- Auburn team captains were RB Ben Tate, DE Antonio Coleman and CB Walter McFadden.
- Auburn won the toss and elected to receive. Georgia chose to defend the west end zone.
- Kickoff was at 6:10 p.m. CT.
- Attendance was announced as 92,746.
- Auburn's band members wore black ribbons in honor of Sarah Anderson, a piccoloist who died in a car accident late Tuesday night.

TEAM NOTES

- Auburn now leads the all-time series with Georgia, 53-52-8, and holds an 18-11 lead in games played in Athens.
- Auburn scored on its opening possession on a 5-yard pass from Chris Todd to Kodi Burns. The Tigers are now 4-2 this season when scoring first.
- Auburn held Georgia to seven first-half points, marking the fifth time in the last seven games, and third game in a row, that Auburn allowed seven or fewer points in the opening half.
- Auburn held a 14-7 lead at halftime, and is now 6-2 when leading at the half.
- The game was tied at 17 after three quarters, marking the first time this season that an Auburn game was tied after three periods.
- Auburn's 11-play scoring drive in the first quarter was the Tigers' eighth scoring drive of double digit plays this season. Seven of the eight ended with touchdowns.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Ben Tate wore No. 4 instead of his usual No. 44 in honor of his roommate, Zac Etheridge, who suffered a season-ending injury Oct. 31 against Ole Miss.
- Tate rushed for 67 yards, pushing his season total to 1209, moving past Carnell Williams (2004), James Bostic (1993), Joe Cribbs (1978) and James Brooks (1979) and into the ninth-best single-season total in school history.
- Tate's career rushing total is now 3,168, which is fifth best in school history, just 200 yards behind Joe Cribbs for fourth.
- Demond Washington's 99-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in the fourth quarter was the first kick returned for a score by Auburn since Tristan Davis returned one 95 yards for a score last season vs. UT Martin. It was the sixth-longest in school history and longest since Tim Carter's 100-yard return in 2000 vs. LSU.
- Washington also broke the school record for kickoff return yards in a game during his return. He finished with 202 kickoff return yards, breaking the Auburn record of 182 set by Tristan Davis last season vs. Arkansas.
- Chris Todd completed 20-of-28 passes for 238 yards and two touchdowns. Todd now ranks second in Auburn single-season history with 19 touchdown tosses this year, just one shy of the record shared by Jason Campbell (2004) and Pat Sullivan (1971).
- Todd also moved into Auburn's top 10 in career touchdown passes. Todd now has 24, which is tied for ninth with Jeff Burger (1984-87).
- Todd completed his first nine passes. Last Saturday against Furman, he completed his first 14 passes before finishing the game 17-of-18.
- Kodi Burns had his first career receiving touchdown to end Auburn's first drive, catching a 5-yard scoring toss from Chris Todd. Burns had scored 12 rushing touchdowns prior to collecting his first receiving score.
- Terrell Zachery grabbed his fifth receiving touchdown late in the first quarter, catching a 31-yard pass from Chris Todd. Even at 31 yards, it was the second shortest of Zachery's five touchdowns this season.
- Demond Washington's 19-yard punt return late in the first quarter was Auburn's longest punt of the season. The previous long was a 17-yarder by Anthony Gulley against West Virginia.
- Mario Fannin caught six passes, and in the process became Auburn's all-time leading receiver among running backs. Fannin now has 73 receptions during his career. James Joseph was the leader with 69 from 1986-90.
- Antonio Coleman had his 22nd career sack in the second quarter, moving him into sole possession of third place on Auburn's career sacks list. He is four shy of the record shared by Quentin Groves (2004-07) and Gerald Robinson (1982-85).
- Tommy Trott's 32-yard reception in the second quarter was his longest of the season and missed a career long by one yard. He had a 33-yard catch last year against Arkansas.
- Wes Byrum's 37-yard field goal late in the third quarter was the 42nd of his career, moving him into a tie for fourth most in Auburn history with Al Del Greco (1980-83). He is now 14-of-15 (.933) this season.

Georgia Postgame Notes: Nov. 14 vs. #25 Auburn

Injury Report: Redshirt freshman safety **Baccari Rambo** had a concussion in the fourth quarter and was carted off the field. He was initially unconscious on the field and then regained conscious. He has movement in all extremities; he has sensation in all extremities. He was transported to St. Mary's Hospital.

Sophomore FLK **A.J. Green** left the game at the beginning of the second period with an injured left shoulder AC (Acromioclavicular) sprain and did not return. Senior LB **Darius Dewberry** had a left elbow injury and did not return.

Georgia Makes It Four In A Row Over Auburn: For the first time since 1948, Georgia has won four straight over Auburn. Starting in 1944, Georgia won five in a row over the Tigers and except for a tie in 1949, they reeled off eight straight over Auburn. Tonight, Georgia fell behind 14-0 in the first quarter and took its first lead with 4:51 left in the third quarter at 17-14. The Tigers tied it on their next possession and the teams exchanged touchdowns before Georgia reclaimed a 31-24 edge with 6:52 left, and the defense preserved the victory. Auburn clings to a 53-52-8 edge in the series, the seventh most played in the nation. Also, Georgia notched a win over a ranked opponent at Sanford Stadium, the first since beating No. 22 Vanderbilt last year. The Tigers came in ranked No. 25. Richt is now 6-3 versus Auburn.

Creating Turnovers: Coming into the game, Auburn QB Chris Todd had thrown only three interception on the year (244 attempts) and the Bulldogs picked off two tonight. Sophomore SC **Brandon Boykin** grabbed his team-leading third interception of the season late in the second quarter. The Bulldogs failed to score off of their sixth INT of the season. Junior safety **Reshad Jones** notched his second interception of the year in the fourth quarter. It led to a TD and a 31-24 lead with 6:52 left. For the year, Georgia is minus-14 in its turnover ratio. The Bulldogs have forced eight turnovers for 27 points. The Bulldogs did not have any turnovers tonight, the first time since the win over LSU last year (14 games). Under Richt, the Bulldogs are 16-0 in games they do not have a turnover.

Troupe Gets First TD: Redshirt sophomore FLK **Israel Troupe** (2 rec., 62 yards) caught a 50-yard TD from quarterback **Joe Cox** at the beginning of the second quarter. This was Troupe's first catch of the year as well as the first TD of his career. He had another 12-yard catch in the third quarter to equal his career high with two receptions in a game. In 2008, Troupe had four catches for 39 yards. Cox also completed a 48-yard pass to redshirt freshman SE **Tavarres King** at the beginning of the fourth quarter. Cox finished with 173 yards passing and 2 TDs, going 9-for-17.

Walsh Delivers Again From Long Distance: Sophomore PK **Blair Walsh** connected on a 51-yard field goal with 11:05 remaining in the third quarter. He is now 4-for-4 from 50 yards or more this year and 14-for-15 overall in 2009. Walsh was recently named a semifinalist for the Lou Groza Award, given to the nation's top kicker.

King Finds The End Zone: Sophomore TB **Caleb King** tied his career high with two rushing TDs including a 24-yarder that gave the Bulldogs a 31-24 lead with 6:52 left in the contest. He finished with 66 yards on 10 carries. **Washaun Ealey** led the team with 98 yards on 18 carries and one TD.

Boykin Sets Kickoff Return Record: Sophomore SC **Brandon Boykin** set the single season kickoff return record after returning his 29th kickoff of the year in the first quarter. Gene Washington (1974) and Asher Allen (2007) each had 28 returns in one season. Boykin is already No. 1 in school history with 769 kickoff return yards on 31 returns in 2009. Tonight, he had 3 returns for 52 yards.

Starters: Junior **Akeem Dent** got the first start of the season at SLB after returning from a hamstring injury. Also, redshirt sophomore DE **Justin Houston** returned to the starting lineup against the Tigers after sitting out the Tennessee Tech game with an elbow injury.

Last Time: Auburn's Demond Washington returned a kickoff 99 yards for a touchdown early in the fourth quarter. Prior to that, the last time an opponent ran back a kickoff for a TD was in 1999 (Tennessee, Leonard Scott, 100 yards).

Bulldogs Show Support For Chance Veazey: At tonight's game, the Bulldogs had a baseball decal with the initials "CV" that they wore on the back of their helmets in honor of UGA baseball student-athlete Chance Veazey. Veazey, a 5-9, 175-pound freshman native of Tifton, Ga., was involved in a motor vehicle accident shortly after leaving the Miller Learning Center on October 28. He is continuing his rehabilitation at the Shepherd Center in Atlanta. The Veazey family provided approximately 1,000 "Team Veazey" t-shirts for UGA students. Many of the students wore them in a show of support for Chance and to raise awareness for the "Prayers for Chance" fund.

Next Week's Opponent: Georgia (6-4, 4-3 SEC) hosts Kentucky (6-4, 2-4 SEC) on Saturday, Nov. 21 at 7:45 p.m. The game will either be televised by ESPN or ESPN2. Georgia leads the series 49-11-2, including the Bulldogs' 42-38 win in Lexington last year. This will be the Bulldogs' third straight home game.

GEORGIA POST-GAME QUOTES

Georgia Head Coach Mark Richt:

"Overall, the team did a fantastic job. The guys stayed together, and I am really proud of the players and coaches. They've kept working hard, and we haven't let anything deter us from what we know is best."

"To get the fourth in row in the series feels good. When we got down 14-0, things could have certainly gone really wrong. But after that, the defense bowed their necks and held them to a field goal the rest of the game. I am very, very proud of what the defense did. The offense, even without A.J., made plays. And we won the turnover battle for the first time this year. When you do that, good things happen to your football team."

"The ball that was deflected and ended up in the arms of Orson Charles was big. It changed momentum for us."

"Rambo took the hit on that wonderful play he made, and he was unconscious for a little while. When he came to, he moved every single part of his body. We think it's a concussion, and he didn't have any neck pain. The great news is we don't feel like it's anything very serious in the long term. A.J. hurt his shoulder and we're just not sure. He's out indefinitely. We're not sure for how long, but we'll find out."

"It's always nice to get bowl eligible. Hopefully we will continue to do well down the stretch."

"Troupe hasn't had that many opportunities to make plays, but he made an instant impact on the game. Auburn might have been saying, 'Who's that guy?'"

Senior Quarterback, #14 Joe Cox:

On the fourth straight win over Auburn...

"It feels great. We not really worried about how many times we've beaten them the past four year. We needed this win for this team this year. We set a goal after the Florida game, and we wanted to win our last four games. That was step two, and we have another one coming up this weekend."

On the win...

"We kept our penalties down. We took care of the ball well. I tried not to force any throws. They turned it over and had a lot of penalties, and we didn't turn it over and only had four penalties. As bad as it started out, we were able to stay in it and that's kind of been our thing all year."

Freshman Tailback, #24 Washaun Ealey:

On nearly rushing for 100 yards...

"I've been hoping for it for a while. I'm going to keep being patient and keep running and trying to win games."

On the win...

"We knew that we could beat them. There were a couple of things that didn't go our way in the first half. Israel Troupe made a big play in the first half to get us to within seven. We knew in the second half we could have success running the ball and that's what we did."
