- Todd's five touchdown passes tied the school single-game record set by Daniel Cobb against Louisiana Tech in 2001.
- Todd's 287 yards passing were a career high, surpassing his mark of 284 set last Saturday against West Virginia.
- Ben Tate rushed for 63 yards, moving past Stacy Danley (1987-90) for eighth place in Auburn history in career rushing yards. Tate now has 2,371 rushing yards during his career.
- Zac Etheridge recovered a fumble that he also forced in the first quarter. He now has three career forced fumbles and two career recovered fumbles.
- Josh Bynes recovered a fumble forced by Craig Stevens late in the first quarter, after Stevens and Daren Bates shared a sack. It was Stevens' second career forced fumble and Bynes' first career fumble recovery.
- Tommy Trott caught a 6-yard touchdown pass from Chris Todd late in the first quarter. It was Trott's third career touchdown catch and his first since 2006.
- Antonio Coleman had a half sack late in the first quarter. He now has 17.0 career sacks, moving into a tie for sixth on Auburn's career sacks list with Leonardo Carson (1996-99) and Willie Whitehead (1991-94).

- Terrell Zachery scored on a 46-yard touchdown pass from Chris Todd early in the second quarter, and a 65-yarder midway through the quarter. He now has three career touchdown receptions, having previously hauled in a 93-yarder in the season opener.
- Zachery went over 100 yards receiving in the second quarter and finished with 122 for his first career 100-yard receiving effort, and second by an Auburn player this season (Darvin Adams vs. Mississippi State).
- Josh Bynes recorded a safety early in the second quarter. It was the first safety recorded by Auburn since a team safety against Arkansas in 2008. It was the first safety recorded by an individual player for Auburn since Charles Dorsey collected one against Louisiana Tech in 1998.
- Onterio McCalebb scored on a 1-yard touchdown run, one play after he had a career-long 62-yard rush. It was his third career touchdown.
- McCalebb's 62-yard rush was tied for the sixth longest rush by a freshman in school history.
- Todd now has 10 for the season, while Kodi Burns also has a TD toss this year. Auburn had just seven passing touchdowns as a team all of last season.
- Travante Stallworth had his first career reception late in the second quarter.
- Wes Byrum's 32-yard field goal just before the half was his sixth field goal in as many attempts this season. His six consecutive made field goals are a career best, and he now has 34 career made field goals, which ranks tied for sixth in school history.
- Darvin Adams caught a 26-yard touchdown pass early in the third quarter, marking his fifth touchdown of his career, all coming in the last three games.
- Mario Fannin's 36-yard touchdown catch in the third quarter was his second receiving touchdown of the season and sixth of his career. He has scored 12 career touchdowns.
- Neil Caudle's 52-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter was the first touchdown – rushing or passing – of his career.
- Dee Ford recorded his first career sack late in the fourth quarter, helping limit Ball State to just a field goal.

"It was great to get our fourth win tonight. We didn't always play like we had hoped. Obviously, there were some very sloppy moments in the game. It just didn't look like we were in sync a lot of times. I don't know exactly what the issues were, I just know that we were sloppy, especially early on with the bobbled punt again and things of that nature. The bottom line is right now is that we found a way to win it again, and we will look at the film tomorrow and we will find a lot of good things that we did. Again, it was sloppy and that wasn't the way we wanted to play, but we are happy with a win. We will go back to work tomorrow, and we have a very tough October that we are facing. They are big catches, and he has made some runs that weren't quite routine runs either. He has made some things happen after he has caught the ball, and he has gone up and made some tough catches. "I'm really proud of Chris again. Chris has done an outstanding job week by week trying to operate and manage and run the offense, and he has done a really nice job of that. Again, tonight on several throws he put that ball about the only place you could put it. It was right in there. He has done really well, and he needs to continue to grow as our quarterback, but right now he is managing our team really well."

On 4 TDs in the first half with very short time period of drives

"That's a great thing. I will take the scores any way and any time that I can get them. Where it gets a little bit unclear is that just for our depth defensively and our depth with on our special teams because every time we score they have to go down and cover another kick. Like I said, we will take it any way that we can get it. Scoring that fast sometimes does take a little bit out of your defense if they can't go three and out. It all balances out. It has all balanced out real well so far. I'm just pleased we score. I don't care if it is one second or a 10 minute drive. I am just proud of the offense putting up points on the board."

On the decision to fake the punt and on Onterio McCalebb

"With Onterio right now, we won't know. We don't really know at this point. Tomorrow we will know more obviously. The decision to fake the punt was we just felt like we faked one in the second game, and we just feel like we have it built into our package and we have some different things off those that we like to use. Our defense was playing really well at that point in time, so we decided to go with the fake and it didn't work, but we will continue to fake them. That is just part of the offset we are trying to do with our punt team because we have a lot of athletes on our punt team."

"Whether I feel I like it or not we are going. I mean that is where we are going and we will be there a week from tonight. I think we have to get a lot of things cleaned up. It is a very young team and it is a very thin team. That's a good football team we are going to play. We will have to play heads and tails above of where we were tonight if we have a chance to beat Tennessee next week."

"It's still a concern. Opening obviously starting with the punt return at the beginning of the game, we have to try to continue to get better. We are continuing to improve in some areas and some areas we are going backward. Again, the continuity of those teams matter. I'm not sure that continuity wise we are where we need to be. I'm not sure that we can be right now. We will continue to work and try to get better at it."

"With our backups were in there before the fourth quarter started. We have to get guys reps, and we have to get those guys playing time.
