UCLA WINS BIG - STANFORD, USC AND SAN DIEGO STATE AT-LARGE PICKS

No. 1 STANFORD breezed through early round championship games against UC IRVINE and HAWAII but met their match against the UCLA Bruins in the championship match. **Katie Hansen** led on offense. Stanford earned an at large bid to the NCAA Championship and the # 1 seedNo. 2 UCLA defeated LONG BEACH STATE, battled it out for a one point win over USC and then put the pedal to the metal against Stanford in the championship match winning 9-3 and earning their ticket to the championship. **Kelly Rulon** took home MPVNo.3. USC took advantage of a first round bye to defeat SAN JOSE STATE then lost a heartbreaker to UCLA and then a win over Hawaii for 3rd place and an at-large ticket to the NCAAsNo. 4 Hawaii split their four games with wins over PACIFIC and SAN DIEGO STATE but their luck ran out when they went up against Stanford and USC. The Rainbow Wahine finished fourth, and no return ticket to the mainlandNo. 5 San Diego State earned their first trip to the NCAA Championship after wins over UC SANTA BARBARA, a loss to Hawaii and wins over UC Irvine and SAN JOSE STATE for 5th placeNo. 6 CALIFORNIA lost to a fired up Long Beach State then came back with wins over CAL STATE NORTHRIDGE and ARIZONA STATE for 9th placeNo. 7 San Jose State placed 6th with a win over Cal State Northridge, a loss to USC, a win over Long Beach State and a loss to San Diego StateNo. 10 UC Irvine was 7th with a win over Arizona State, losses to Stanford and San Diego State and a win over Long Beach StateNo. 11 and Championship Host, Arizona State started with a loss to UC Irvine, followed up with a win over UC Santa Barbara and fell on Sunday to California for 10th placeNo. 14 UC Santa Barbara came out in 12th after a loss to San Diego State, a win over Pacific and losses to Arizona State and CS NorthridgeNo. 16 CS Northridge lost to San Jose State and California but ended on a high note for 11th place with a win over UC Santa Barbara.....Pacific lost early round games to Hawaii and UC Santa Barbara to end in 13th in the most competitive conference in the country....
