2005 MPSF Men's Soccer Player of the Year

ROD DYACHENKO, #16, Senior, Midfielder – UNLV

ROD DYACHENKO • Senior • Forward • 6-0 • 165 • Vancouver, WA; Mountain View HS

This marks Dyachenko's third-consecutive season being named to the All-MPSF First-Team. Dyachenko leaves UNLV as one of the top goal scorers in school history. His team-high eight goals this season gives him 23 for his career, ranking him ninth all-time for the Rebels. His eight career assists give Rod 54 career points four years at UNLV, which includes seven game-winning goals. He was named MPSF Player of the Week in his junior year. Dyachenko was a four-year letter-winner and three-year starter at midfield at Mountain View High in Vancouver, Wash. His team reached the first-round of the state playoffs as a sophomore and quarterfinals as a junior. Rod's club team, West Villa Thunder, was Oregon state champion and regional finalist as was F.C. Portland, where he also played club. Rod, who is majoring in psychology, was born in Russia, and is the son of Sergey and Luydmila Dyachenko. He has one brother, Kosta who plays soccer at Western Baptist College.

ISHMAEL IBARRA, #20, Junior, Forward – SAN JOSE STATE

JEFF BUDDENBOHN, #16, Freshman, Defender – SACRAMENTO STATE

ISMAEL IBARRA • Junior • Forward • 6-0 • 160 • Salinas, CA; Hartnell College

Ismael Ibarra, a Salinas native, started 12 of the 15 games this season, contributing five goals, five assists, and 15 points on the year, and was second on the team in game-winning goals with four. Ibarra, a business major with a concentration in finance, earned MPSF Brine Player of the Week Oct. 17, and was honored as the 2004 NSCAA/adidas Junior College Division III "Player of the Year" with 28 goals and 15 assists as a sophomore at Hartnell College in Salinas where he led the Panthers to their first appearance in the California State Championship and was the first player to earn NSCAA/adidas All-America honors in successive years, garnering second-team honors in 2003 and first-team honors in 2004. Ibarra ended his junior college career 57 goals scored and made first-team All-Far West Region both years. Ibarra was a four-year soccer letter-winner, three-time all-league selection and two-time league MVP at Everett Alvarez High where he led his team to back-to-back league titles as a sophomore and junior.

JEFF BUDDENBOHN • Freshman • Defender • 6-4 • 190 • La Canada, CA; St. Francis HS

Jeff Buddenbohn was one of the most decorated players in Sacramento State's 2005 recruiting class. The Hornets' first NSCAA High School All-American, Buddenbohn helped solidify a recruiting class that is considered the best in program history. He came to Sacramento State from St. Francis High School in La Cañada, Calif. and was quickly inserted into the starting lineup, organizing the back line in the central defense. The Sierra Madre, Calif., native started 16 of the Hornets' 17 matches and was a dangerous threat in the air on both sides of the field. He picked up his first assist of the year during Sacramento State's final game of the season when his header helped set up the Hornets' goal. He finished his high school career with 54 goals and as a senior in 2004 was named high school player of the year by the Glendale Press, Pasadena Star News and Los Angeles Daily News.
