### UCLA MAKES IT 26 IN A ROW & EVERYONE GOES TO THE BEACH

No. 1 UCLA goes north to continue their winning streak now at 26 and counting. The Bruins played No. 3 STANFORD winning 7-5 in a conference match and then traveled to SAN JOSE STATE and took the Spartans 8-3. No. 2 USC's **Erika Figge** and **Brittany Hayes** scored three goals each in the nightcap of a unique doubleheader Friday as the Trojans defeated ARIZONA STATE's Sun Devils, 9-8, at USC. A few hours earlier, the Women of Troy earned a 10-7 win at Loyola Marymount in nonconference action. **Moriah Van Norman** led the Women of Troy with three goals in the match at Loyola Marymount (23-5), snapping the Lions' program record 13-game winning streak. USC traveled to UC SANTA BARBARA on Saturday where they won handily 11-5. No. 3. STANFORD hosted UCLA in a conference game where they lost a heartbreaker 5-7. Two days later the Cardinal played the WWPAs UC Davis to end the weekend on a 12-5 winning note. No. 4 HAWAII traveled to the mainland and won six to make it 13 in a row. First up, UC Santa Barbara where they shook off jet lag to post a 8-4 win. Next victim was conference foe No. 11 UC IRVINE where they took the Anteaters 9-6. **Iefke Van Belkum** scored four goals in the win. On to the Long Beach State Tournament where they played No. 12 Michigan winning 5-4, Cal State Northridge winning 9-4, Cal State Bakersfield winning 11-5 and finally SAN DIEGO STATE where they won 9-3. No. 5 LONG BEACH STATE stayed home to host the Beach Tournament. The 49ers took their home pool advantage seriously and posted wins over CAL STATE NORTHRIDGE 13-6, UC Santa Cruz 13-7, Santa Clara 12-2 and No.18 Hartwick 9-5. The Hartwick game was the last home game for seven Seniors who were honored along with their parents in a special celebration before the game. No. 7. CALIFORNIA traveled to Bay area neighbor SAN JOSE STATE where they beat the Spartans in a 9-8 overtime thriller. No. 9 UC Santa Barbara lost to No. 4 Hawai'i 4-8 as the Rainbow Wahine used a strong first quarter to get out in front. Four different Gauchos contributed to UCSB's scoring and goalie **Christy Medigovich** had an impressive game in the cage. On Saturday the Gauchos lost to USC 5-11 in a conference home match. **Dana Saign** scored four of the five goals for the Gauchos bringing her season total to 29 goals. No. 11 UC Irvine went 2-3 on the week defeating Arizona State 5-3 and Cal Baptist 7-6 and losing to Hawaii 6-9, No. 19 UC San Diego 2-5 and No. 12 Michigan 5-7. **Robyn Kaake** scored six goals on the week and Freshman **Jessica Lewis** scored seven. No. 10 San Jose State lost to UCLA 3-8. The Spartans allowed just one UCLA goal late in the first period but the Bruins dominated the rest of the match. No. 13 San Diego State started out with an impressive 16-4 win over Cal State Bakersfield but then lost three in a row, Hartwick 7-9, Michigan 6-7 and Hawaii 3-9 at the Beach Tournament. No. 16 Arizona State won two and lost three on their California swing. First up was USC where they almost snuck by the Trojans losing 8-9. Next was the Beach Tournament where they split beating Santa Clara 6-3 and Cal Baptist 8-6 and losing to UC Irvine 3-5 and Hartwick 3-9. No. 17 Cal State Northridge started off the Beach Tournament with a conference game against host Long Beach State losing 6-13. They lost the next one to Hawaii 4-9 but then took it out on UC Santa Cruz winning 14-6. They finished up the weekend with a 5-7 loss to UC San Diego. PACIFIC went 1-3 at the Beach Tournament with an impressive win over UC San Diego 11-9 and losses to Hartwick 6-11, Cal Baptist 4-6 and Santa Clara 6-8.

The MPSF champion will gain automatic qualification into the NCAA 8-team tournament along with the conference champions from the Western Water Polo Association, the Collegiate Water Polo Association, the Southern California Intercollegiate Athletic Conference and the MAC. Three at-large teams will be chosen by the NCAA Women's Water Polo Committee.
