STANFORD ALONE IN FIRST AFTER BEATING THE BRUINS IN O.T.

No. 1 STANFORD stayed on top of the rankings with a 7-6 win in OT over the UCLA Bruins and followed with a win over UC SANTA BARBARA.. **Christina Hewko** led the Cardinal in scoring in both gamesNo. 2 UCLA lost to Stanford but came back strong the following day for a win over SAN JOSE STATE. **Katie Rulon** led the Bruins with six goals against San Jose StateNo.3. USC's **Kami Craig** led the charge with eight goals in three games as the Women of Troy defeated CALIFORNIA, SAN DIEGO STATE and HartwickNo. 4 HAWAII defeated UC Santa Barbara, CAL STATE NORTHRIDGE to complete their MPSF regular season, then followed up with non-conference wins over Hartwick and Cal Baptist.....No. 5 California traveled south where they split the weekend losing to USC and defeating Cal State Northridge before heading home for next weekend's Big Splash against rival StanfordNo. 7 UC IRVINE took home road losses to San Diego State and ARIZONA STATENo. 8 San Jose State went two for three on the weekend with a win over UC Santa Barbara followed by a loss to UCLA and a win over Cal State Monterey BayNo. 11 ARIZONA STATE posted two MPSF wins at home defeating LONG BEACH STATE and UC IRVINENo. 13 UC Santa Barbara lost to San Jose State, followed up with a win over Santa Clara but ended with a loss to No. 1 Stanford. **Jenny Gonzales** led the Gauchos on defense from the goalNo. 14 Long Beach State took a narrow 14-16 loss to Arizona State on the roadNo. 19 CS Northridge stayed at home for three games losing to Hawaii and California but finishing with a win over Pacific Pacific lost to Cal State Northridge and Hartwick.

WOODLAND, Calif. Christina Hewko led the Cardinal to two victories this week over ranked opponents. On Saturday Hewko led the Cardinal to an overtime victory over No. 2 ranked UCLA 7-6 in overtime. Hewko had three goals in the low scoring game and was a strong contributor in holding the top scoring offense to only six goals. Hewko followed up that performance with four more goals against No. 12 ranked UCSB in the 12-5 victory. Three of Hewko's goals in the match came in the closely contested first half. Hewko totaled seven goals for the weekend and led the Cardinal to their 18th and 19th consecutive victories.
