STANFORD STUNS NO. 13 VANDERBILT, 15-9

STANFORD picked up a huge non-league victory Sunday in Palo Alto, 15-9 over 13th-ranked Vanderbilt. The Cardinal never trailed in the game, as six different players tallied. Senior Sarah Bach recorded a hat-trick in each half, finishing with a career-high six goals, which also matched a single-game school record. Senior Megan Burkner added three goals and three assists, while junior Michelle DeChant and sophomore Daphne Patterson scored twice. No. 20 Stanford stays home this week, facing Columbia Saturday and MPSF opponent St. Mary's Sunday....OREGON set a team record for most goals in a game with a 22-8 MPSF home win over St. Mary's Friday. The 14-goal differential was the largest margin of victory for the Ducks in their two seasons of competing. The Ducks opened a 7-0 lead en route to the big win, and had at least one tally from 10 players. Freshman Ilsa Van Den Berg tied a team record with five goals, while sophomore Lindsay Killian added four. Oregon fell 16-6 to 12th-ranked Georgetown Sunday in Eugene, and now heads to Farmville, VA. to play Davidson Friday and Longwood Sunday....ST. MARY'S is now 2-1 on the season and will have the entire week to prepare for the short trip to Stanford Sunday....DENVER improved to 3-0 at home with an impressive 15-9 win over Hofstra Saturday. Senior Tanya Fuchs led the Pioneers with five goals. Junior newcomer Kristie Leggio added three goals and two assists on the heels of a two hat-trick effort in a 12-11 overtime loss at Delaware....UC DAVIS had its lone scheduled game of the week rained out at Stanford Friday. The 1-2 Aggies will be at Denver Saturday in their first MPSF road contest....CALIFORNIA has been off since it edged Ohio State 12-11 on Feb. 26. The 2-1 Bears host Vanderbilt Tuesday followed by a trip to New York to face No.17 Cornell Friday and Colgate Sunday.

STANFORD'S BACH LEADS UPSET WIN, NAMED MPSF PLAYER OF THE WEEK

WOODLAND, Calif. – STANFORD senior attacker **Sarah Bach** (Baltimore, MD.) has been named MPSF Player of the Week for her solid play in a 15-9 win over No. 13 Vanderbilt. She posted a hat trick in each half, finishing with a career-high six goals and one assist on the day. The six tallies also tied a single-game Stanford record. Bach also won three important draw controls for the Cardinal. She is now tied for the scoring lead at Stanford with 11 goals in 2006, and ranks eighth in school history with 80 career goals.
