- Eltoro Freeman finished with a career-high 12 tackles. He surpassed his season output through the team's first seven games by halftime, when he had eight tackles. Freeman had seven tackles this season entering the game.
- Ben Tate moved closer to becoming the fifth Auburn player with 3,000 career rushing yards. Tate finished with 67 yards rushing, and now has 2,882 yards for his career.
- Zac Etheridge forced a fumble that Craig Stevens recovered in the second quarter. It marked the fourth forced fumble of Etheridge's career, and the second fumble recovery of Stevens' career.
- Antonio Coleman was credited with half a sack twice in the second quarter, and now has 18.0 quarterback sacks during his career, which puts him in sole possession of sixth place on Auburn's career sacks list.
- Wes Byrum's 24-yard field goal in the third quarter was the 40<sup>th</sup> field goal of his career, and 12<sup>th</sup> this year in 13 attempts. He ranks fifth in school history with 40 career field goals, and needs just 10 more to tie John Vaughn for the school record.
- Byrum's four points scored pushed his career total to 207, moving him past Stephen Davis (1993-95) for eighth in Auburn history in career points scored.
- Neil Caudle threw his first career touchdown pass late in the game, connecting with Philip Lutzenkirchen from the 1-yard line.
- The touchdown catch by Lutzenkirchen was the second of his career.
- Emory Blake caught his first career pass late in the game, hauling in a 16-yard reception from Caudle.

1. LSU's game captains were 30 **Josh Jasper**, 24 **Harry Coleman**, 92 **Drake Nevis**, 18 **Richard Dickson** and 68 **Josh Dworaczyk**.
2. LSU won the toss and deferred to the second half. Auburn received the opening kickoff.
3. Tigers extending their notable consecutive starts streak tonight were: LT **Ciron Black** (47), OG **Lyle Hitt** (27), LB **Harry Coleman** (20), RT **Joseph Barksdale** (20), TE **Richard Dickson** (20), RB **Charles Scott** (20) and CB **Chris Hawkins** (20).
4. LSU's touchdown on its opening drive, a 14-yard TD catch by **Terrance Toliver**, was the first TD by the Tigers on their opening drive in any game all season. LSU's other score on an opening drive came at Washington with a field goal.
5. With **Chris Hawkins'** interception in the second quarter, LSU has now intercepted at least one pass in nine straight games dating back to the final two games of the 2008 season.
6. LB **Harry Coleman's** sack in the first quarter was the first by LSU since tallying three sacks against Vanderbilt in the second week of the season.
7. LSU's defense did not surrender a point in the first half, marking the second time this season that has happened. The Tigers also held Georgia scoreless in the first half.
8. LSU has defeated Auburn in three straight meetings for the first time since 1972, 1973, and 1980. The last time LSU beat Auburn in three consecutive seasons was 1935-37. LSU now leads the all-time series, 24-19-1.
9. Tonight's attendance of 92,654 is the eighth highest attendance in the history of Tiger Stadium.
10. LSU improved to 6-1 for the third time in five seasons under head coach **Les Miles**.
11. LSU has now won 33 of its last 34 Saturday night games in Tiger Stadium.
12. LSU extended its winning streak on the ESPN family of networks to 20 straight games. The streak dates back to the home opener in 2005 when Tennessee rallied for a 30-27 overtime win on a Monday night on ESPN2.

13. WR **Brandon LaFell** has now caught a pass in 35 straight games (34 of those multiple-reception games) dating back to the 2007 Sugar Bowl versus Notre Dame.
  - a. **LaFell's** streak is the fifth longest streak in the nation. Central Michigan's Bryan Anderson leads the nation with 47 consecutive games with a catch.
14. WR **Terrance Toliver** hauled in his third receiving TD of the season and seventh of his career on a 14-yard throw from Jordan Jefferson with 8:21 remaining in the first quarter.
  - a. **Toliver** has now caught a pass in 17 consecutive games.
  - b. **Toliver's** nine catches tonight are a career-high, surpassing his previous best of six receptions at Georgia earlier this season.
15. QB **Jordan Jefferson** fired his eighth and ninth TD passes of the season and 12th and 13th of his career on a 14-yard throw to Terrance Toliver with 8:21 left in the first quarter and a 17-yard pass to Brandon LaFell with 13:41 remaining in the third quarter.
  - a. **Jefferson** then recorded his first rushing TD of the season and second of his career on a 15-yard scamper with 1:10 to go in the first quarter.
  - b. **Jefferson** became the first LSU quarterback to run for a TD and throw for a TD in a game since Matt Flynn did it against Arkansas on Nov. 23, 2007. Jefferson is the first to achieve the feat in the same quarter since Marcus Randall ran for a TD and threw for a TD in the second quarter at Arkansas on Nov. 26, 2004.
16. LB **Harry Coleman** tallied his second forced fumble of the season and third of his career with 2:31 left in the first quarter.
  - a. **Coleman's** two sacks of Chris Todd marked the first sacks of his career.
17. DB **Danny McCray** recovered a fumble for the third and fourth times in his career.
18. CB **Chris Hawkins** picked off his fifth career pass and second of the season with 14:29 left in the second quarter. Three of Hawkins' five career interceptions have come against Auburn.

19. PK **Josh Jasper** booted a 32-yard field goal with 0:09 on the clock in the second quarter. He is now 12-of-13 for his career and 10-of-11 for the season. Jasper's only miss came at Mississippi State earlier this year.
20. QB **Russell Shepard** ran for his first career TD on a 69-yard TD dash with 1:09 to go in the third quarter.

LSU HEAD COACH LES MILES

Opening statement...

“That’s a very good Auburn team. They fought like heck. I give great credit to coach (Gene) Chizik, and I think he’s done a great job in his first year. We went into the open week with the want to improve, and we looked at some specifics. We still want to run the football and throw the football with balance and have the ability to do both. We think that in the long run in football and in the stretch run of the season, the team that has balance – can run it and throw it – will be the most dangerous offensively. We stayed the course. We throw for 250 (yards), and we rush for 122 (yards), and an offense comes to life. I still don’t think we are hitting on all cylinders. I think we can be better and more efficient. Our football team needs to improve. This is a nice win, certainly, but not one that we are going to rest and reflect on but choose to improve on ambitiously.

“We understand where we’re at. We play a quality team (Tulane) next week, and as the season unfolds, we are going to play some of the finest teams in the country. To be and compete with those teams, we have to be better, and our team knows that. That’s good. You’d have been proud of this team if you watched them in the open week, coming off a tough loss to a nationally-ranked team, and they just played hard. This was that mark. This was some improvement. Certainly, a very good defensive unit has taken the field week-in and week-out for us and is playing better and better. Offensively, we’re coming. I didn’t like how we played in (special) teams. I think we can play better in (special) teams, but again, it was a very good outing for the team.”

On how important it was for QB Jordan Jefferson to have this kind of game as a confidence booster...

“Part of the improvement is certainly at the quarterback spot. I think you watched him really execute pretty well. His last passing attempt was him not executing very well, but I think we can catch it better and throw it better, and I think that he is the kind of quarterback and kind of competitor that expects himself to be better. He’s a confident guy. He’ll look to improve.”

On the first-team defense going back on the field with eight seconds remaining in the game...

“They wanted to go back on the field. Can you stop them? I couldn’t stop them. There’s not any chance. I love that effort and that want and scrappiness late in the game with nothing really to prove other than a yard. They said, ‘I’ll play for a yard.’”

"I thought we had our moments where we played some things well. What (Jefferson) did tonight is he hit some great deep balls on us. He was really, really accurate, and put the ball about the only place you could put it. There were times I thought we had good coverage, but the receivers went up and got the ball. He threw some jump balls in some places right now that were very hard to defend. He had a big night and executed well. The deep balls were the things that were glaring to me when it comes to our pass defense. They hit some underneath, intermediate ones as well, but it was the deep balls that got us. On if he will change quarterbacks ...

"We will look at everything. That is the natural question, but it was a whole offensive effort, whether it was running the football, throwing the football.
