STANFORD FINISHES ON TOP

No. 20 STANFORD recorded a 13-7 victory over Ohio State to wrap up the regular season with a 5-0 and 11-5 overall record. Junior **Sarah Bach** scored four goals and **Megan Burkner** recorded a hat trick against the Buckeyes. CALIFORNIA celebrated a 18-11 win over UC DAVIS on "Senior Day". **Laura Cavallo** led all scorers with six points from four goals and two assists, **Liz Reifsnnyder** scored three goals and one assist and **Molly Brady** scored a hat trick. The Golden Bears improved to 4-1 and 11-6 overall to finish the regular season. DENVER got hat tricks from **Steph Greenlees**, **Megan Tyrie** and **Crystal Jack** on its way to a 17-8 win over fifth-ranked Colorado College. The Pioneers finish the regular season with a 3-2 and 6-11 overall record. UC Davis tallied a 17-5 win over SAINT MARY'S in a non-conference match. **Katie McMahon** scored five goals while **Katie McGovern** and **Megan O'Connor** each added three to lead the Aggies. The Aggies took a 11-18 loss to California. **Katie McMahon** led the Aggies with three goals while **Tiffany Lee** and **Katie McGovern** each added two. **Hilary Harkins** recorded strong second-half numbers, tallying 10 saves against the six goals in 30 minutes in the cage. UC Davis finishes the regular season 2-3 and 9-7 overall. OREGON closed out the regular season with a 9-7 victory over Ohio University Saturday. Despite being outshot 30-18, the Ducks managed to hold the Bobcats to only two goals in the first half and held on for the win. **Jen May** paced the way with three goals. **Jana Bradley** and **Lindsay Killian** both netted two goals apiece. The Ducks finish 1-4 and 5-10 overall. Saint Mary's ended the regular season with an 11-18 defeat at Boston College. **Jen Utley** led the Gaels with four goals and **Molly Wagner** added another three. Saint Mary's ends the season 0-5 and 1-15 overall.
