### THE GAME

Now 4-4 on the season following a 52-27 home loss to Appalachian State, Furman returns to action this Saturday when it takes on the Auburn Tigers in a 1:30 p.m. ET (12:30 CT) pay per view televised game. In Auburn, a 37-20 winner over Mississippi last Saturday, the Paladins will be facing their second Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) foe this season and first Southeastern Conference opponent since 2002 (Vanderbilt). The contest will highlight Homecoming Weekend at Auburn.

## NOTING THE PALADINS

► **104th SEASON...**The 2009 campaign marks the 104th season of football at Furman. The first school in South Carolina (along with Wofford) to play football, Furman since 1889 has compiled a 560-420-38 record in 1017 games. A member of the Southern Conference since 1936, Furman has captured a record 12 league championships (1978, '80, '81, '82, '83, '85, '88, '89, '90, '99, '01, & '04).

► **QUESTION OF THE WEEK...**Okay, let's go ahead and provide the answer to the most popular question asked every time Furman plays a Football Bowl Subdivision opponent. The Paladins' guarantee for Saturday's game at Auburn is approximately \$425,000.

► **PALADIN STADIUM PROWESS...**This fall marks Furman's 29th season in Paladin Stadium where it has compiled a 143-37-1 record (.793), including a 37-9 mark (.804) under Bobby Lamb — the best mark of any Furman head coach. Over the last five-plus years the Paladins have posted a 29-6 mark (.829) at home.

► **TWO FBS FOES THIS YEAR...**In facing Missouri and Auburn this year, Furman will be playing two FBS (formerly I-A) opponents for the first time in a season since 1982. That year the Paladins dropped a 26-0 season opening decision to North Carolina State but later dumped South Carolina, 28-23.

► **FURMAN VS. FBS SINCE 1982...**Since being reclassified (along with the rest of the Southern Conference) from NCAA I-A to I-AA in 1982 and, most recently, from I-AA to the current Football Championship Subdivision (FCS), Furman has had some success against formerly I-A (now Football Bowl Subdivision) foes, posting a 5-19-1 record against FBS competition over the last 27 seasons. From 1982-86, Furman went 4-1-1 against FBS teams, registering wins over South Carolina (1982), Georgia Tech (1983), and North Carolina State (1984 & '85) and a tie with Georgia Tech (1986). Since 1987, however, the Paladins have gone only 1-18 against FBS competition, with the one win coming against North Carolina in 1999.

► **LAMB (THE PLAYER) VS. FBS...**While no current players in the Furman program have experienced a win over an FBS opponent, head coach **Bobby Lamb**, during his playing days at Furman, went 3-0 against FBS competition. In 1983, his sophomore year, Lamb started in place of injured quarterback **David Charpia** and engineered Furman to a 17-14 win over Georgia Tech, passing for 140 yards and a touchdown. A year later he completed 9-of-16 passes for 210 yards and two touchdowns in leading the Paladins to a 34-30 triumph over N.C. State, and as a senior in 1985 torched N.C. State again, connecting on 9-of-15 passes for 167 yards and four touchdowns in a 42-20 rout of the Wolfpack.

► **FURMAN VS. THE SEC...**Furman sports a 26-65-1 record against current members of the Southeastern Conference, though many of those games were contested prior to the schools being members of the SEC. The last time the Paladins played an SEC foe was 2002 vs. Vanderbilt (49-18 loss). The last time Furman claimed a win over a current SEC member was 1982, when it defeated then non-member South Carolina (28-23). The Paladins' 14-13 triumph over Vanderbilt in 1963 marked the last time Furman downed an SEC foe.

► **ALABAMA CONNECTIONS...**Furman has had a strong recruiting pipeline to Alabama in recent years, and this year's squad reflects it. Among the Paladins' projected starters for Saturday's game versus Auburn are four Alabamians, including junior All-Southern Conference rover **Max Lerner (Birmingham/Hoover H.S.)**, junior all-conference wide receiver/return specialist **Adam Mims (Birmingham/Spain Park H.S.)**, senior left guard **Tyler Haynes (Birmingham/Vestavia Hills H.S.)**, and freshman running back **Jerry Williams (Prattville/Prattville H.S.)**. Sophomore free safety **Matthew Gordon (Birmingham/Briarwood Christian School)** is being redshirted after sustaining a season ending knee injury in the Paladins' season opening 45-21 win over Presbyterian, and sophomore offensive guard David Barrington (Montgomery/Montgomery Academy) is also out for the season with a knee injury. True freshman quarterback **Josh Hollingsworth (Hamilton, Ala./Hamilton H.S.)** is being redshirted.

► **FORCIER FINDS THE END ZONE...**Sophomore quarterback **Chris Forcier (San Diego, Calif.)** registered his first substantial action of the season on Saturday against Appalachian State and registered his first touchdown since joining the program this summer following two seasons at UCLA. His 25-yard scoring burst late in the third quarter highlighted an outing that saw him rush six times for 41 yards. He went 0-for-4 passing, but two of his throws in heavy rain were dropped.

► **DITTO FOR ANDERSON...**Sophomore tight end **Colin Anderson (Dallas, Texas)** also scored his first career touchdown on Saturday against Appalachian State when he hauled in a 33-yard scoring toss from quarterback **Jordan Sorrells (Greenville, S.C.)** late in the second quarter. For Anderson, who came to Furman as a walk-on quarterback before making the switch to tight end last year, it marked only his second reception of the season.

► **FIRST START FOR JOHNSON...**True freshman cornerback **Cortez Johnson (Snellville, Ga.)** earned the first start of his career on Saturday against Appalachian State, recording five tackles and a pass deflection while stepping in for injured sophomore **Jordan Griffin (Faiburn, Ga.)**.

► **TOUCHDOWN TERSOO...**Furman running back **Tersoo Uhaa (Gainesville, Ga.)** has found the end zone in seven of the Paladins' eight contests, including a 4-yard scoring run last Saturday against Appalachian State when he rushed 19 times for a career high 104 yards. His previous career high had been 99 yards versus ASU last year in Boone. As a true freshman a year ago he paced Furman with eight rushing touchdowns and now has 15 in his career.

► **SORRELLS EYES FU CAREER PASSING MARK...**Senior quarterback **Jordan Sorrells (Greenville, S.C.)** has delivered solid play for the Paladins over the first eight games, throwing for 1,738 yards and 14 touchdowns while also rushing for 73 yards and a score. In the Paladins' 45-21, season opening victory over Presbyterian, he accounted for a career high 336 yards in total offense and four touchdown responsibilities on the way to earning Southern Conference Offensive

Player of the Week honors. Coming off a 165-yard, 2-touchdown performance against Appalachian State, he is now just 72 yards shy of Ingle Martin's school career passing yards standard of 5,751 yards. He is now second in career total offense (5,666 yards) and ranks fourth in Furman history in career touchdown passes (36).

► **WILLIAMSTURNING HEADS...**Highly regarded true freshman running back **Jerry Williams (Prattville, Ala.)** has gained the attention of Furman's coaches and fans since the first day of preseason practice, which isn't surprising given the fact that he is a product of ultra-successful Prattville (6-A) High School, which posted a 43-1 record and won three 6-A state championships during his tenure there. As a senior he rushed for 1,383 yards in 19 touchdowns en route to earning Alabama Sportswriters Association All-State honors as well an invitation to play in the prestigious Alabama-Mississippi All-Star Game. In eight games (all starts) thus far he has rushed for a team leading 359 yards (5.4 ypg) and a touchdown, though last Saturday against ASU he was severely limited due to an ankle sprain sustained against The Citadel, against whom he rushed nine times for team high 83 yards, including a season long 40-yard burst in the second half.

► **MIMS ON THE CHARTS...**Furman junior wide receiver **Adam Mims (Birmingham, Ala.)**, the Paladins' leader receiver this year with 55 receptions for 613 yards and two touchdowns, continues his advance up the school's career receptions and receiving yards ledger. Last Saturday against Appalachian State he caught five passes for 102 yards, including a career long 72-yard scoring hook-up with Jordan Sorrells in the third quarter, to vault into fourth place on the school's receptions charts.

► **ANDERSON A HIT AT LINEBACKER...**Furman sophomore linebacker **Kadarron Anderson (Greenwood, S.C.)** has proven to be quite a hit — literally — this year, especially in the Paladins' last four games when he has combined for 74 tackles. He currently leads the SoCon and ranks third nationally in tackles, averaging 12.5 per game. In the Paladins' 33-14 win at Western Carolina on Sept. 26 he recorded a then-career high 17 tackles, 14 of which were solos. The following week he notched a game high 14 tackles against league leader Elon en route to earning SoCon Defensive Player of the Week honors, and tallied another career high with 18 stops against Samford. He racked up 14 tackles versus The Citadel two weeks ago and a team leading 11 stops versus Appalachian State. He is in his first season as a starter for the Paladins.

► **CESARI SOLID FROM 3-POINT RANGE...**Spurred by a strong performance against Western Carolina on Sept. 26 when he converted all four field goal attempts and was named SoCon Special Teams Player of the Week following a 33-14 Furman victory, Furman placekicker **Matthew Cesari (Atlanta, Ga.)** continued his strong work by cashing in both field goal tries versus Elon, including a career long 46-yard effort in the third quarter. Though he missed a 39-yard try against Samford, snapping a string of six consecutive makes, Cesari is still having a fine year (8-of-10). Over the last 13 games, the senior left-footer has made 12 of 14 attempts. He is now 17-of-22 (77.3%) on field goal attempts for his career.

► **WELCOME BACK...**Junior All-Southern Conference **Mike Brown (Marietta, Ga.)** turned in a solid performance against Samford recently in his first action of the season. Sideline midway through the preseason with a subtalar (ankle) sprain, he registered 10 carries for 35 yards and also notched 126 total yards on five kickoff returns (25.2 avg.) against the Bulldogs. Unfortunately, against the Citadel Bulldogs the following week he sustained a mild concussion and sat out the Appalachian State contest. Last year he rushed 162 times for a team leading 823 yards (5.1 ypc) and five touchdowns and caught 35 passes for 343 yards en route to earning consensus second team All-SoCon honors in voting by head coaches and media.

► **DEJA VU...**If Furman defensive end **Kyle McKinney (Atlanta, Ga.)** says he's seen it before, take him at his word. That's because in blocking Samford's game winning 38-yard field goal attempt on the final play to preserve a recent 26-24 Furman victory, he replicated the heroics he registered last year against Samford when, in the game's waning seconds, he broke through the line to block a Samford PAT attempt that would have tied the game with 1:52 remaining (Furman won 28-27 in Birmingham). In another interesting twist to the story, Samford's Richie Fordham scooped up the blocked kick, ran 10 yards, and appeared to have a chance to take it to the end zone before being tackled by Furman's **Max Lerner (Birmingham, Ala.)** to seal the results. Last year in Birmingham it was none other than Lerner who completed McKinney's game saving play when he stepped up to tackle a Samford player who had scooped up the deflected PAT just a few yards shy of the end zone.

► **MAD MAX...**Furman junior All-Southern Conference rover **Max Lerner (Birmingham, Ala.)** got the Paladins off to a quick start against Chattanooga on Sept. 12 by intercepting Mocs quarterback B.J. Coleman on the first play of the game and returning it 43 yards for a touchdown. Lerner, who totaled four tackles in the game, including two for loss, was named SoCon Defensive Player of the Week for his work in the 38-20 Furman victory. It was the first by a Paladin that was returned for a touchdown since **Thomas Twitty** covered 20 in a 23-21 win over Delaware last year.

► **A QUICK LOOK BACK...**Furman came within a whisker of taking down then-12th ranked Elon on Oct. 3, dropping a tough 19-12 verdict to the Phoenix. The game came down to the last few ticks when Elon freshman kicker Adam Shreiner booted a 37-yard field goal with two seconds remaining to give the Phoenix a 13-12 lead, capping a 7-play, 52-yard drive. Elon tacked on a final score with no time on the clock after an attempted lateral by Furman on the ensuing kickoff was fumbled into the end zone, where it was recovered by the Phoenix. A 1-yard scoring plunge by **Tersoo Uhaa (Gainesville, Ga.)** with 1:56 left in the game gave Furman a 12-10 lead, but a botched snap on the PAT proved costly and left the door open for Elon's game winning field goal.

► **MCKINNEY RETURNS...**Furman senior defensive end **Kyle McKinney (Atlanta, Ga.)** saw his first action of the season against Western Carolina on Sept. 26 after missing the entire preseason and first three games due to a fractured foot sustained in late July. A starter in seven games who tallied 24 tackles and 2.5 sacks a year ago, he moved back into the starting lineup against the Catamounts and registered three tackles. Against Elon he notched four tackles and a pass deflection, and against Samford came up with perhaps Furman's two most important defensive plays. Late in the first half with Furman leading 20-7, McKinney was credited with the fourth down tackle on Samford quarterback Dustin Taliaferro just inches from the goal line to keep the Bulldogs out of the end zone, preserving Paladins' two touchdown advantage. And later he broke through the Samford line to block the potential game winning 39-yard field goal attempt with two second seconds left in the contest, allowing Furman to hang on for the 26-24 victory.

► **MARRIED MAN...**Jordan Sorrells, the son of Furman offensive coordinator and Paladin All-Southern Conference signal caller **Tim Sorrells (1977-81)**, married his high school sweetheart, Sarah Kathryn Williams, in May of this year.

► **DID YOU KNOW?...**Furman quarterback **Jordan Sorrells (Greenville, S.C.)** throws left-handed but writes right-handed, and backup signal caller **Chris Forcier (San Diego, Calif.)** throws right-handed but writes left-handed.

► **HENDRIX AND THE CITADEL...**Sophomore wide receiver **David Hendrix (Buford, Ga.)** excels when playing The Citadel, as evidenced by the fact that all three of his career touchdown catches have come against the Bulldogs. Two weeks ago in Charleston, he caught a pair of 29-yard scoring tosses. Last year he collected a 9-yard scoring strike in a 34-20 triumph over The Citadel en route to garnering SoCon Coaches All-Freshman Team honors with a school freshman record 46 catches for 565 yards.

► **R.J. SPINS HIS WEBB, AGAIN...**The 2009 season has afforded twice injured senior wide receiver **R.J. Webb (Pickens, S.C.)** to complete another comeback. In catching three passes for 36 yards and

a touchdown in the season opener against Presbyterian, Webb returned to the field almost a year to the day after sustaining a torn anterior cruciate ligament in the Paladins' 2008 season opener versus Mars Hill when, ironically, he caught three passes for 36 yards and a score before his season ending injury. In 2007 he appeared well on his way to a fine campaign before suffering a torn ACL in a 27-17 victory over Coastal Carolina. In eight games this year he has caught 22 passes for 194 yards and two touchdowns while also displaying a still solid arm by completing a 55-yard pass versus Missouri off a flanker reverse. Webb, who is now 20th on the school's career Top 20 receptions ledger, threw for 1,634 yards and 12 touchdowns his senior year at Pickens High School, where he helped his squad to the state playoffs before bowing to a Greenville High School squad led by current Paladin signal caller **Jordan Sorrells (Greenville, S.C.)**.

► **EXPERIENCED GUARDS**...Senior guards **Tyler Haynes (Birmingham, Ala.)** and **Heath Cockburn (Dalton, Ga.)** have combined for 59 starts and 4,142 snaps in their careers.

► **CAROLINA SUCCESS STORY**...Furman boasts the second best record (81-39) among NCAA Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) and Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) programs in the Carolinas since 2000.

► **STREAKING IN THE SOCON**...In defeating Chattanooga in its SoCon season opener on Sept. 12, Furman claimed its 15th straight win over the Mocs since 1995. It is the longest active winning streak among current Southern Conference member schools. The Paladins won 21 consecutive games against VMI from 1980-02 before the Keydets departed the league. Furman won eight straight games versus Elon from 2000-07, but three of those came prior to the Phoenix joining in the SoCon in 2003.

► **2009 TEAM CAPTAINS**...Five players will serve as team co-captains in 2009: QB **Jordan Sorrells (Greenville, S.C.)**, NT **Justin Brown (Warner Robins, Ga.)**, BAN **Julian Hicks (College Park, Ga.)**, DE **Kyle McKinney (Atlanta, Ga.)**, and TE **Chris Truss (Atlanta, Ga.)**.

► **WHEN THE CLOCK STRIKES ZERO**...Furman did major damage against Chattanooga with the clock showing zero — literally. The Paladins scored touchdowns on the final play of the first, second, and third quarters. **Tersoo Uhaa (Gainesville, Ga.)** reeled off a 34-yard touchdown run on the final play of the first quarter to give Furman a 21-7 lead, and his second score of the contest, a 2-yard plunge, came on the last play of the first half, staking the Paladins to a 28-10 advantage. In third quarter **Ryan Steed (Mt. Pleasant, S.C.)** pounced on a fumble in the end zone with no time on the clock to give Furman a 35-13 lead.

► **FURMAN MAN**...As head coaching tenures go, **Bobby Lamb** doesn't qualify as a big time veteran, but when factoring in total years of association with Southern Conference schools, he could rightfully be considered the dean of league coaches. For Lamb, the 2009 campaign marks his 28th season at Furman. That tenure includes four seasons as a player (1982-85), 16 years as an assistant coach (1986-01), and eight seasons as head coach (2002-present). No other league mentor can match that length of service to a league school.

► **THE SPREAD: YEAR TWO**...The 2009 football season will mark year two of Furman's move to the popular spread offense.

► **PURPLE AND ORANGE**...Junior offensive tackle **Antonio Frazier (Chattanooga, Tenn.)** wears orange in the morning and purple in the afternoon and on Saturdays — literally. As a participant in Furman’s dual degree pre-engineering program with Clemson, he now attends ceramics and materials engineering classes at Clemson in the mornings before returning to Furman to practice football in the afternoons. Upon graduation, the fourth-year member of the Paladin football program will have diplomas from both schools.

► **FIRST SINCE 1998**...When freshman defensive end **Josh Lynn (Fort Lawn, S.C.)** got the starting nod in the season opener against Presbyterian, it marked the first time a true freshman position player had started in the season opener for Furman since 1998. That year true freshman **Louis Ivory** started for the Paladins at fullback against Clemson, as did first year cornerback **Rodney Johnson**.

► **NEW VIDEO BOARD DEBUTS**...The 2009 season offers Furman fans a new game experience in Paladin Stadium in the form of a new scoreboard that will contain a video board, full color ribbon, and static scoreboard equipped to display a wide variety of statistics, information, graphics, animation, and live and recorded video. The video board measures 13 feet high by 32 feet wide, and the ribbon board is 4 feet by 32 feet. Capturion Networks, based in Laurel, Miss., is the manufacturer, and the board operator is Mark-It Productions from Boiling Springs, S.C.

► **FURMAN LEGACY**...Furman football 2009 has a connection to the university’s origin in the person of sophomore linebacker **Rick Furman (Greenville, S.C.)**, the fifth great grandson of the school’s founder (1826), Dr. Richard Furman. Rick’s father, Richard, uncle, Earle Furman, Jr., grandfather, Earle Furman, Sr., and grandmother, Carolyn Hendricks Furman, all graduated from the university, and his mother, Nancy Yeargin Furman, was an All-American tennis player at Rollins College who played professionally at Wimbledon.

► **SMALL WORLD**...Furman senior defensive ends **Shaun Van Rensburg (Jacksonville, Fla.)** and **Kyle McKinney (Atlanta, Ga.)** have more in common than just a position. They both have lived in South Africa. Van Rensburg, who was born in Cape Town, South Africa, and was an Under 10 and Under 14 national equestrian (horse riding) champion, has had the distinction of meeting both Nelson Mandela and Bishop Desmond Tutu. His family emigrated to the United States in 2000. McKinney, meanwhile, lived in South Africa for two years, as a third and fourth grader, after his mother was relocated there with IBM.

► **MAX LERNER: TV STAR**...Starting junior rover **Max Lerner (Birmingham, Ala.)** starred in the 2007 hit MTV series “Two-A-Days: Hoover High.” In the series, Lerner and several former Hoover High School teammates were profiled in depth from the start of their 2005 football campaign all the way to the conclusion of the Buccaneers’ 14-1, Alabama 6A state championship season. Lerner tallied 85 tackles and three interceptions for Hoover his senior year en route to garnering all-state honors. Hoover finished the 2005 campaign ranked No. 7 nationally by **USA Today**.

► **A SHOT FROM THE PAST**...Furman sophomore tight end **Colin Anderson (Dallas, Texas)** has an interesting tie to history as he is a direct descendant of General Robert C. Anderson, who was in command of Union forces at Fort Sumter when the Civil War began on April 12, 1861.

► **NFL PALADINS**...Furman currently has two former players in the National Football League (NFL) ranks: **RB Jerome Felton '08** (Detroit Lions) and **CB William Middleton '09** (Jacksonville Jaguars). Felton was a fifth round draft selection of the Lions in 2007 and Middleton a fifth round pick of the Atlanta Falcons earlier this year.

► **CFL PALADINS**...Furman also has two former players in the Canadian Football League (CFL), including WR **Brian Bratton '05 (Montreal Alouettes)** and OT **Joel Bell '09 (Saskatchewan Roughriders)**.

# 2009 FURMAN PALADINS

**Head Coach Bobby Lamb**



**F**rom his days as a highly successful player at both the high school and collegiate level, to his tenure as an assistant coach, and, most recently, as head coach, Bobby Lamb has enjoyed notable success.

Through seven seasons as mentor at his alma mater he has compiled a 56-29 record (.659 winning percentage). That ranks among the top winning percentages among active FCS head coaches with at least five years of service to their institutions and fourth among Furman head coaches, trailing only his former head coach Dick Sheridan (.744), Jimmy Satterfield (.689), and W. L. Laval (.688).

The success Furman has enjoyed under Lamb is even more laudable when considering the nationally renowned liberal arts university boasts the most rigorous academic regimen of any SoCon school that competes for the league championship. Indeed, since the NCAA instituted its Academic Progress Rate (APR) monitoring system, which tracks eligibility, retention, and graduation, Furman's football program has produced the highest APR scores among league schools. The story is the same when examining NCAA Graduation Success Rates (GSR), with Furman leading the SoCon.

Furman's on-the-field results have mirrored the success in the classroom as the Paladins have compiled a 35-17 record (.705) versus SoCon foes, made four FCS playoff appearances, and claimed the 2004 conference championship during Lamb's tenure.

That coaching and success have been constants in Lamb's life appear to be nearly preordained. The son of a highly successful prep coach in Georgia and winner as a high school and collegiate player and assistant coach, he assumed the reins of Furman's football program in December of 2001, marking the culmination of a lifelong dream of becoming a collegiate head coach. To realize his dream at his alma mater made the moment even more special.

The next signal moment in his head coaching experience came in 2004 when he directed Furman to a 10-3 record, SoCon championship, and No. 5 final national ranking — a performance that netted him league coach-of-the-year honors. He followed up that success by leading his Paladins to an 11-3 record, NCAA I-AA (now FCS) semifinal playoff finish, and No. 3 final national ranking in 2005.

A Commerce, Ga., native, Lamb had served as an assistant on the Paladin staff for 16 years before becoming Furman's 21st

head coach; and, while at 46 years of age he still ranks as one of the younger mentors in the SoCon, in terms of total years of experience with his current school, he has no peer. Indeed, when combining a highly decorated four-year playing career with his time as a member of Furman's coaching staff, his 26 years of service to his alma mater rank first among current league head coaches.

A former Paladin standout quarterback and 1995 inductee into the University's Athletic Hall-of-Fame, Lamb spent 13 years as quarterbacks coach and from 1993 to 2001 served as passing game coordinator before being tapped to succeed Bobby Johnson as head coach following his departure to Vanderbilt. Lamb's assistant coaching tenure also included work with the program's receivers and defensive ends.

As a member of the Paladin coaching staff, he has played a pivotal role in some of the greatest seasons in school history, including six SoCon championships, a national championship, and a national runner-up finish. Furman's record during his tenure as an assistant coach was 126-65-3 (.657).

Fueling Furman's team success during his span as an assistant and in his first five years as head coach has been the outstanding play of Lamb-developed quarterbacks. The latest product is Ingle Martin, an all-conference signal caller who in 2005 passed for a school record 2,959 yards and 20 touchdowns prior to being selected by the Green Bay Packers in the fifth round of the 2006 NFL Draft.

In 2001 Lamb oversaw the emergence of Billy Napier, a two-time all-conference performer who completed a stellar career by passing for a then-school record 2,475 yards, finishing second in the nation in passing efficiency, and setting a new league season completion percentage standard (68.5 percent).

Prior to Napier, he assisted in the development of Justin Hill (1997-00) into an all-league player. In 1999 Hill directed Furman to a 9-3 record and league championship season that included a 28-3 win over North Carolina.

Before Hill, he helped mold Braniff Bonaventure (1993-96) into an all-conference signal caller and national record holder for most consecutive pass attempts (217) without an interception. Bonaventure's emergence followed that of two-time all-conference quarterback Frankie DeBusk (1987-90), who Lamb mentored during the 1989 and '90 seasons. DeBusk shattered several school records, many formerly held by Lamb, including career passing yards and total offense.

Prior to taking over duties as quarterbacks coach in 1989 under then-head coach Jimmy Satterfield, Lamb directed the program's defensive ends for two seasons, including a 1988 campaign that saw All-America performers Kelly Fletcher and Chris Roper play a crucial role in Furman leading the nation in scoring defense (9.7 ppg) and headlining the Paladins' drive to a school season best 13-2 record and I-AA national championship.

Furman's success during his tenure as an assistant coach only continued the level of achievement he helped deliver as an all-star prep and college quarterback.

Lamb came to Furman in 1982 under Dick Sheridan after fashioning a fine career at Commerce (Ga.) High School, where he played for his father, Ray Lamb. In 1981 he was named by the **Atlanta Journal-Constitution** as its AA Back-of-the-Year after leading Commerce to a 13-1-1 record and state championship.

At Furman he put his impressive ability and field savvy on display beginning in his sophomore season when he stepped in for injured starting quarterback David Charpia to lead the Paladins to a 17-14 win over Georgia Tech on the way to 10-2-1 record, league championship, and I-AA semifinal playoff finish. In his first full season as a starter in 1984, he helped engineer

Furman to an 8-3 record, including a 34-30 triumph over North Carolina State.

As a senior in 1985 he recorded perhaps the most effective season ever by a Paladin quarterback, completing 133-of-228 pass attempts for 2,264 yards and 24 touchdowns (only six interceptions). His 171.20 passing efficiency rating led the nation and helped the Paladins post their fourth straight win over a I-A opponent with a 42-20 rout of North Carolina State. In addition to going undefeated in league play (6-0) and notching the program's third conference title in four seasons, the Paladins finished as national runner-up with a 12-2 record. In recognition of his outstanding play, he was named SoCon Player-of-the-Year, Furman Male Athlete-of-the-Year, South Carolina Male Amateur Athlete-of-the-Year by the South Carolina Athletic Hall-of-Fame, and Carolinas Male Amateur Athlete-of-the-Year by the Charlotte Athletic Club.

In helping Furman to a 39-10-1 record (.790) during his playing career, Lamb, who still holds a number of school records and two league standards, helped fashion the second best four-year stretch in school history. During his playing and coaching tenure at Furman, the Paladins have notched a 215-99-4 record (.682) and have captured nine of the school's league record 12 league championships.

Lamb graduated from Furman in 1987 with a bachelor of arts degree in health and exercise science and in 1992 added a master's of education degree in the same field.

He and his wife, Allyson Acker of Greenville, have two children: a daughter, Sallie, and a son, Taylor.
