2006 MPSF Player of the Year

ANDREW BOYENS, #3, Senior, Defender – UNIV. of NEW MEXICO

NEW MEXICO senior defender **Andrew Boyens** is a 2006 Hermann Trophy Candidate. Boyens will finish his Lobo career as one of the top players in New Mexico soccer history. As a sophomore in 2004, the hard-nosed defender dominated the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation, earning both the league's co-Player of the Year and Newcomer of the Year honors. He scored a pair of goals from the backline, guiding New Mexico to its first ever appearance in the NCAA Sweet 16 in his first year with the Lobos. In 2005, Boyens was again one of the top defenders in the nation, repeating as a 1st Team All-MPSF selection and earning national recognition as a Soccer Times, CollegeSoccerNews.com and NSCAA All-American. He was second on the team in scoring with 17 points on seven goals and three assists. His two goals in the NCAA Tournament earned him a spot on the 2005 College Cup All Tournament team and guided New Mexico to an appearance in the NCAA title game. A 2005 NSCAA Scholar Athlete, Boyens is currently third on the team in scoring with seven points on two goals and three assists.

2006 MPSF Newcomer of the Year

KELLAN CHRISTENSEN, #3, Freshman, Forward – UNIV. of DENVER

DENVER freshman forward **Kellan Christensen** had an incredible freshman campaign tallying five points on two goals and one assist, starting in each of the 16 games he played in. Christensen's first goal as a Pioneer was the only goal scored in a 2-1 loss to then No. 25 Memphis. His second goal helped the Pioneers to a 3-0 victory over San Jose State on Oct. 20. Christensen's assist helped teammate junior defender **Josh Fallin** score the game-winning goal in the Pioneers 1-0 shutout of San Jose State on Oct. 12. As a tough competitor on both ends of the field, Christensen's defense and offense were an integral part of the Pioneers' winning season.
