No. 2. USC defeated CAL STATE NORTHRIDGE 16-8 for their first MPSF win of the season. Fr. **Alexandra Kiss** tossed in four goals to lead the Women of Troy.....No. 3 STANFORD scored their second MPSF win of the season over PACIFIC.....No. 4 CALIFORNIA suffered a tough loss to Bay Area neighbor San Jose State and prepare to host the top ranked Bruins next Friday .....No. 6 SAN DIEGO ST. started the season with a win over Hartwick and three wins at the Triton Invitational before falling to Loyola Marymount in the championship game. So. **Anna Gonzales** led the Aztecs with 10 goals and scored in all five games.No. 7 UC IRVINE. Breezed through the first two games of the Triton Invitational besting CS Bakersfield and Hartwick but lost a heartbreaker to Loyola Marymount 7-8 in triple overtime. The Anteaters went on to defeat UC Davis.....No. 8 San Jose St defeated California in OT 14-13. Goalie **Kendra Adama** had 12 saves in goal and **Deanna Lowry** tossed in four goals to lead the Spartans in their first win over the Bears.....No. 15 Long Beach St. started off the Triton Invitational with a loss to Hartwick but followed up with wins over CSU Bakersfield, CS Northridge and Princeton.....No. 16 UCSB scored wins over Santa Clara, Michigan and Hartwick but lost a close one to San Diego St. at UCSD. **Sarah Kovach** led the Gauchos with 6 goals for the weekend.....CS Northridge started a grueling weekend with a loss to USC and followed with losses to Michigan, Redlands and Long Beach State at USC before finding the silver lining with a win over Santa Clara to finish it up. ....
