Auburn Post-Game Notes

Auburn vs. Furman

- The pregame flight was made by Nova from the flagpole in the northeast corner of the stadium.
- Auburn team captains were QB Chris Todd, DE Antonio Coleman and CB Walter McFadden.
- Auburn won the toss and elected to receive. Furman chose to defend the south end zone.
- Kickoff was at 12:36 p.m. CT.
- Attendance was announced as 81,506.
- At halftime, Christian Becraft, a senior from Huntsville, was named Auburn's Homecoming Queen.

TEAM NOTES

- Auburn won its 18th consecutive Homecoming game, marking the longest streak in school history. The Tigers won 17 straight Homecoming contests from 1953-69.
- Auburn is now 4-0 all-time against Furman, although this was the first meeting between the schools since 1956.
- Auburn scored a season-high 63 points, which is the most by the Tigers since the Tigers also scored 63 against Ball State in 2005.
- Auburn has now won 55 consecutive games when scoring 30 or more points in a game, and is 275-4 all-time. The last time Auburn lost a game when scoring at least 30 points was in 1996, when the Tigers dropped a 56-49 contest to Georgia in four overtimes.
- Auburn finished with 655 yards of total offense. It marked the Tigers' seventh game this season with at least 400 yards of offense and their fourth with at least 500.
- Auburn's 655 yards of offense were the fourth most since in school history (records dating back to 1967) and the most by the Tigers since 1988 (680 yards vs. Kansas).
- Auburn had 373 yards passing, which is the ninth most in school history (records dating back to 1967) and the most since 374 against Tennessee in the 2004 SEC Championship game.
- Auburn as a team completed 27-of-30 passes (90%) setting the mark for highest single-game completion percentage with at least 30 attempts. The previous high was 25-of-34 (75.6%) against Georgia Tech in 1971.
- Auburn had 282 yards rushing, marking the Tigers' seventh game this season with at least 200 yards rushing.
- Auburn scored first on a 6-yard pass to end the opening drive. The Tigers are now 4-1 when scoring first.
- Auburn's 21 first-quarter points were the most in an opening quarter for the Tigers since Auburn scored 21 points in the first quarter of the 2005 Iron Bowl against Alabama.
- Auburn's 42 points in the first half were the most in the opening half by the Tigers since Auburn scored 45 first-half points against Louisiana-Monroe in 2003.
- Auburn led 42-3 at the half. The Tigers are now 6-1 this season when leading at the half.
- Auburn held Furman to three first-half points, marking the fourth time in the last six games that the Tigers allowed seven or fewer points in the opening half.
- After allowing 51 yards to Furman on the Paladins' opening drive, Auburn surrendered just eight yards the rest of the first half.
- Auburn led 49-17 after three quarters. The Tigers are now 6-1 this season when leading after three quarters.
- Auburn had four touchdown drives that took less than two minutes. The Tigers now have 21 TD drives this season that have taken less than 2:00 off the clock.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Junior Demond Washington and freshman Philip Lutzenkirchen made their first career starts.
- Junior safety Zac Etheridge, who suffered a season-ending injury last Saturday, had his streak of consecutive starts snapped at 24, which was tied for second longest on the team with Ryan Pugh, behind only Lee Ziemba.

- Chris Todd completed 17-of-18 passes for 256 yards and four touchdowns - all in the first half - while beginning the game with 14 consecutive completions. It marked his sixth 200-yard passing game of the season.
- Todd broke the Auburn single-game records for completion percentage with a minimum of 10 and 15 attempts, completing 94.4 percent of his throws. Jason Campbell previously held both records, completing 12-of-13 passes (92.3 percent) vs. Western Kentucky in 2003 and 17-of-19 passes (89.5 percent) vs. Arkansas in 2004.
- Todd's four touchdown passes give him 17 this season, which ranks tied for fourth most in a single season in school history. It was also his third game this season with at least four touchdown passes.
- Darwin Adams had six catches for 115 yards and three touchdowns (6, 23 and 41 yards) in the first half. Adams now has nine TD receptions this season, which is tied for third most in a single season in school history, and the most since Ronny Daniels had nine in 1999. It was also his second career 100-yard receiving game and his second game with six catches and three touchdowns (West Virginia).
- Ben Tate finished with 75 yards rushing on just 12 carries. He now has 1,142 yards rushing this season, moving up two spots to 13th on Auburn's single-season rushing chart.
- Tate had touchdown rushes of nine yards in the first quarter and four yards in the second quarter. He now has eight rushing touchdowns this season and 22 for his career, which ranks ninth in school history.
- Freshman Deangelo Benton had six catches for 88 yards after entering the game without a reception this season.
- Freshman Emory Blake had five catches for 32 yards after entering the game with one reception this season.
- Mario Fannin's 24-yard touchdown reception late in the first quarter was the seventh receiving touchdown of his career and his 13th career touchdown overall.
- Antonio Coleman recorded his 21st career quarterback sack on the final play of the first quarter. He moved into a tie for third on the school's career sacks list with Tracy Rucker (1985-88) and Craig Ogletree (1986-89).
- Dee Ford intercepted his first career pass late in the first half on a throw that was batted by Nick Fairley.
- Eric Smith scored his first career touchdown late in the third quarter, scoring on a 2-yard run.
- Anthony Gulley scored his first career touchdowns in the fourth quarter, scoring first on a 13-yard rush before adding a 50-yard run later in the quarter.

Gene Chizik, Auburn Head Coach

"It was great to go out there and get a win. We played a lot of young guys today which we did. We played every senior who we have on our squad which is really important for us to be able to do that. We just played a bunch of guys. We played some guys both ways that we kind of threw in there and let them play and have fun. It was just good to see that. It was great for our team morale and it was great to get everybody out of the game relatively healthy. It was a good team win."

On Chris Todd

"It was really good to see Chris. He was on the run for a lot of his throws, and he was very efficient in what he did. Again, we ran the ball some and play action it. We had a lot of receivers who were very productive in the first half I thought. Chris did a really nice job. It is hard to complete that many in a row. It was good to see him come out and fire on all cylinders."

On Anthony Gulley playing in the secondary, is that an experimental deal?

"That was just us trying to get some guys out of the game and throw some guys in the game just because depth-wise that is where we are. We just threw him out there. We just threw him out there. We worked him a little bit there this week just to make sure they've done some. Not a great deal but enough to get them in the game and survive with them out there. Again, it was just one of those matter of circumstances."

On Anthony Gulley playing at tailback

"To my knowledge at this point, never. Now, we will all look like what are we thinking about since he ran a 50-yard touchdown. Really and truly, we just are trying to survive to the end of the game. It was great to see him do that. He's a good football player."

On Coach Curtis Luper carrying the American flag

"He carried the American flag. We brought the Armed Forces into our practice this week just as a recognition and celebration for what those guys do for our country. We just thought it was appropriate today for Curtis, who was in the Army, to lead the team out carrying the American flag."

Were players asking to play other positions?

"You get a little of that going on. He was actually one who didn't ask. We just threw him out there. It was fun. It was fun to have those guys get out there. Again, we were trying to run the ball and run the clock out some. He did a great job on that. Of course, he had some really good blocks thrown out there by some guys as well."

When Furman scored twice like that right after the half, did you think about putting the starters back in?

"I was committed to going with young guys and letting them play. That was really indicative of how football games go. They have to play through those times. You have to keep them out there and let them play."

After getting a big first half lead, what were some of your goals for the rest of the game?

"When it comes to the offense right now, you are trying to do some things with your younger guys, who are imperative for down the road. Timing throws. You don't really want to throw the football. You really like to run it and run the clock out. You got some on first downs so it is a little bit of a catch 22. Timing of the throws with the quarterbacks and receivers is important. DeAngelo Benton today got some timing in there with him and Neil. Things of that nature. The offensive line being able to run block and being able to protect. Those are the things that they have to when they are ahead they have to get better at. Defensively, the same thing. They just basically execute on base defense with very little blitzing. We have a lot of guys in there who have never played defense before. We are just trying to really survive the game and get out healthy while still giving everybody experience."

On the Auburn team wearing white wrist bands with #4 on them

"Our football team and coaching staff and players really felt like we needed to do something in recognition of the fact that Zac (Etheridge) wasn't playing out there on the field with us today. This is what we

came up with. We got it cleared by the SEC Office. We appreciate that very much by the SEC. It meant a lot to our football team. He is a huge part of what we do and who we are. This is just a great way to recognize him."
